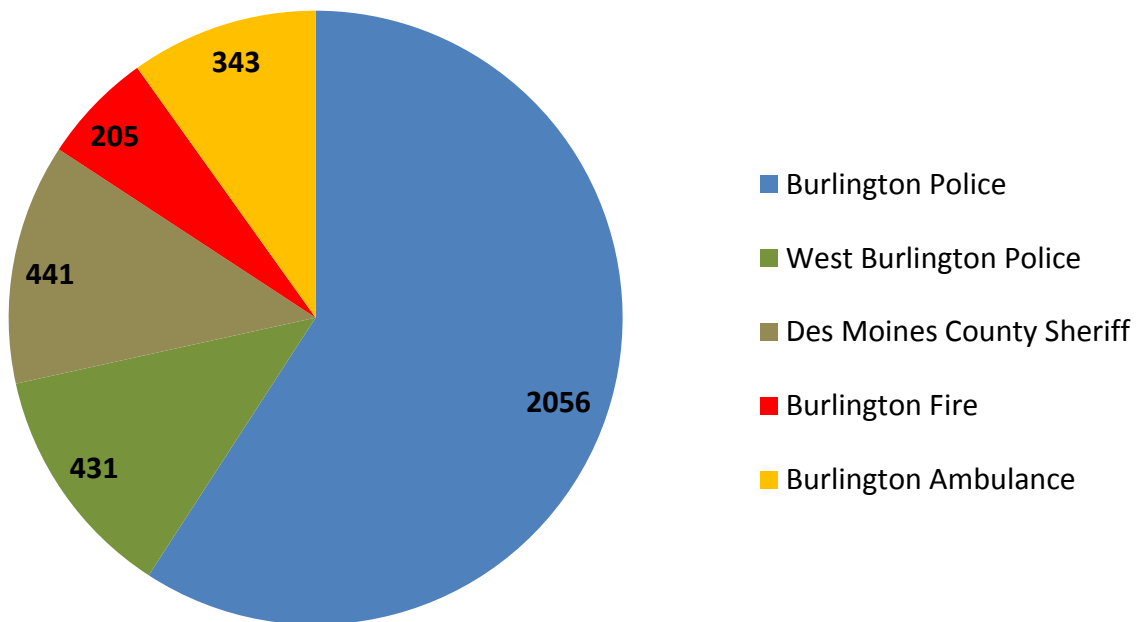

Re: Police Department Activities – September, 2015



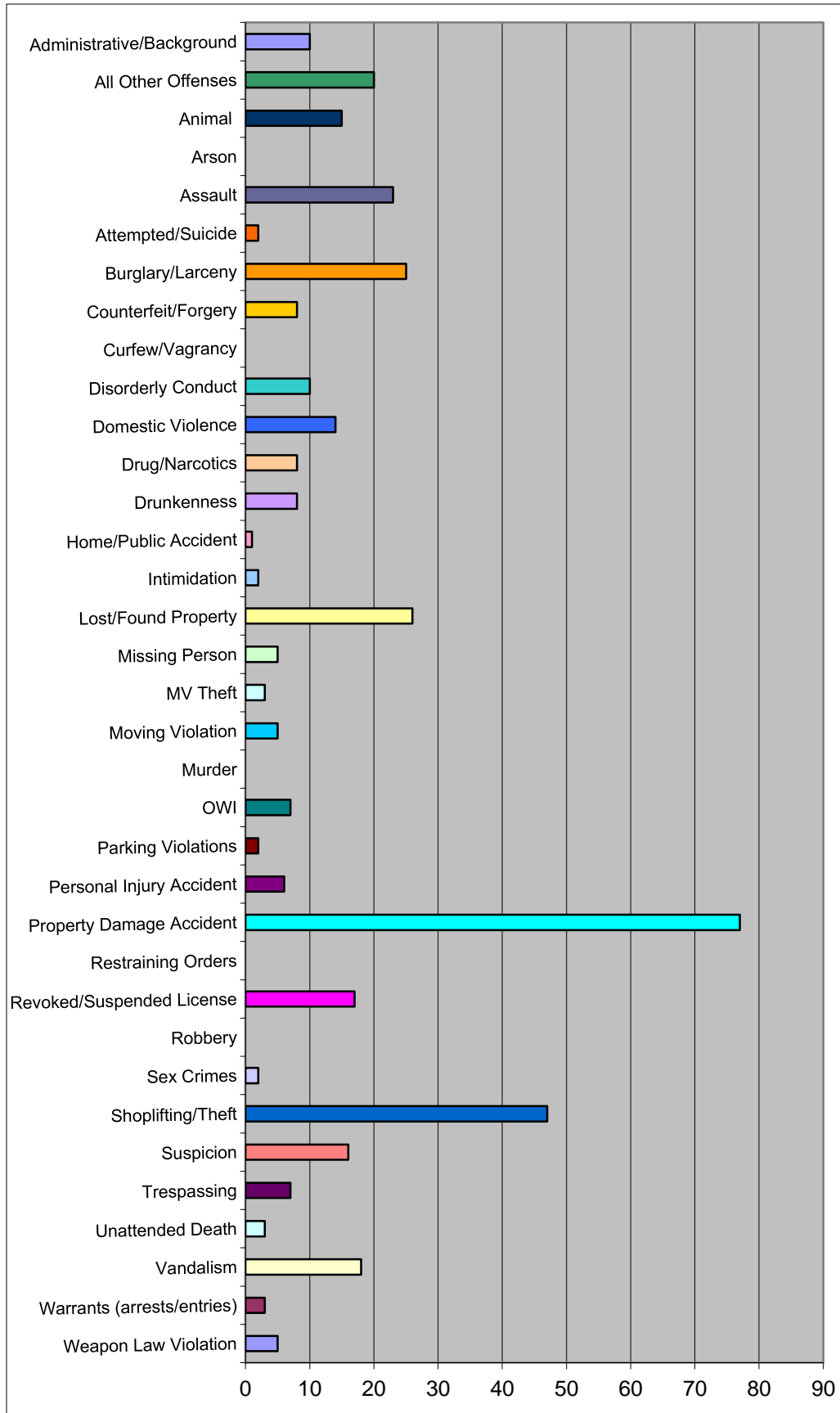
- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

