

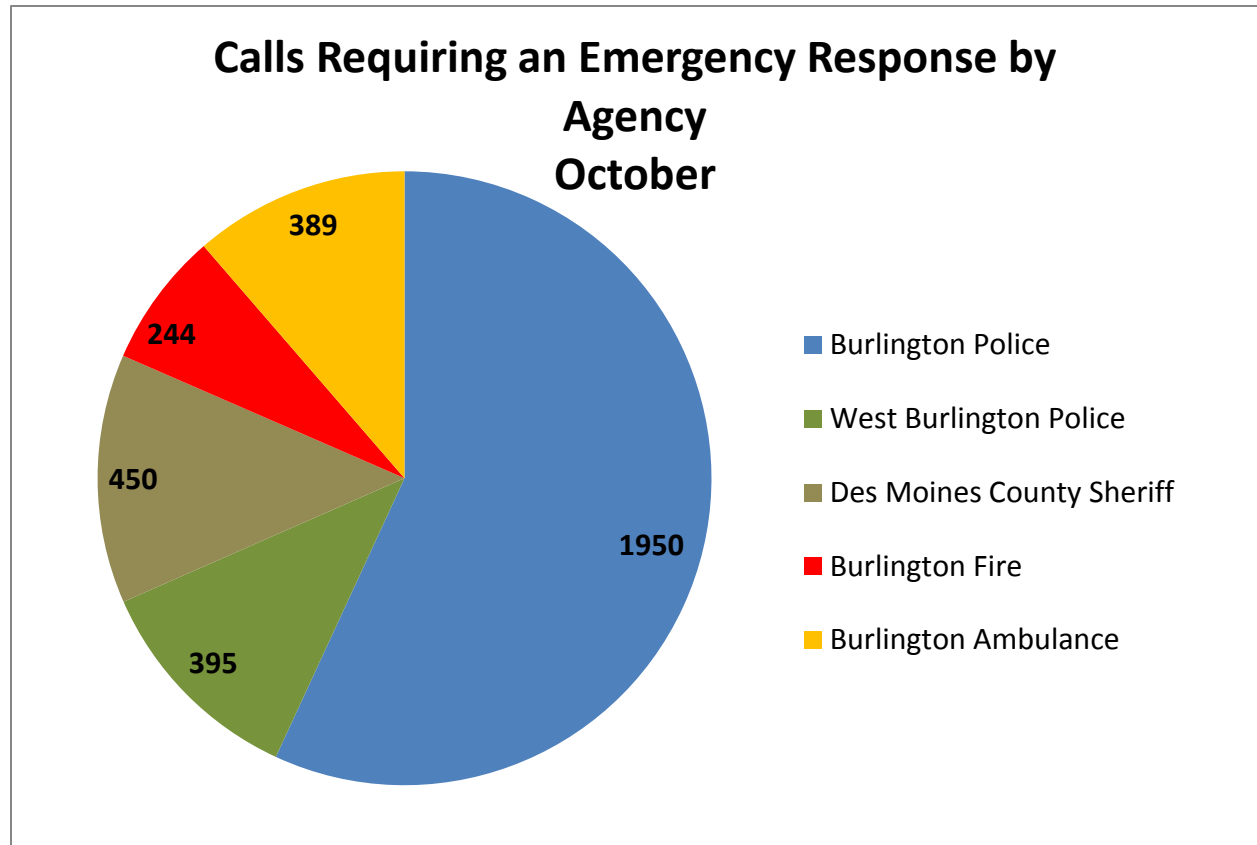

Re: Police Department Activities – October, 2015

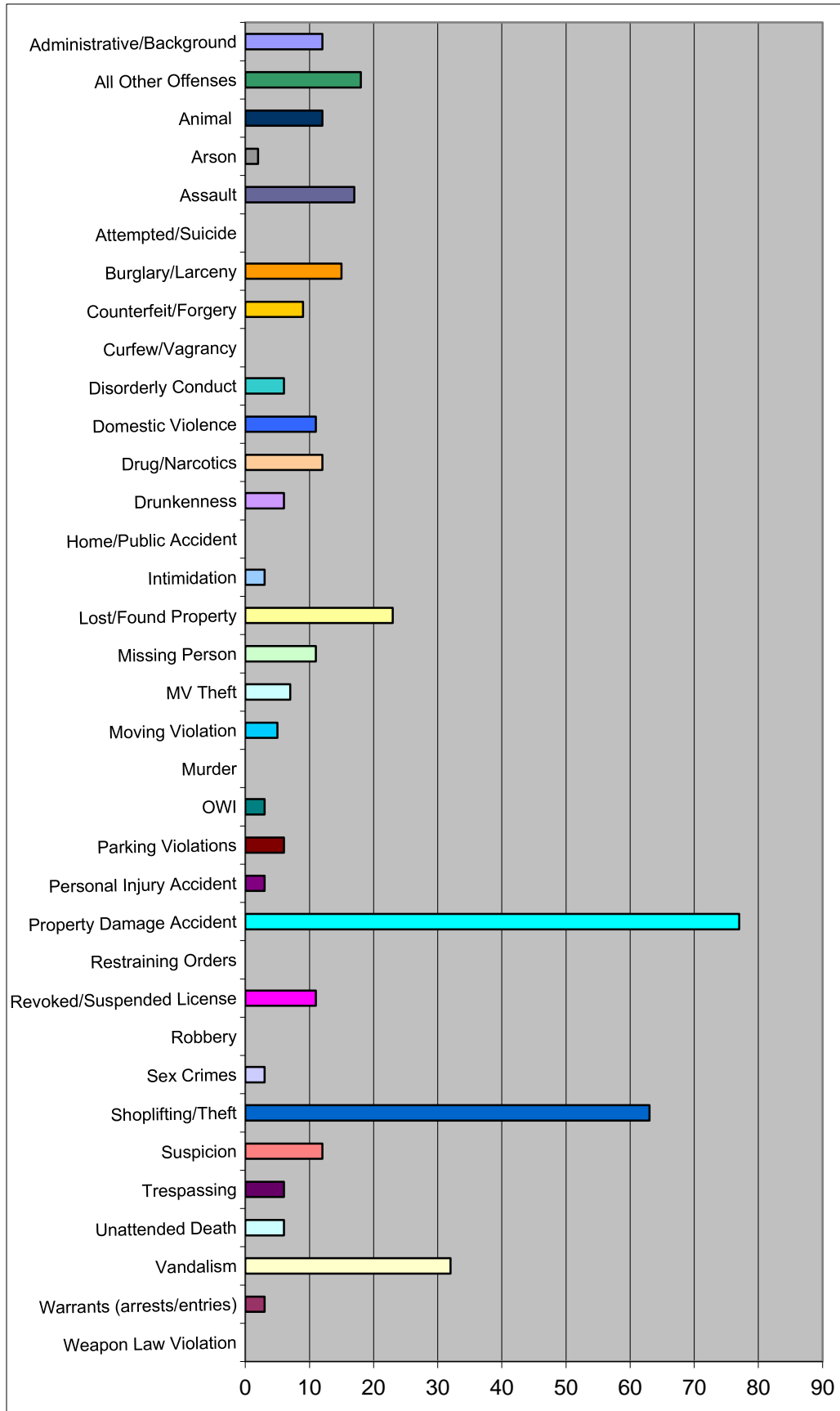


- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

- The Landlord Education Training Series was taught by police officers at the Burlington Public Library.

