

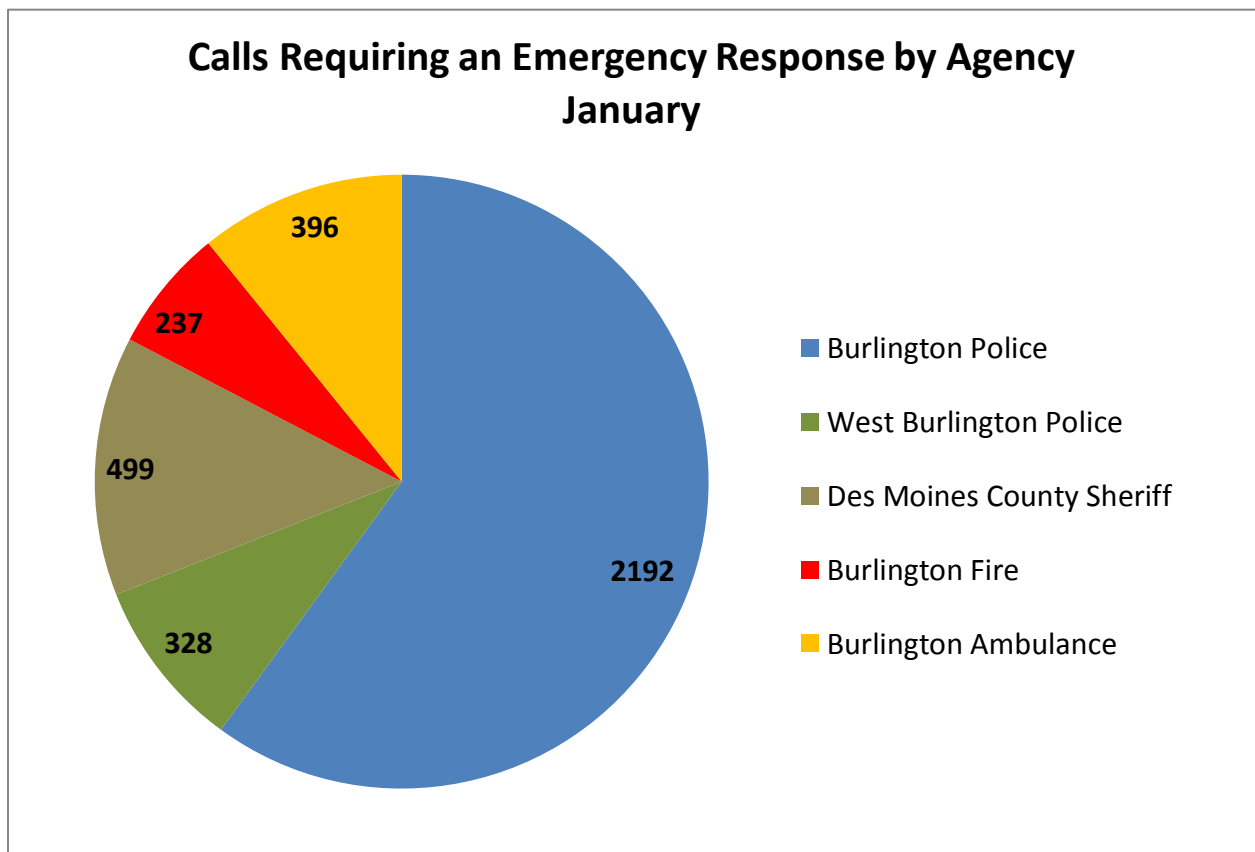

Re: Police Department Activities – January, 2017

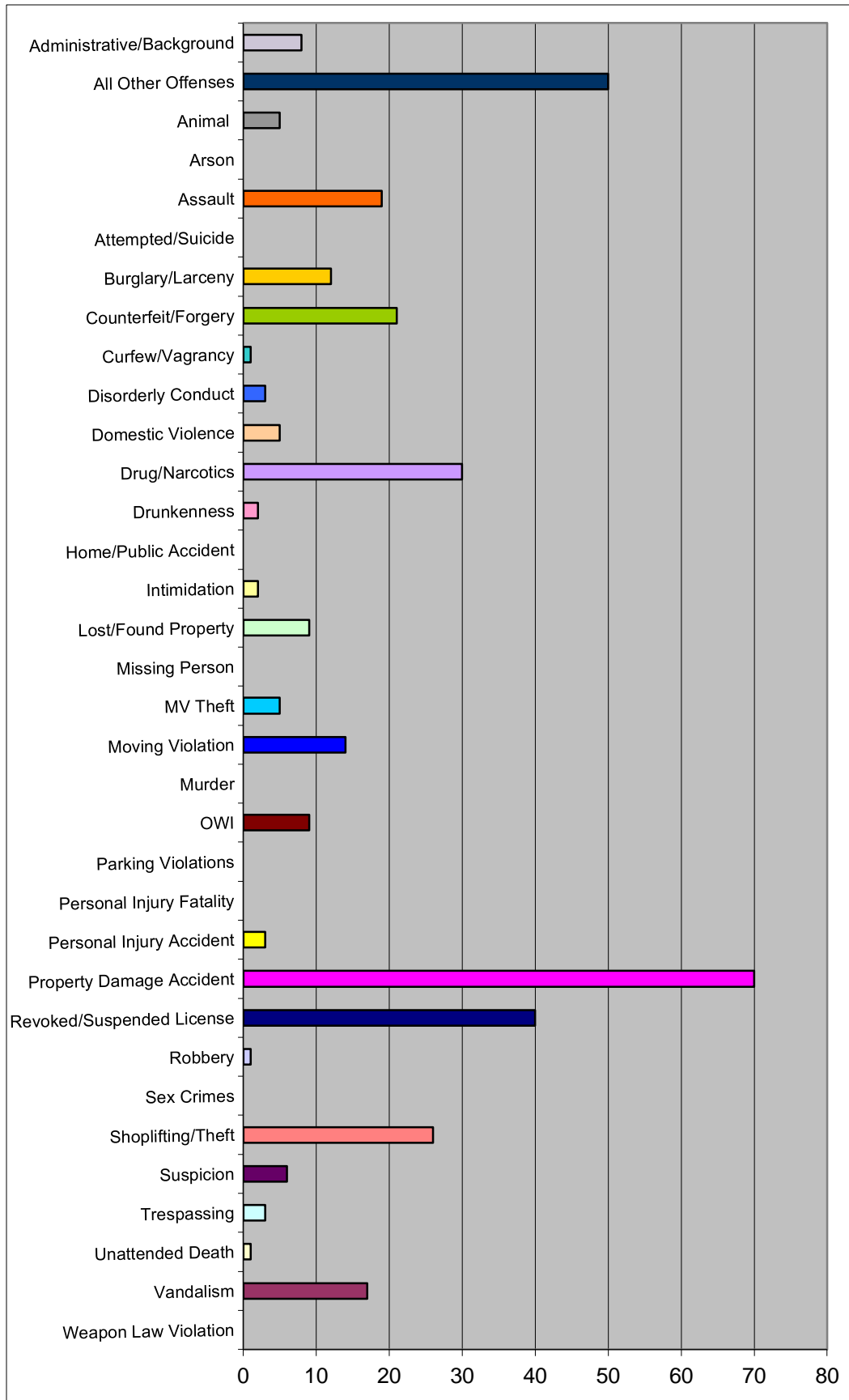


- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

- Major Grimshaw attended the Safe Families event at the Maple Leaf Center.