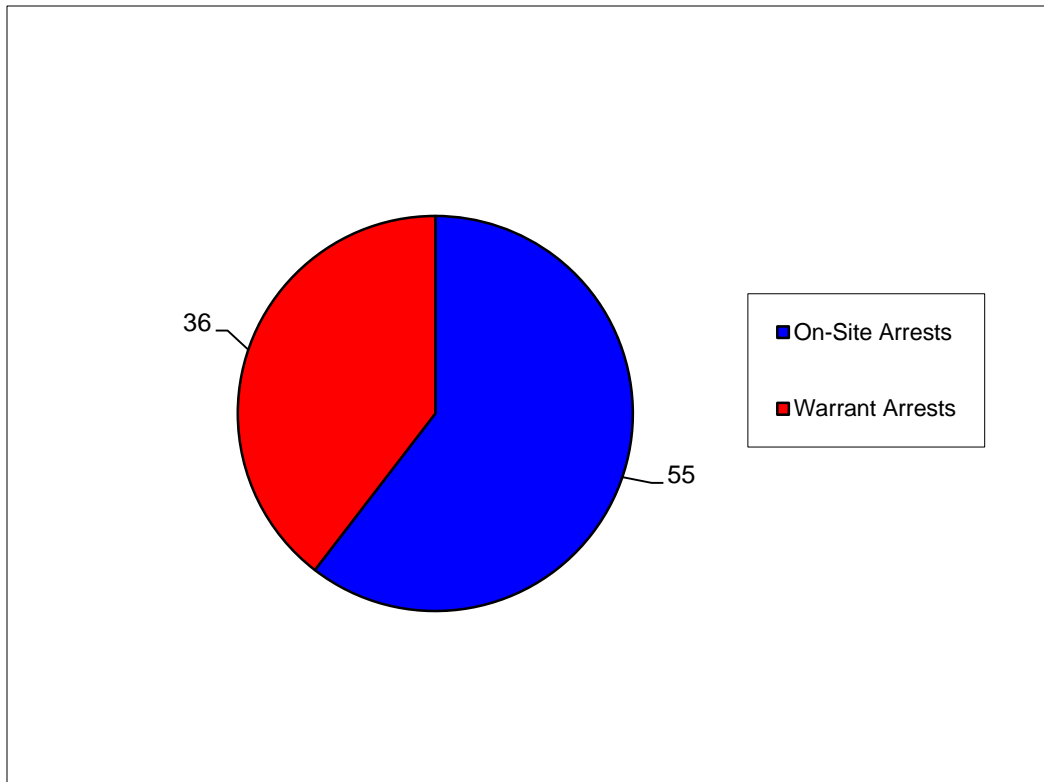
Calls Requiring an Emergency Response by Agency September



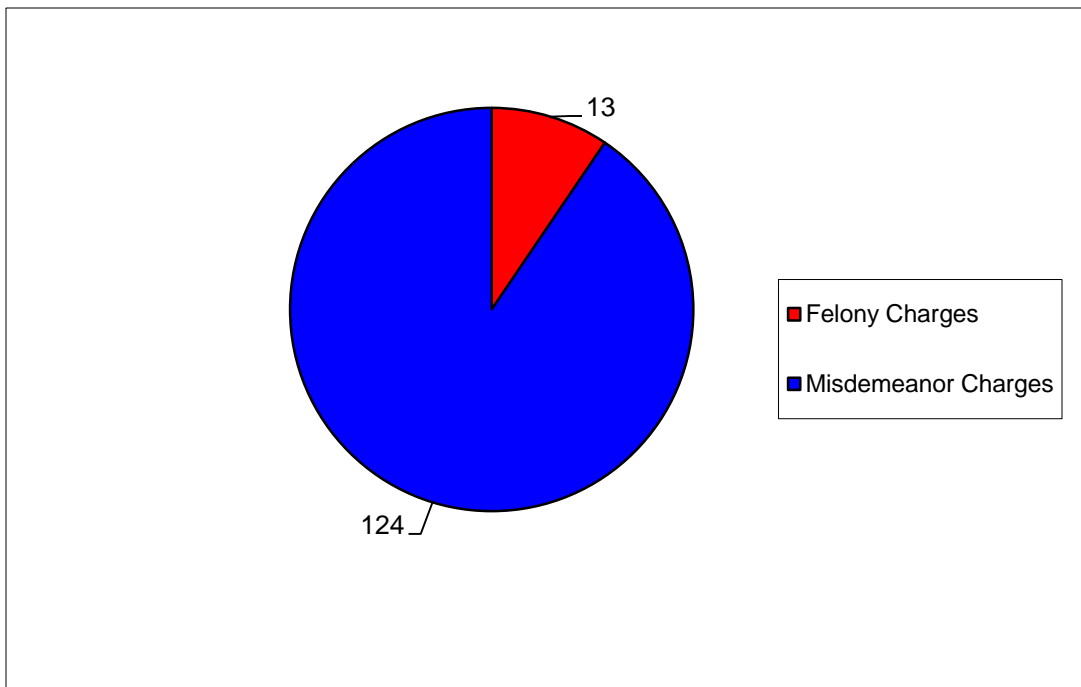
Incidents September 2015
