Re: Police Department Activities – July 2014

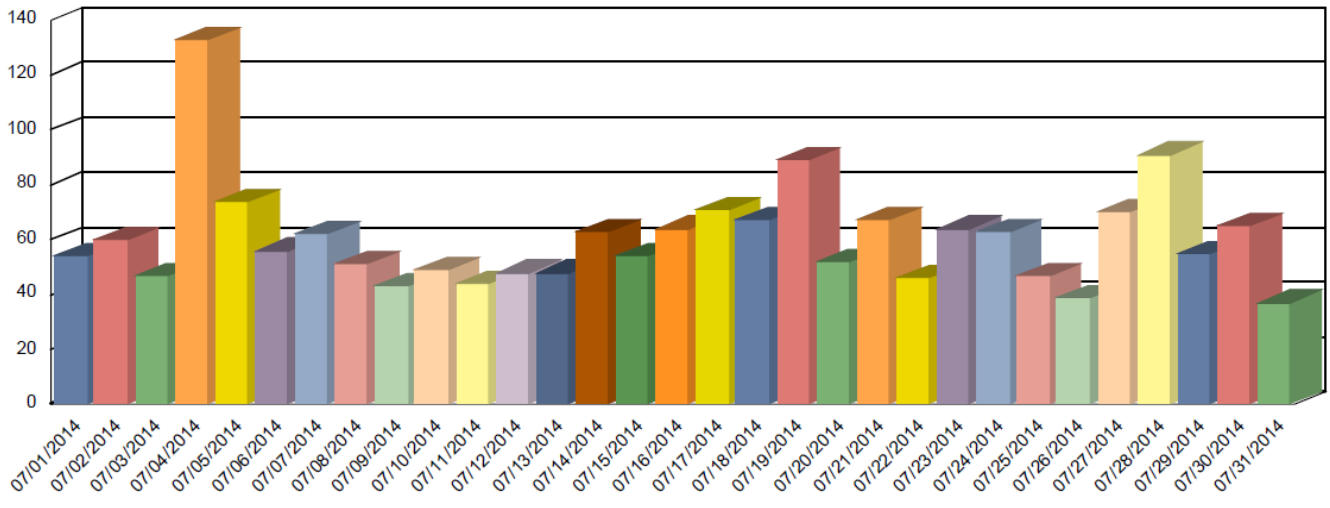


- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

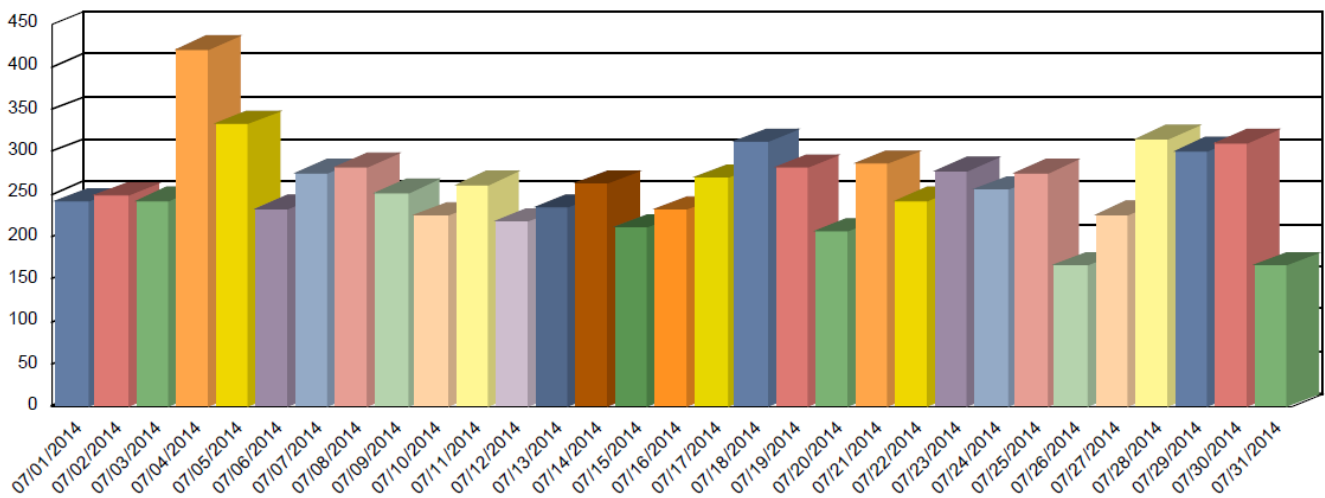
