

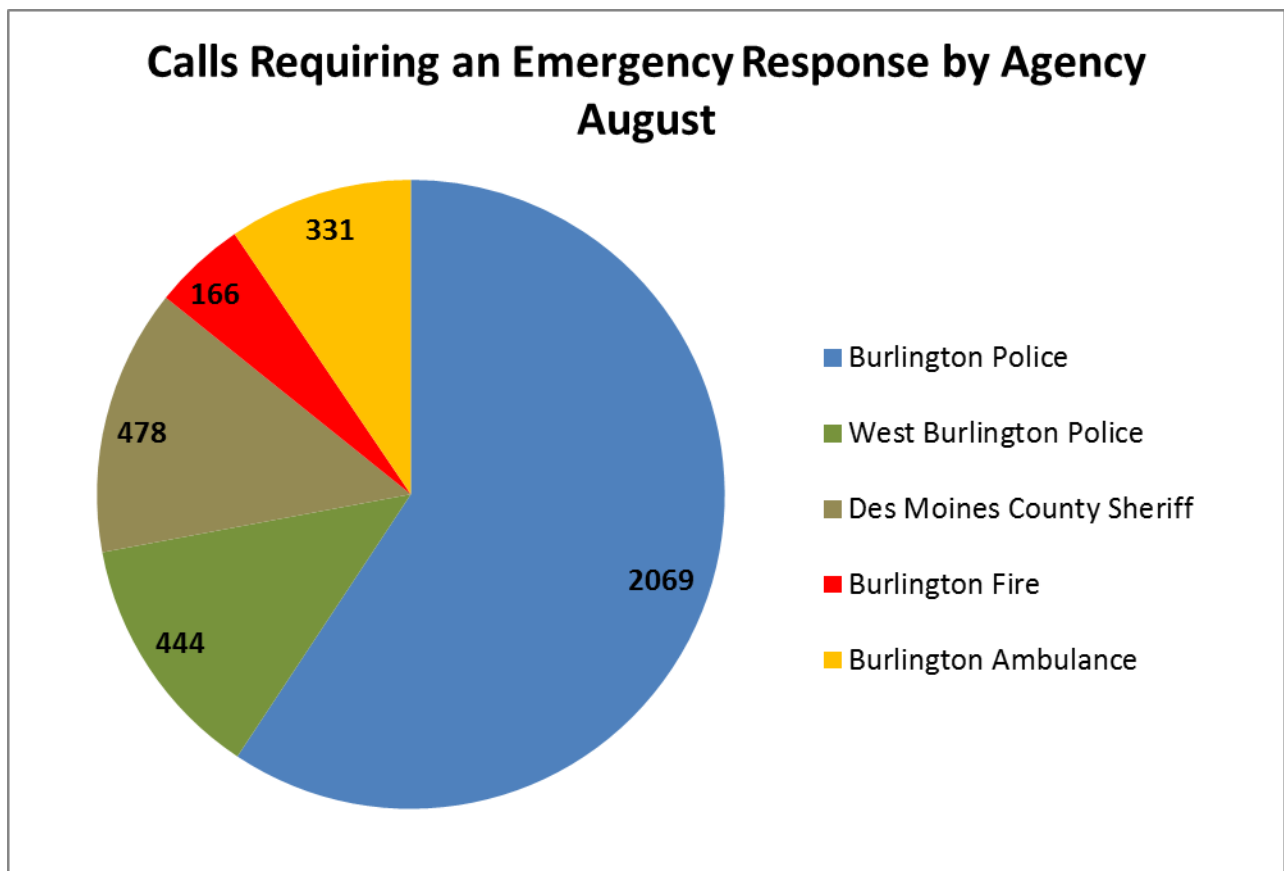

Re: Police Department Activities – August, 2015

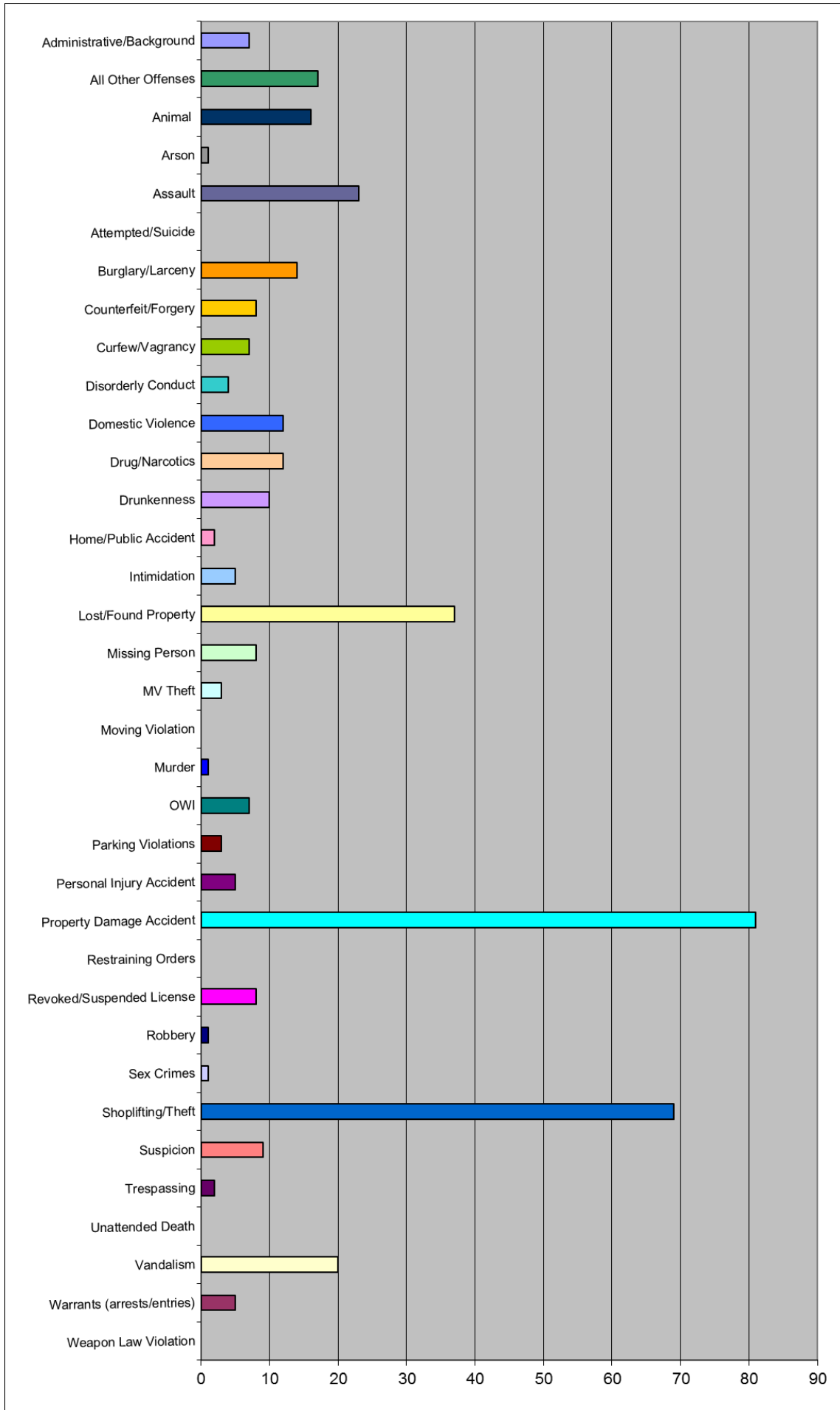


- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

- Major Grimshaw attended the Iowa Summit on Justice and Disparities in Ankeny.

