

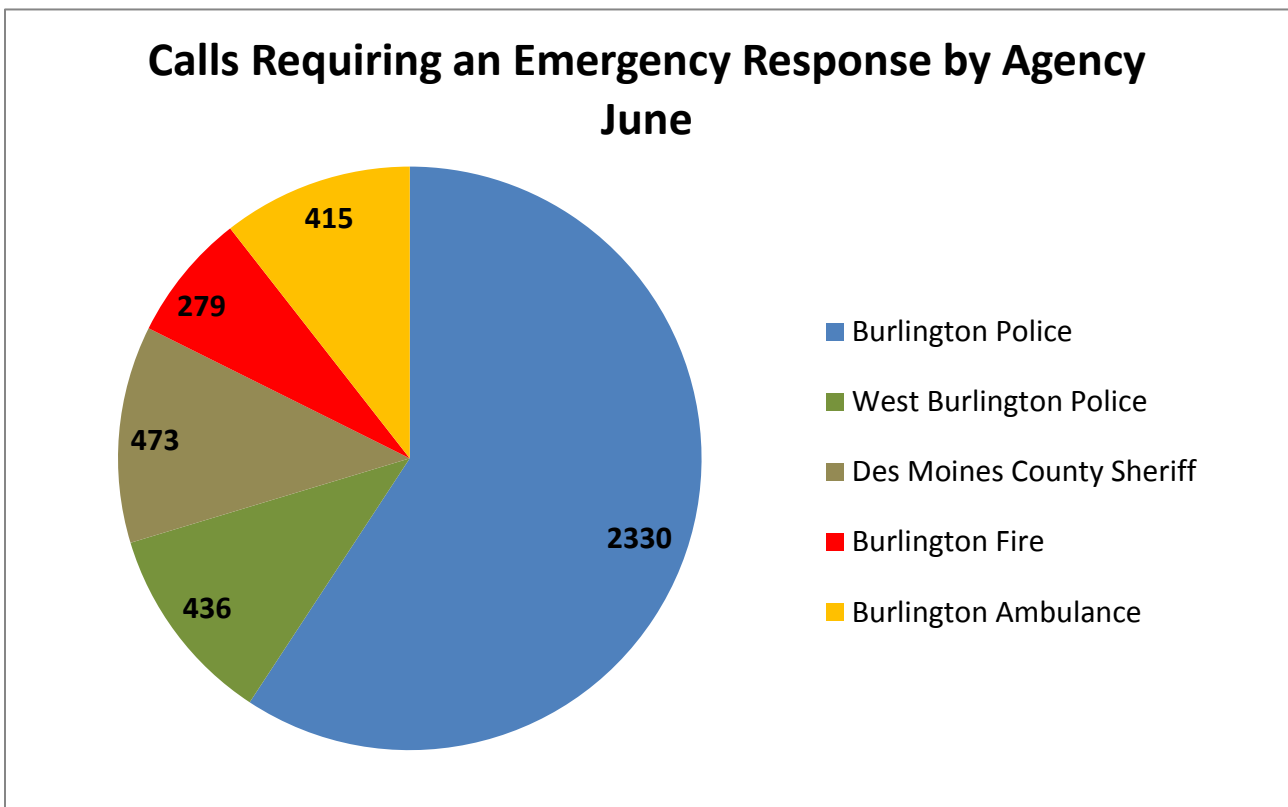

Re: Police Department Activities – June, 2016

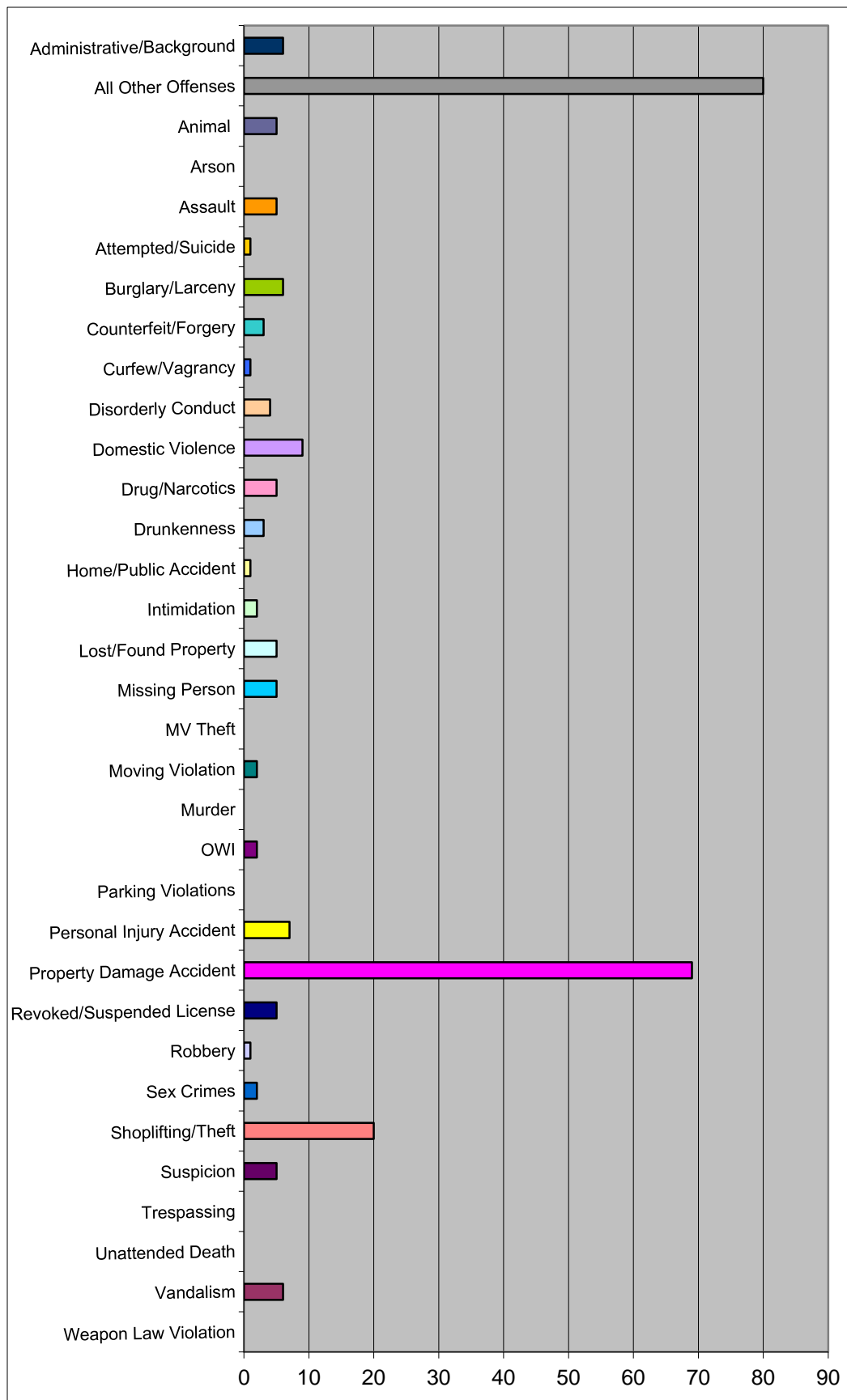


- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

- Administration submitted an application for the 2016 Justice Assistance Grant.