Incoming 9-1-1 Calls July 2014

Number of Calls : 1,873

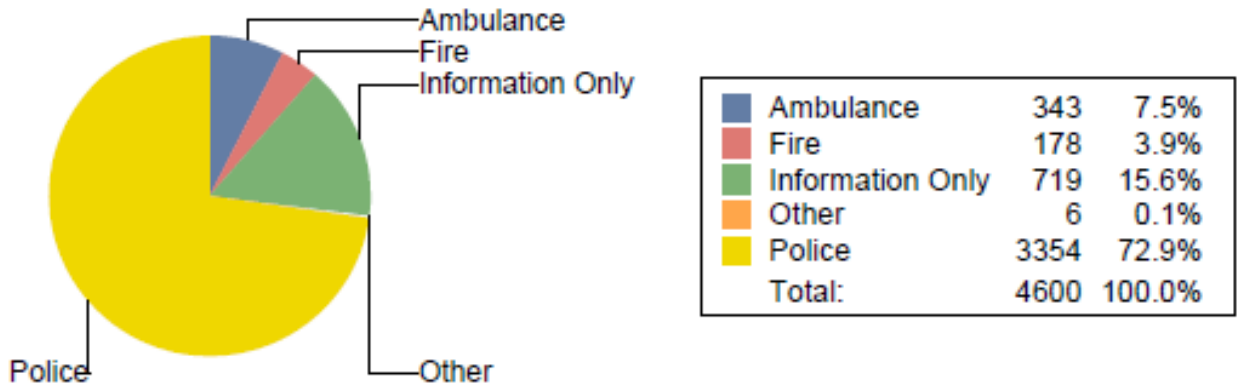


Incoming Calls to the Communications Center July 2014

