CRITERIA AND INFORMATION

1. Must fill out application. Application must be accompanied by grade transcript.
2. Must be graduating senior from Des Moines County High School.
3. Must have "C" average at application.
4. Must be entering Criminal Justice Program at Southeastern Community College as a full time student.
5. Must have financial need as determined by the committee.
6. Must provide two letters of recommendation; one from an instructor of their high school; one from non-relative adult citizen of Des Moines County.
7. Must provide names of parents and/or guardian.
8. Must provide address of parents and/or guardian.
9. Must provide employment of parents and/or guardian.
10. Members of the Burlington Police Department and their immediate family members are excluded.
11. Applicant may not be required to, but must be willing to meet with the scholarship committee.
12. Is applicant employed? If so, where?
13. List of outside activities.
14. In 100 words or less, explain how applicant would benefit from receiving the scholarship.
15. Scholarship will be presented at the school's regular award assembly.

16. Tuition payments of \$500 each semester will be made directly to Southeastern Community College.
17. Second year scholarship renewable automatically, if "C" average is maintained during the first year.
18. Southeastern College transcripts must be provided to the committee at the end of each semester.
