

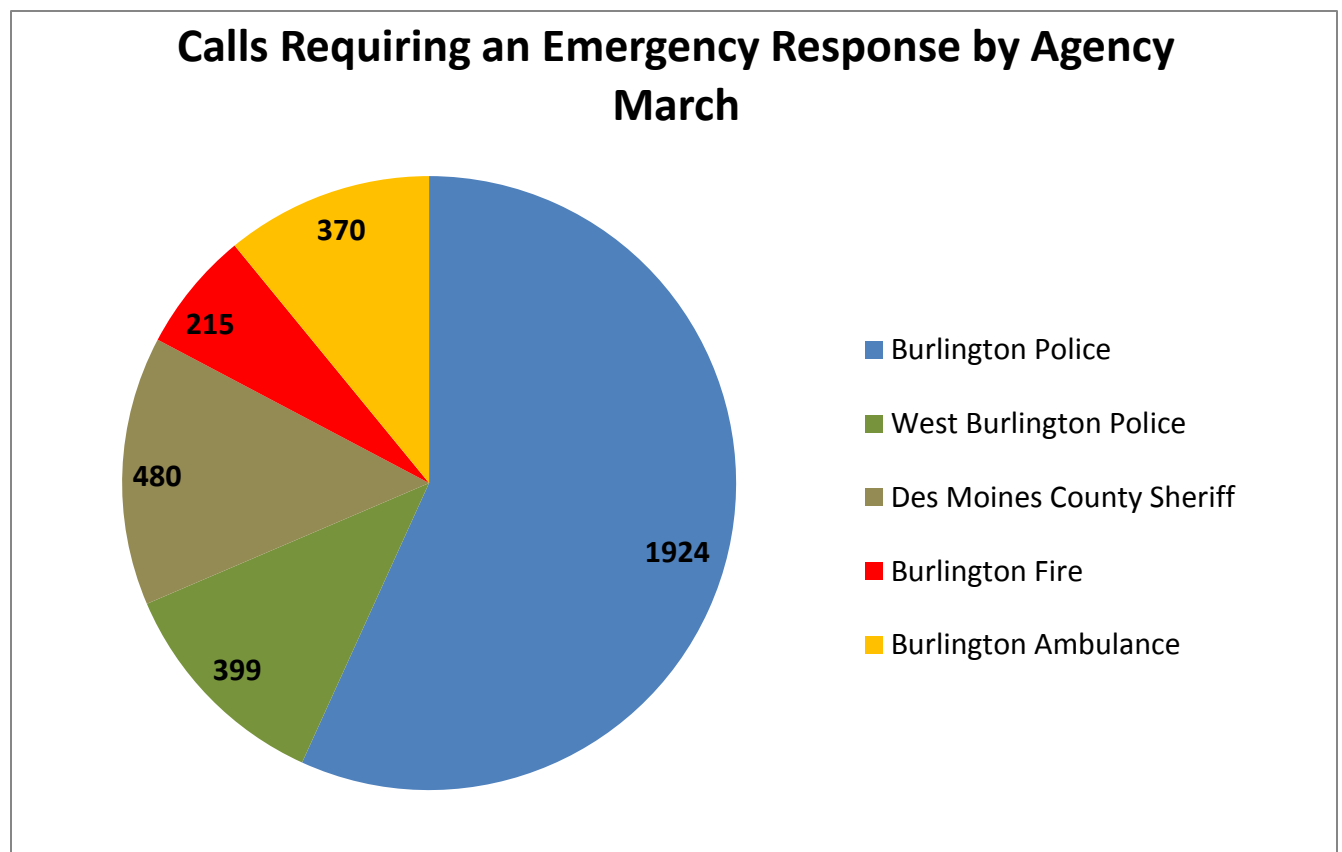
# MEMORANDUM

Re: Police Department Activities – March, 2016

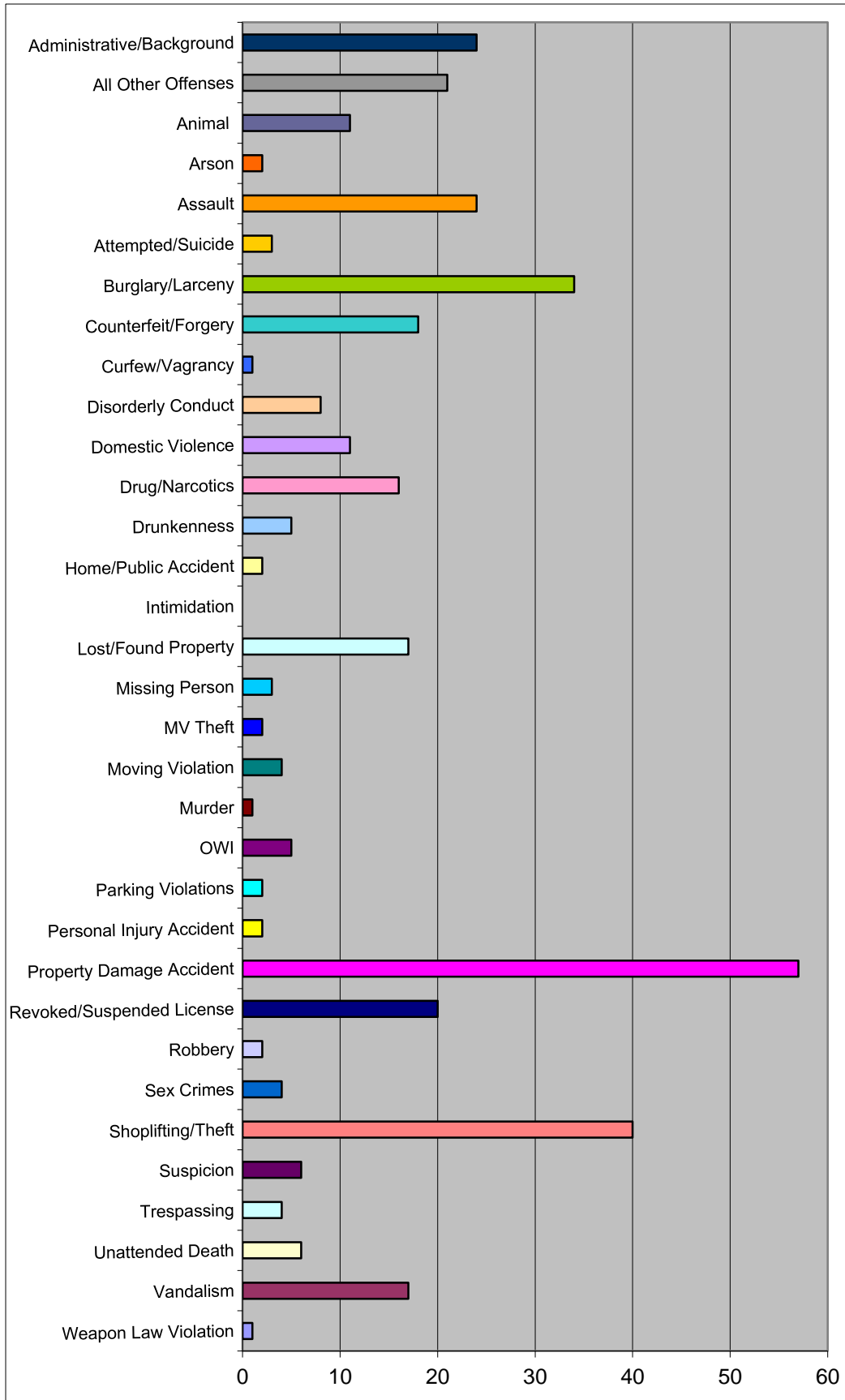


- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

- Major Kramer participated in the Downtown Partner's parking study committee meeting.

