

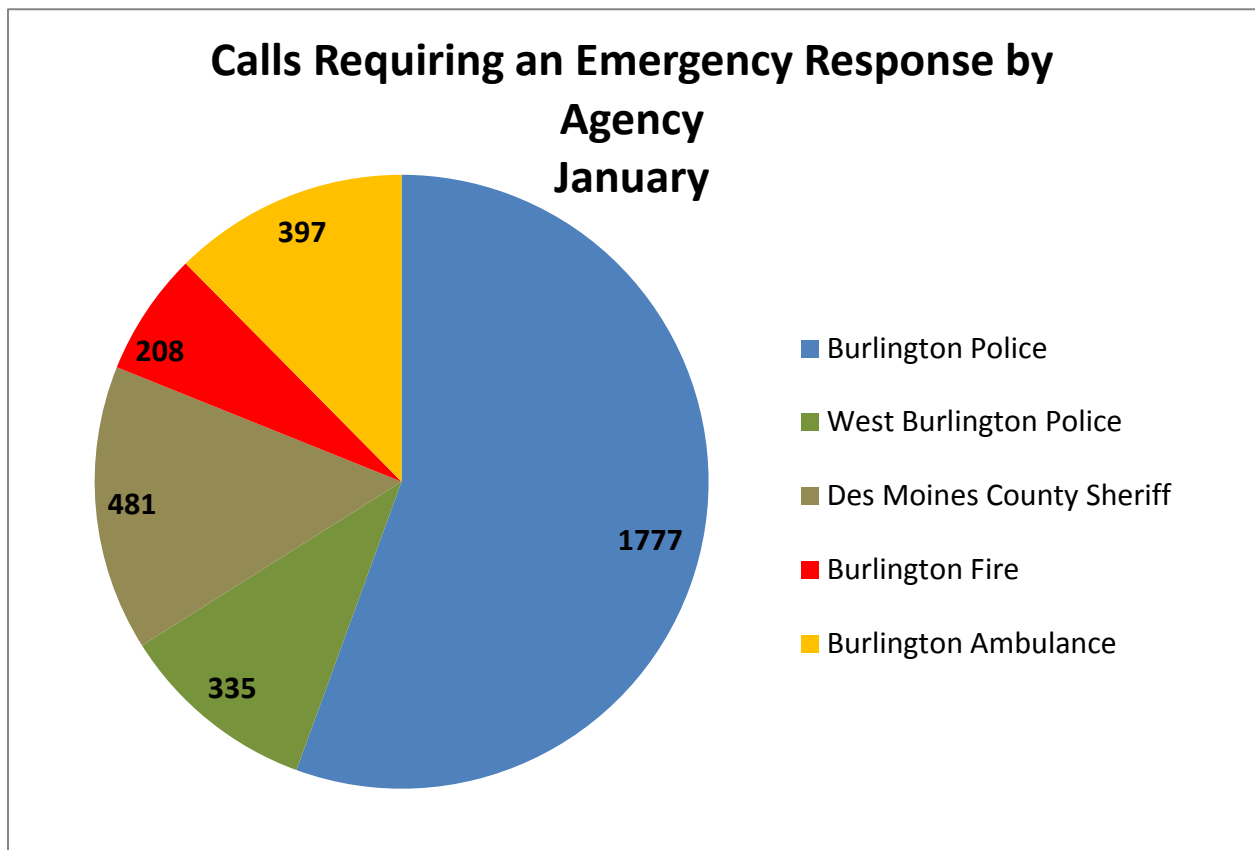

Re: Police Department Activities – January, 2016

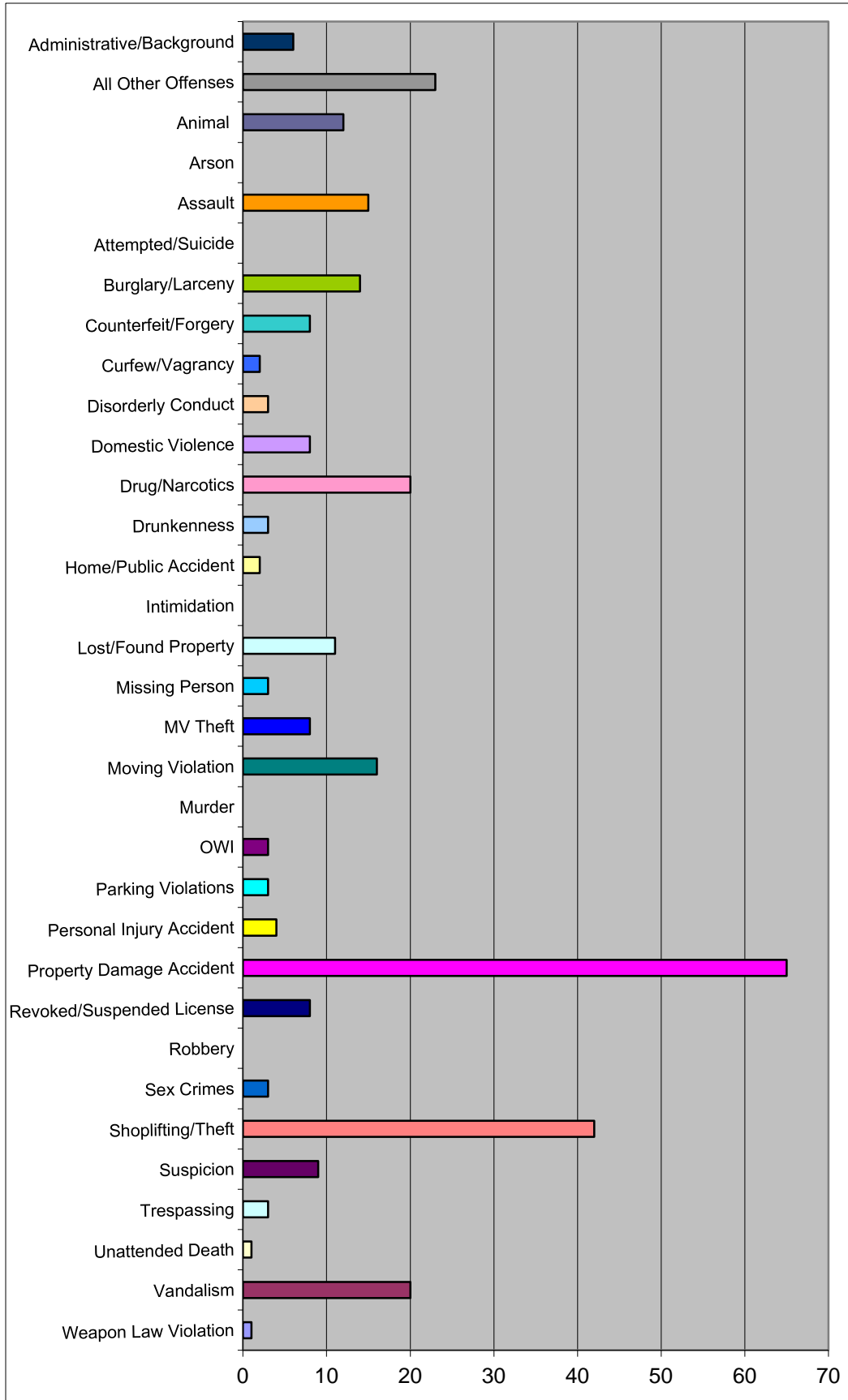


- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

- Major Grimshaw was a guest presenter at the Lion's Club.

