




Figure 33. Buildings of Chittenden and Eastman as depicted in sketch in 1925 catalog (Map #17, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 19, 20, 21, 23), looking southeast – scale/width of buildings remains exaggerated to demonstrate magnitude of plant – new six story buildings at south end in background included (Chittenden and Eastman 1925: 2).




Figure 34. 1931 Sanborn fire insurance map of Burlington, with district boundary overlaid and extant buildings shaded (Sanborn Map Company 1931).




Figure 36. 1952 Sanborn fire insurance map of Burlington, with district boundary overlaid and extant buildings shaded (Sanborn Map Company 1952).




Figure 41. Buildings of Chittenden and Eastman as depicted in sketch in 1954 catalog (Map #17, 12-16, 19-23), looking southeast – scale/width of buildings remains exaggerated to demonstrate magnitude of plant (Chittenden and Eastman 1954: 2).