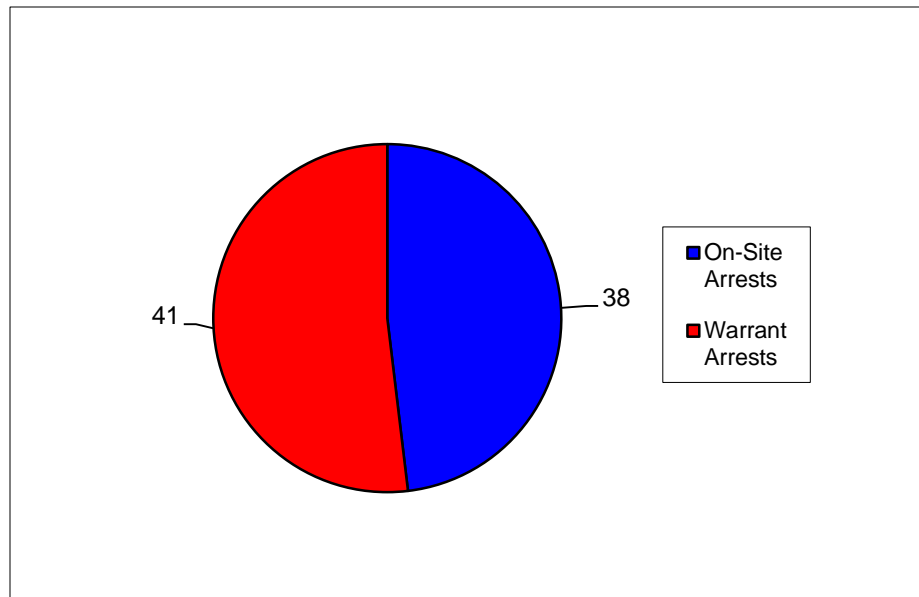
- Administration participated in a walk-thru (plan review) with James Estes at the US Bank building.

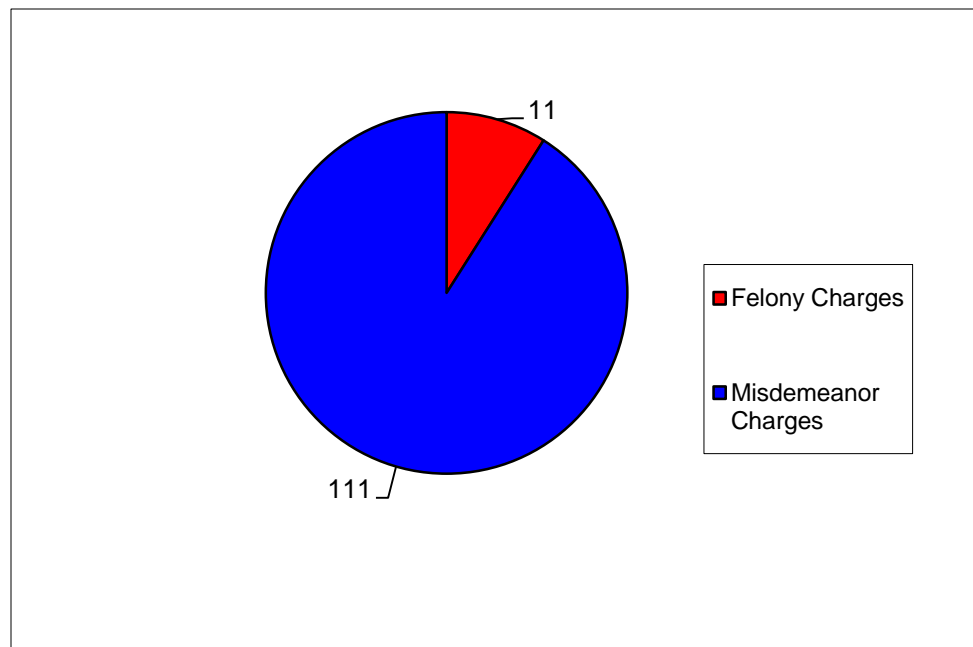
Incidents June 2016
