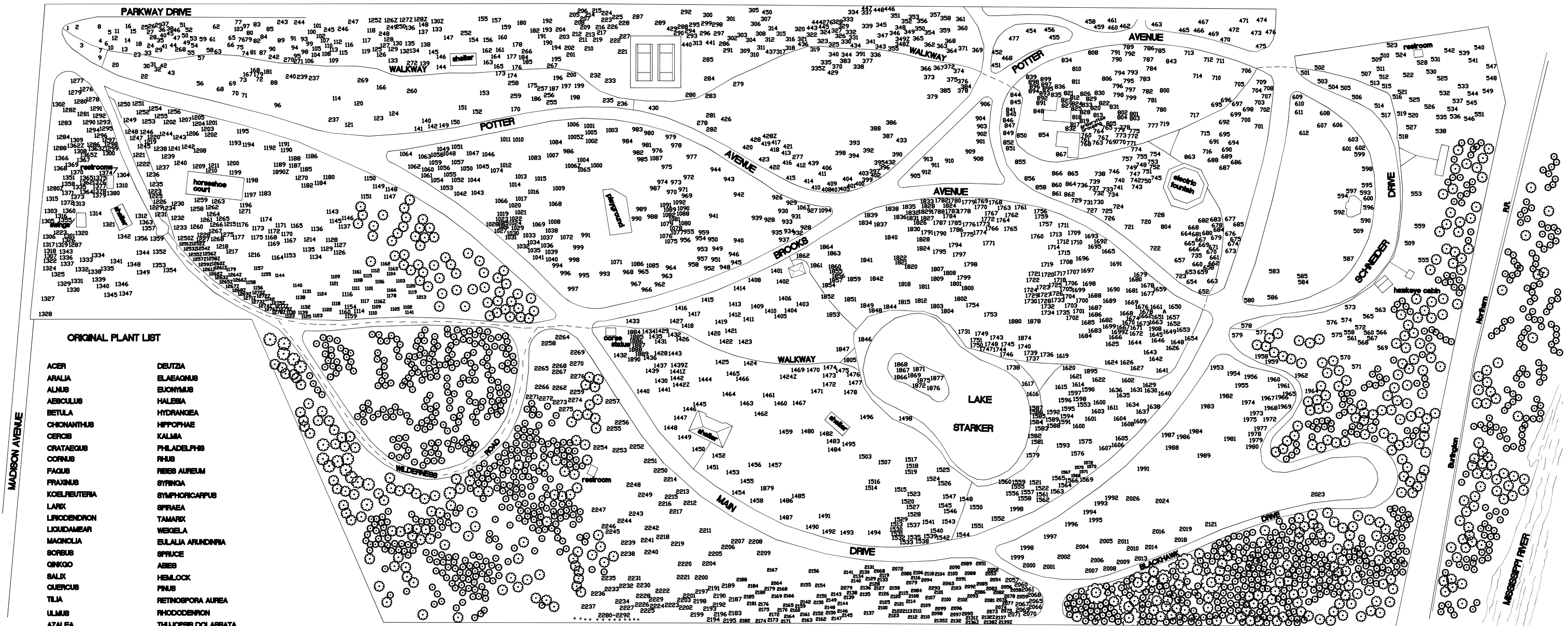


# Map Of CRAPO PARK

**CRAPO PARK**, Covering approximately 95 acres, is located two miles South on Main Street from the business center. Situated on the West side of the Mississippi River, the park possesses the natural beauty of sheer stone bluffs, deep ravines and majestic river views. All plant material in Crapo Park is individually tagged and numbered. The map shows the location of each tree. A supplemental booklet identifies the common and scientific name of each numbered plant.

**THE PURPOSE OF THIS MAP** is to increase the use and enjoyment of this beautiful and unusual park by the general public. Also to foster and preserve that the public spirit shown by the many individuals and organizations who by their contribution of specimens have assisted in making Crapo Park one of America's finest.