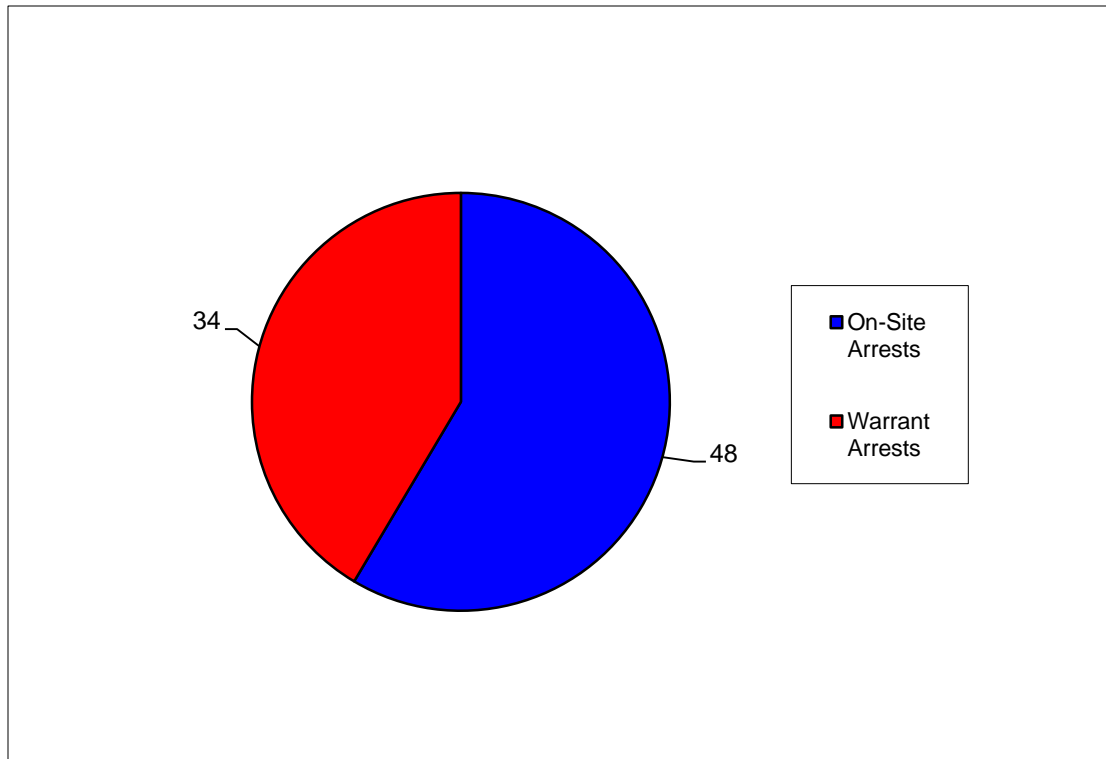
- The Chief attended the United Way allocation committee meeting.

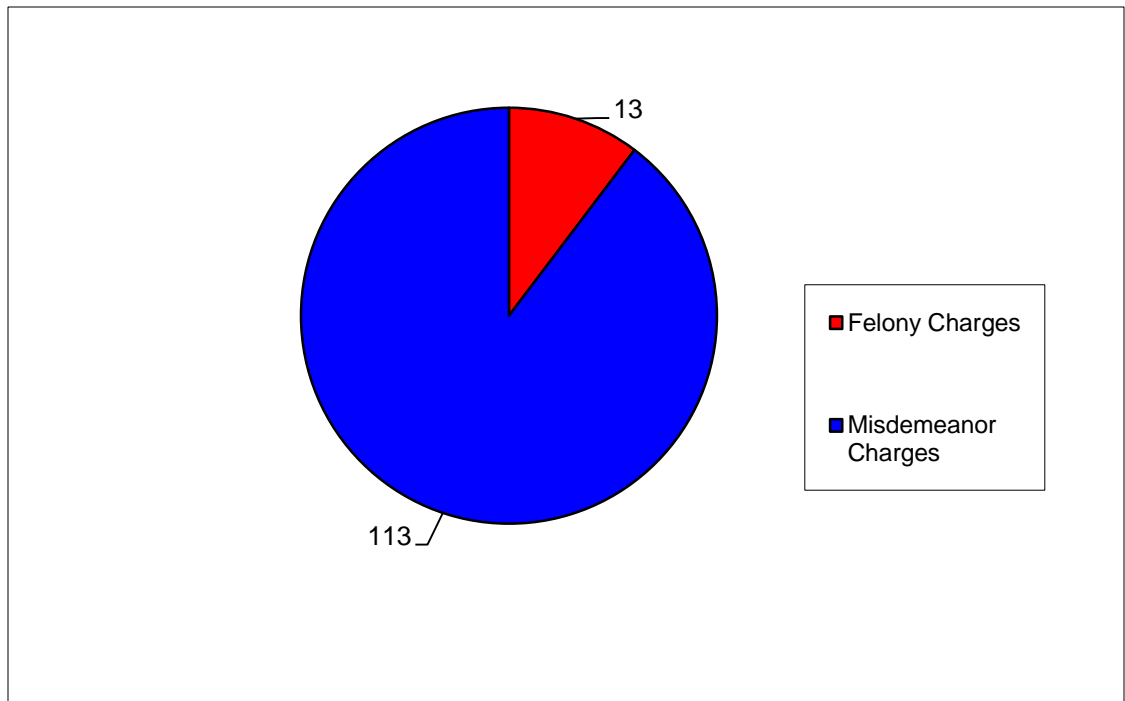
# Incidents March 2016