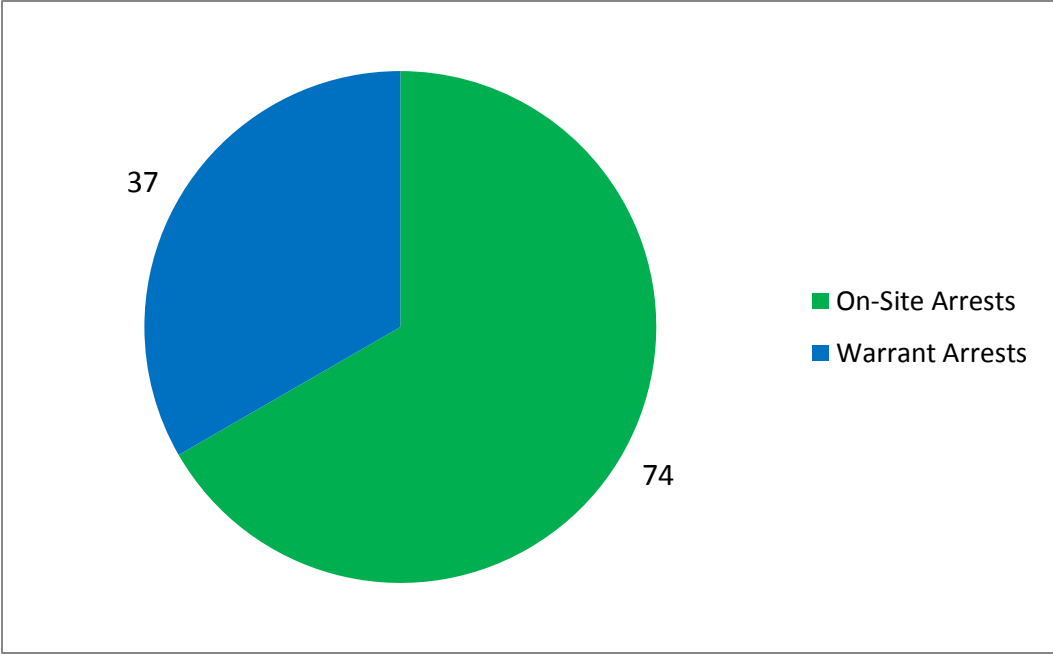
- Major Grimshaw attended Crisis Intervention Team organizational meetings at Henry County Emergency Management and GRMC.

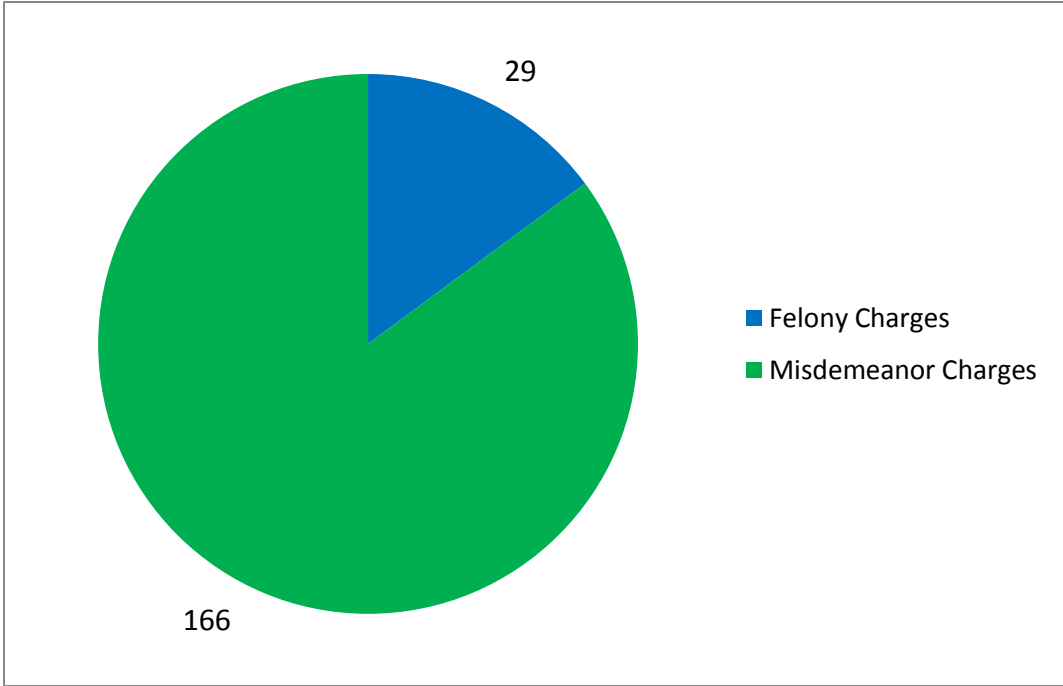
Incidents January 2017