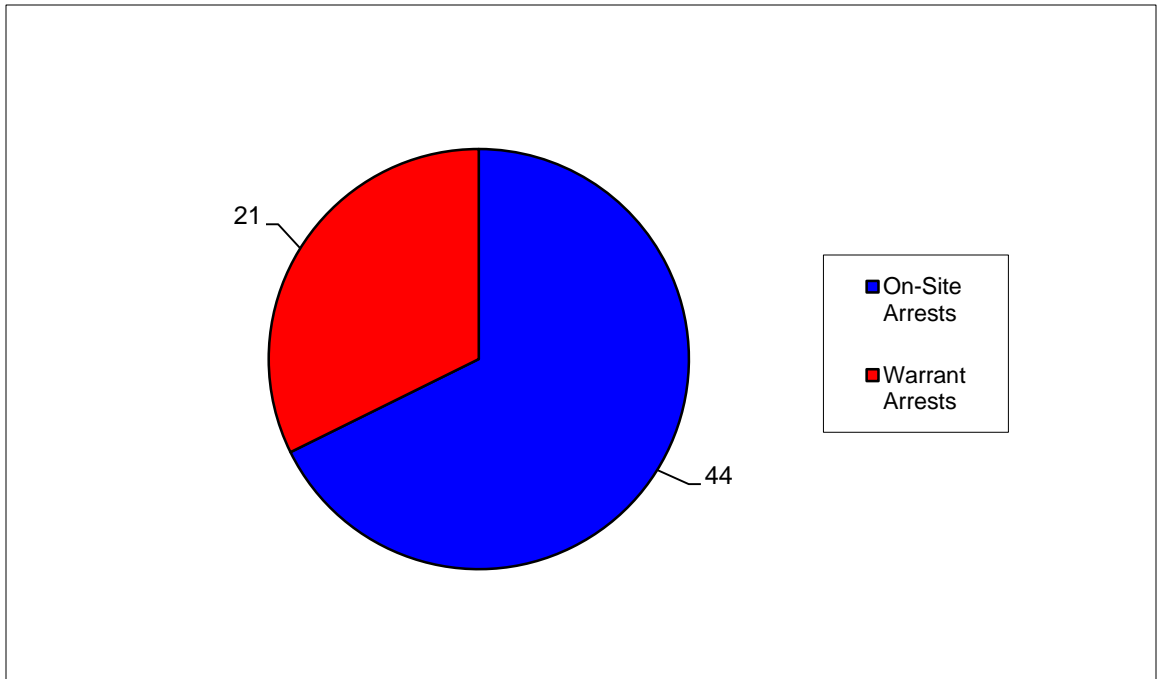
- Chief Beard attended the Bibles, Badges and Business forum at St. Ambrose University.

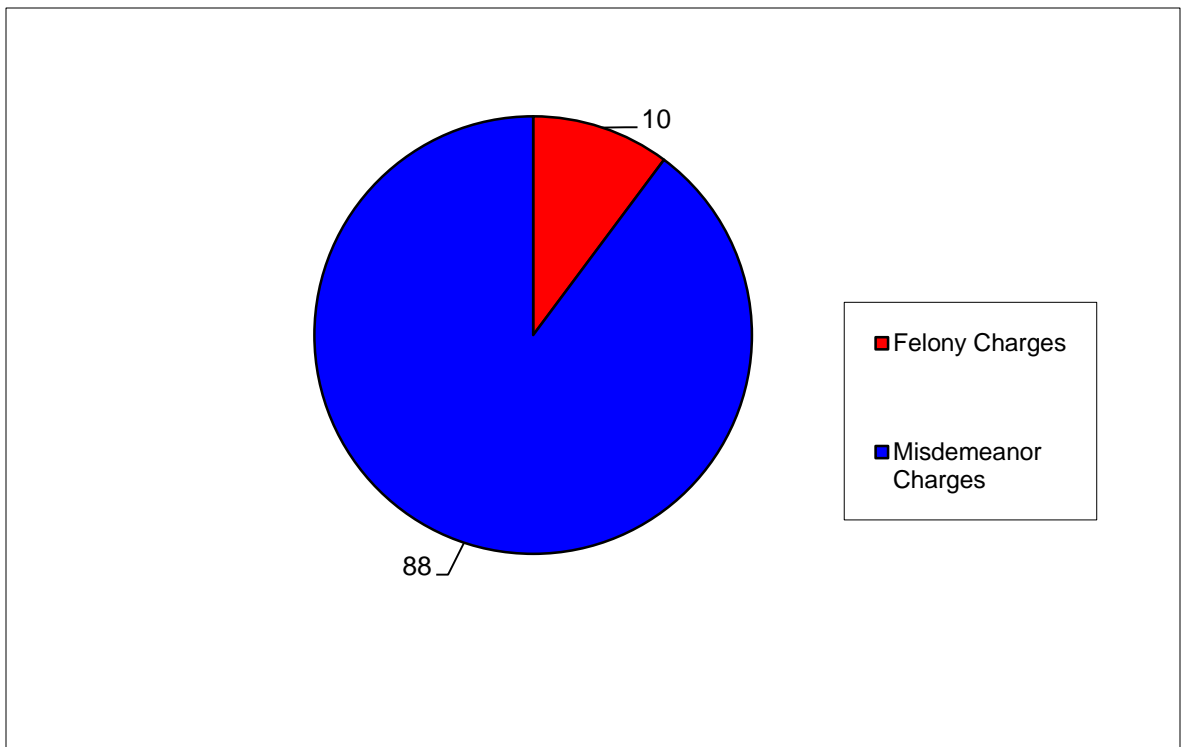
Incidents January 2016