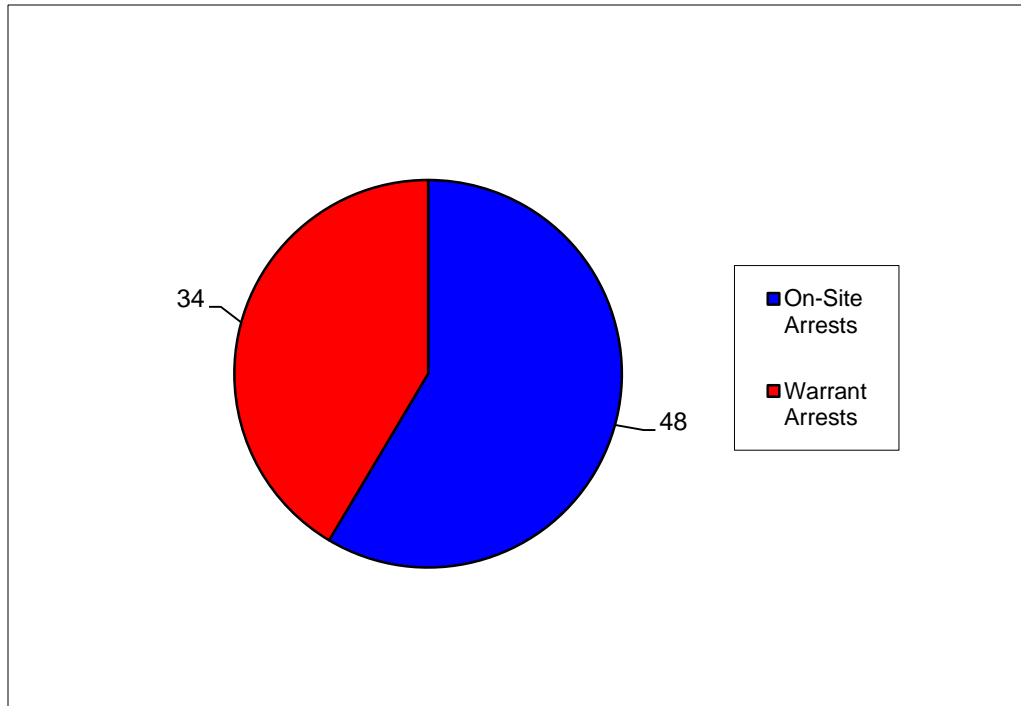
- Chief Beard was a guest on several radio talk shows to discuss the vote and a new police facility in the current U.S. Bank Building.

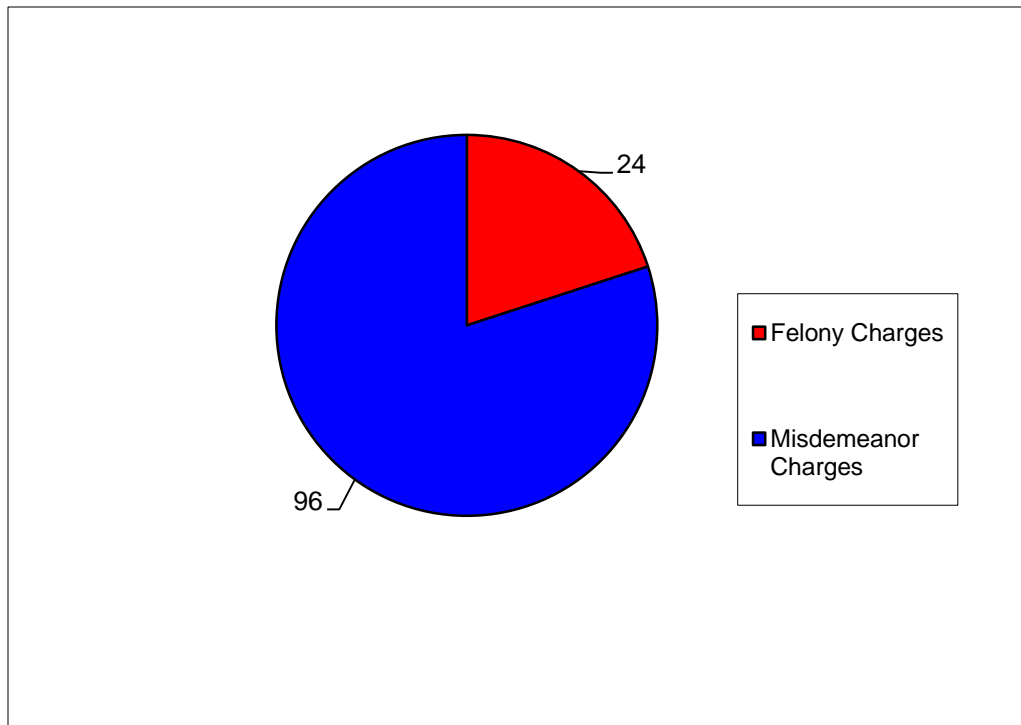
Incidents October 2015