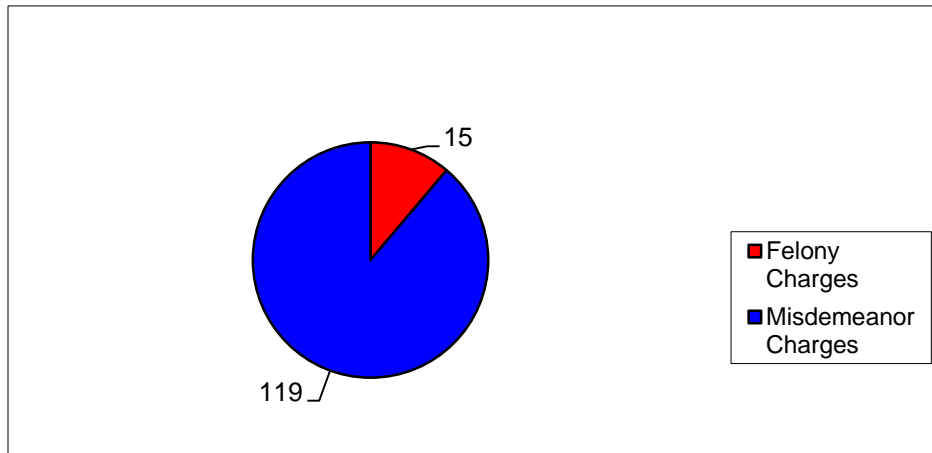

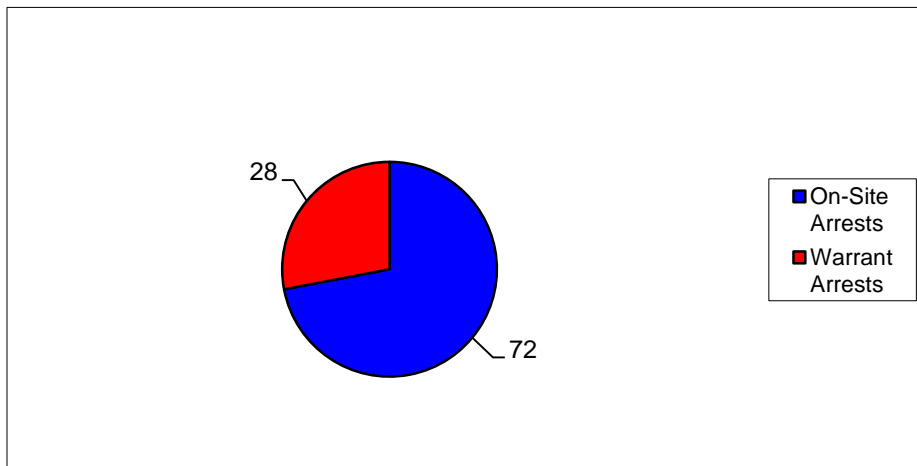
Calls for Service July 2014



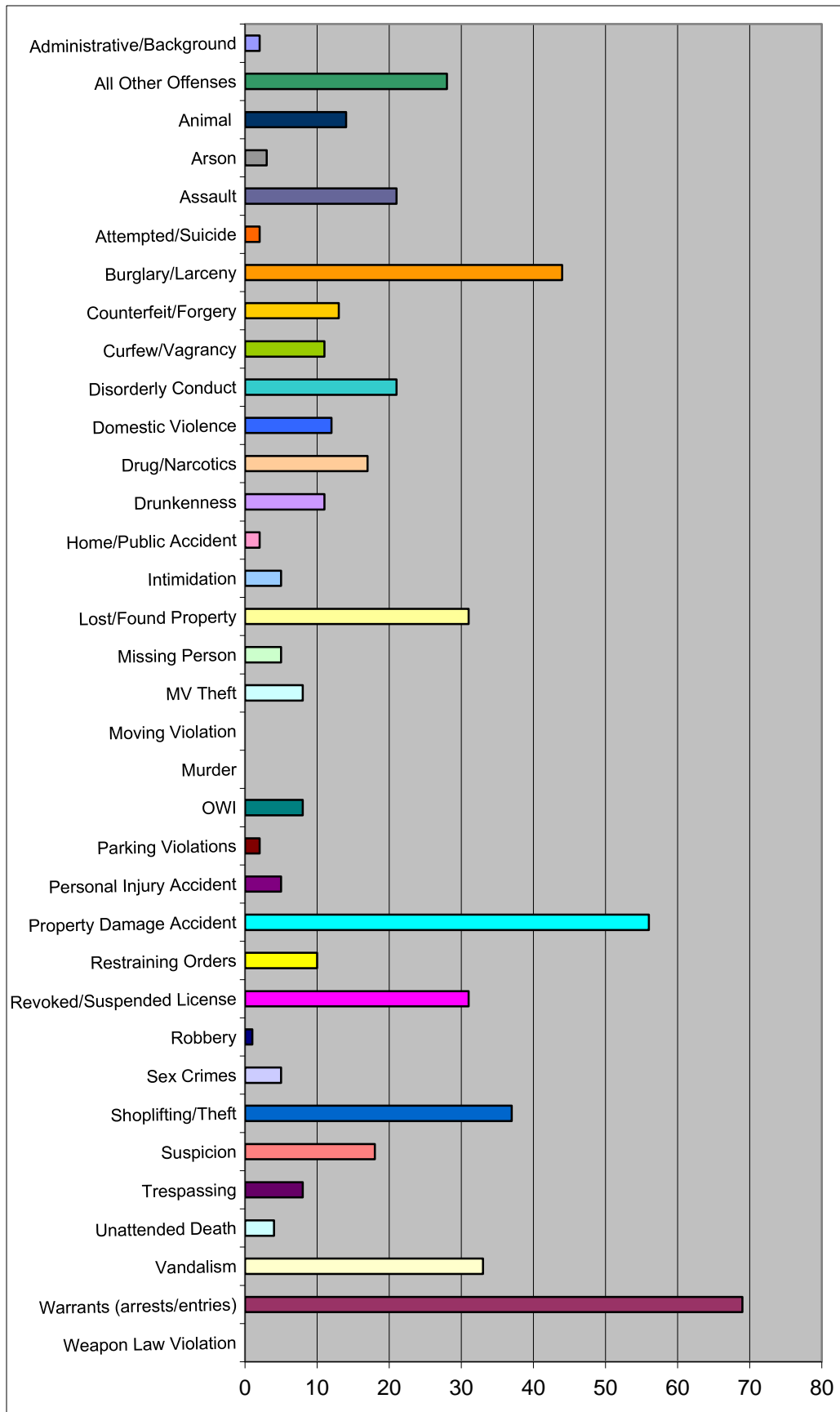
Charges July 2014
