






Recreational Fires

- ◆ No permit shall be required for recreational fires.
- ◆ All recreational fires shall be attended to by an adult familiar with the rules and regulations and have appropriate fire extinguishing equipment readily available.



- ◆ All openings shall be covered by a protective mesh screen with a maximum grid size of 1/2 inch .
- ◆ Recreational fires shall be limited to 3 feet or less in diameter and 2 feet or less in height.

- ◆ Recreational fires shall be limited to manufactured fire pit appliances, above or below ground fire pits protected by metal, stone, or concrete.
- ◆ Recreational fires shall be located at least 15 feet from any structure or combustible material.
- ◆ Burning material shall be limited to clean dry wood or commercial fire-place logs.
- ◆ No construction waste or demolition material shall be burned.
- ◆ Recreational fires shall be limited to between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 a.m.



- ◆ No fire may be kindled when wind velocity exceeds 15 miles per hour.



- ◆ Any Burlington Firefighter or Police officer is authorized to require that open fires be immediately discontinued if determined that smoke emissions are offensive to occupants of surrounding properties, or if the recreational fire is determined to constitute a hazardous condition, or the recreational fire is determined to be in violation of this section.