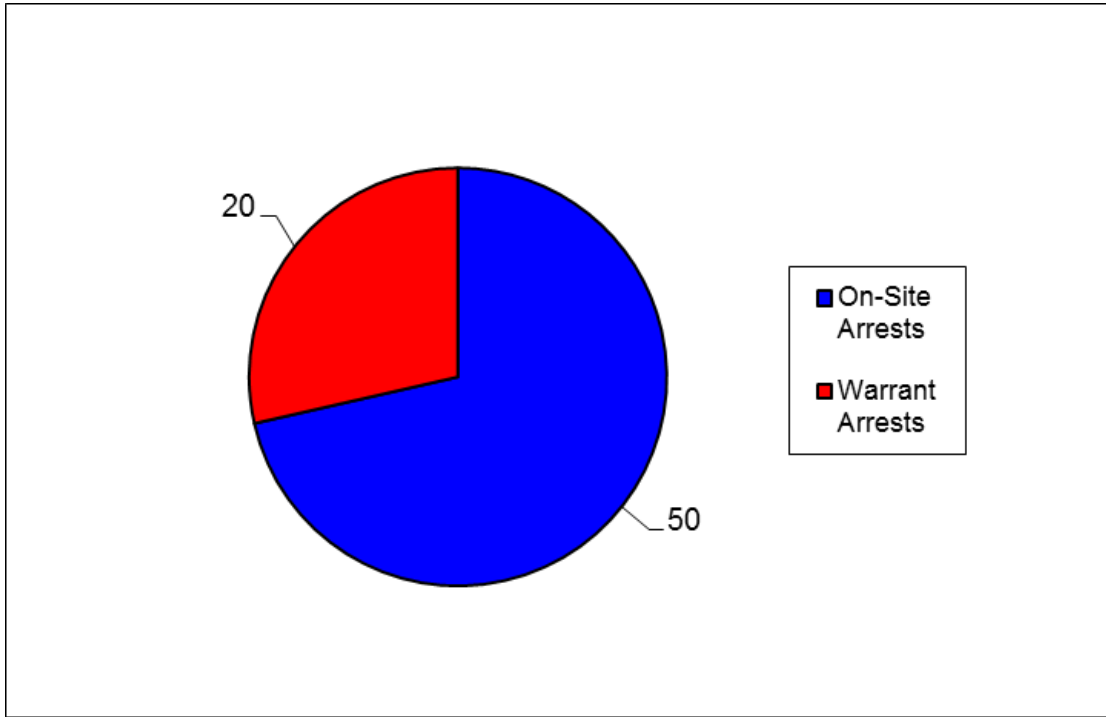
- The Command Staff met for the monthly staff meeting.

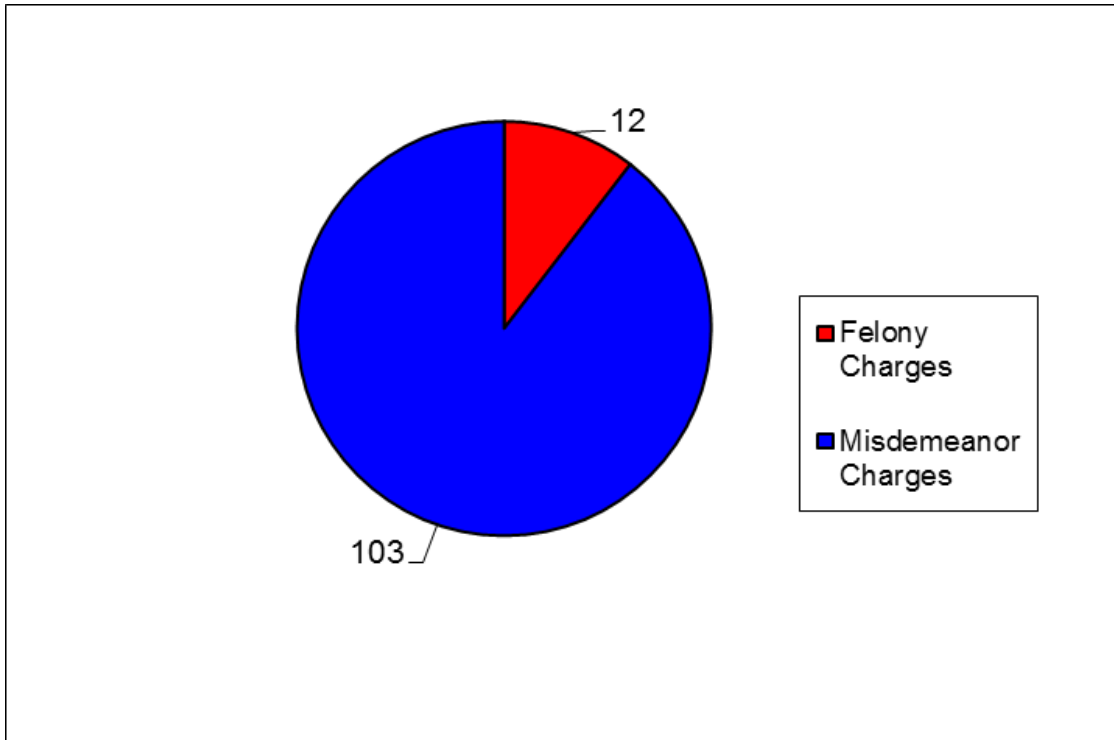
Incidents August 2015
