

## BURLINGTON'S ANNUAL CITY-WIDE CLEAN-UP PROGRAM

*The Annual City-Wide Clean-Up Program is scheduled according to trash route.*

*It takes crews 3 or 4 days to collect all items from a route, but items must be set out before 7:00 a.m. of your SET OUT DATE.*

*To avoid creating a nuisance, do not set out more than one week in advance of your date.*

<u>SET OUT DATE - 2018</u>	
Monday's route	April 16
Tuesday's route	April 24
Wednesday's route	May 2
Thursday's route	May 10
Friday's route	May 18

- *Place CWC items in the same location as your regular garbage collection. However, **REGULAR GARBAGE is still subject to the TAG program for garbage** and should be separate from CWC items.*
- During CWC, Burlington's Solid Waste crews pick up program-approved items from Solid Waste customers at no additional charge -- objects such as furniture, old clothes, toys and bulky household items.
- ***Small items must be in garbage cans, trash bags, sturdy boxes or other containers no larger than a garbage can. Loose bits and pieces will not be picked up!***
- Paint cans must be empty or dry with the lid removed.
- Carpet must be cut in 4' strips and each strip tightly rolled and tied. If taken to the landfill by the resident, there is no need to cut, roll and tie.
- The **quantity** of material collected from one residence is limited to a reasonable amount. Crews will fill the garbage truck hopper up to four times. This equates to a pile no more than 14' L x 5' W. DO NOT STACK!!!
- **NOT APPROVED:** Items too heavy for 2 people to safely handle are not approved, nor are items not properly prepared for collection.
- **NOT APPROVED:** Electronics with screens are banned from the landfill. Electronics are accepted at the HazChem Center for a fee. TVs cost \$15. Other electronics are 25¢ per pound. City crews also pick up TVs by appointment. 11 Trash Tags are

required. Call (319)753-8114 to get on the list. Goodwill of the Heartland accepts computers, monitors, and computer accessories, at no charge, even if they don't work. Items are recycled. Goodwill is located at 165 West Burlington Avenue.

- **NOT APPROVED:** Appliances, tires, batteries & pressurized tanks are collected year-round by appointment. TRASH TAGS are required. Call (319)753-8114 to get on the list. Appliances may be taken to the Area Recyclers for a fee. Alliant Energy will pay their electric customers \$50 for working refrigerators or freezers and \$25 for working air conditioners. Call 1-866-255-4268 to apply.
- **NOT APPROVED:** recyclables, yard waste, tree limbs, auto parts, landscape timbers, railroad ties, pallets, bricks, stones, rubble, concrete, asphalt, shingles, siding, and dry wall.
- **NOT APPROVED:** Liquids and Household Hazardous Waste. Call the Haz Chem Center at 1-877-429-2436 for FREE disposal. DO NOT mix Hazardous Waste with other items.
- **NOT APPROVED:** Construction and demolition material. (bricks, stones, concrete, rubble, asphalt, shingles, lumber, pallets, siding, drywall, landscape timbers, railroad ties)
- **"FREE" SELF-HAUL during Burlington's CWC has been DISCONTINUED. If you wish to haul material to the Landfill the cost is \$52/ton with a \$10 minimum.**

Loads brought to the landfill must be secured to avoid a \$10 surcharge - in most cases this requires a tarp. The Landfill is located on Washington Road northwest of West Burlington, 1.3 miles from Hwy 34. Hours are M-F, 8-4 and Saturday, 8-noon

### **Recycle What You Can!**

**Area Recyclers accept most types of glass including beverage glasses, vases, ceramics, Pyrex, bottles, jars, mirrors and window glass smaller than 24".**

**Burlington Public Library accepts used books for Friends of the Library book sales - drop off during Library hours.**

**Animal Shelters appreciate old towels, rugs, blankets and sheets for use in the kennels.**

Good, used clothing and household goods may be donated to **Salvation Army, Hopefully Yours or Goodwill of the Heartland.**
