

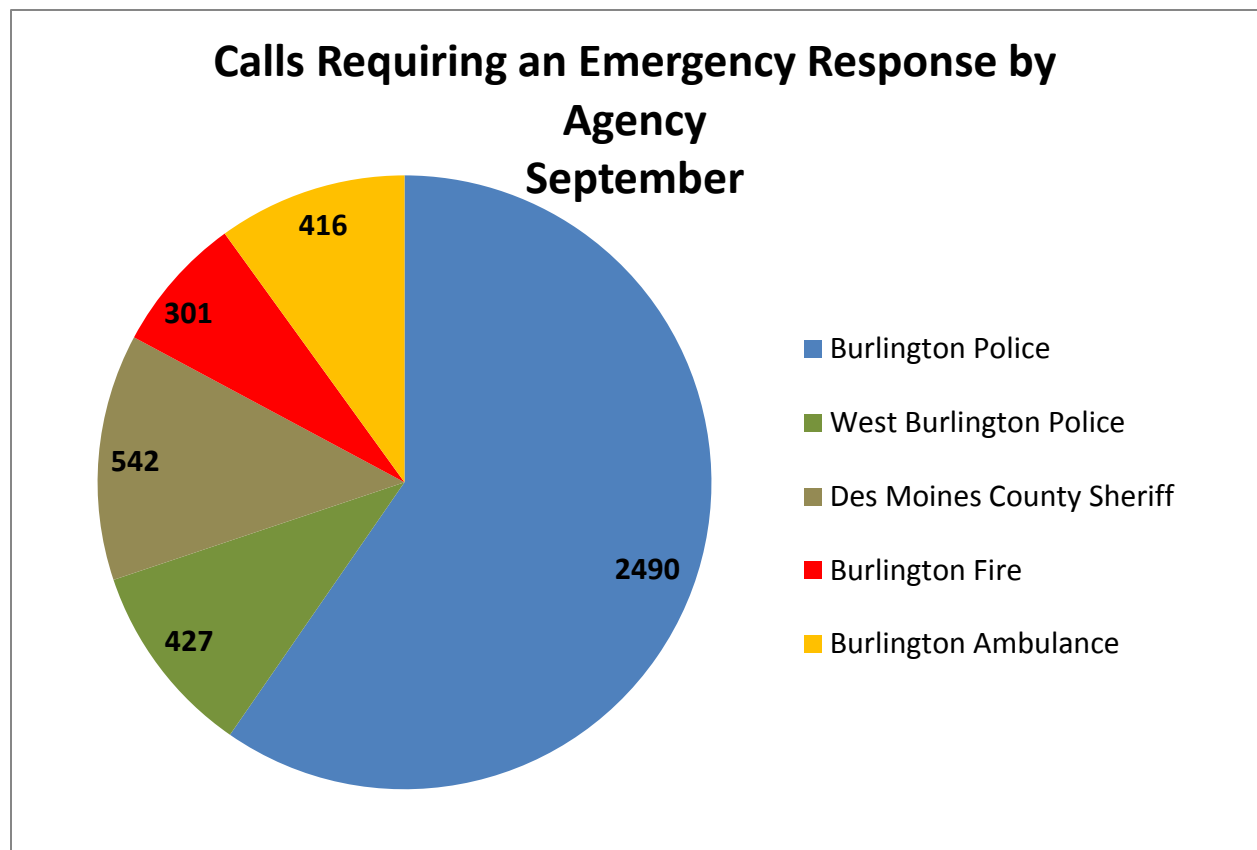

Re: Police Department Activities – September, 2016

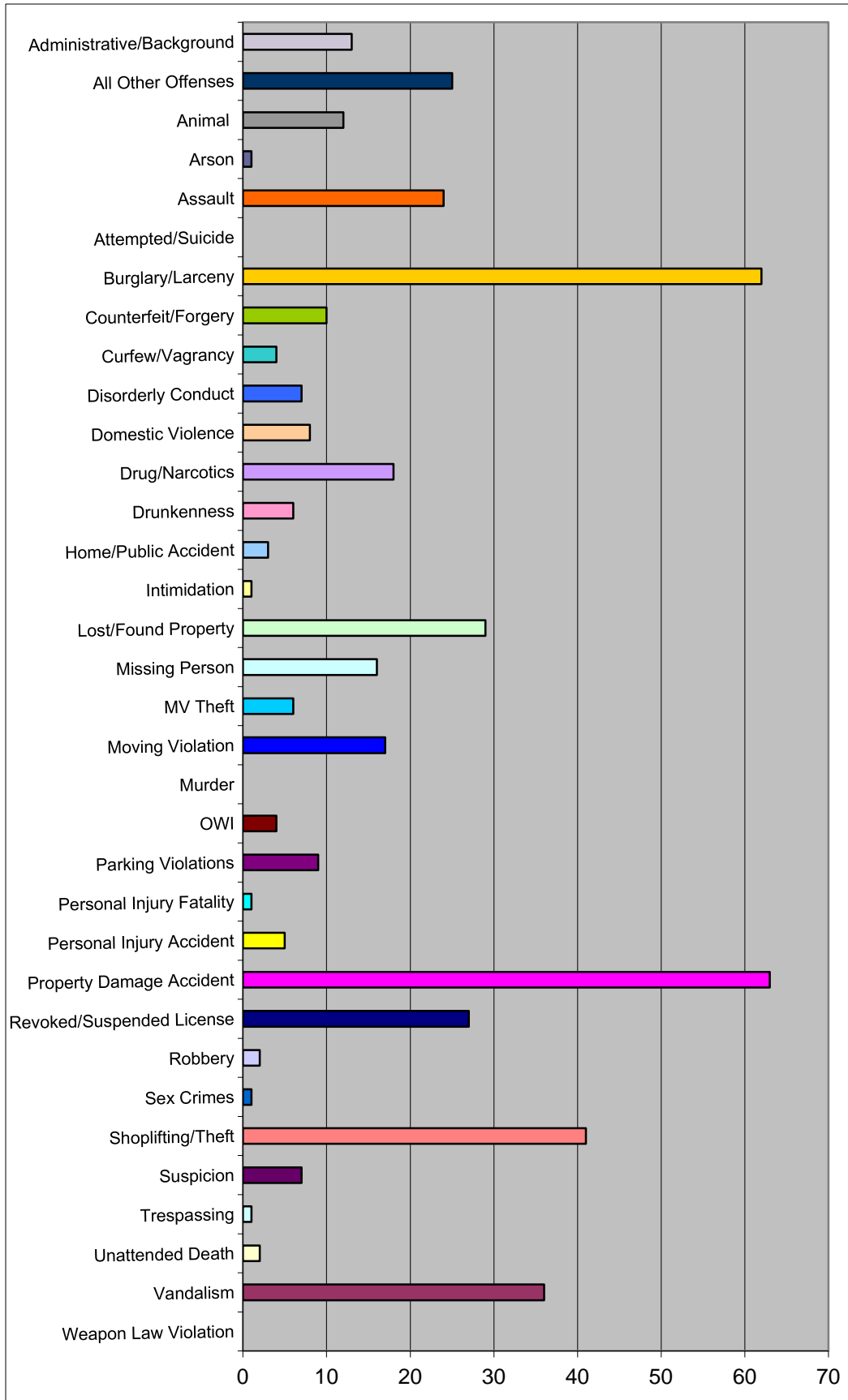


- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

- Chief Beard, Major Kramer and Major Grimshaw attended the United Way kick-off luncheon.

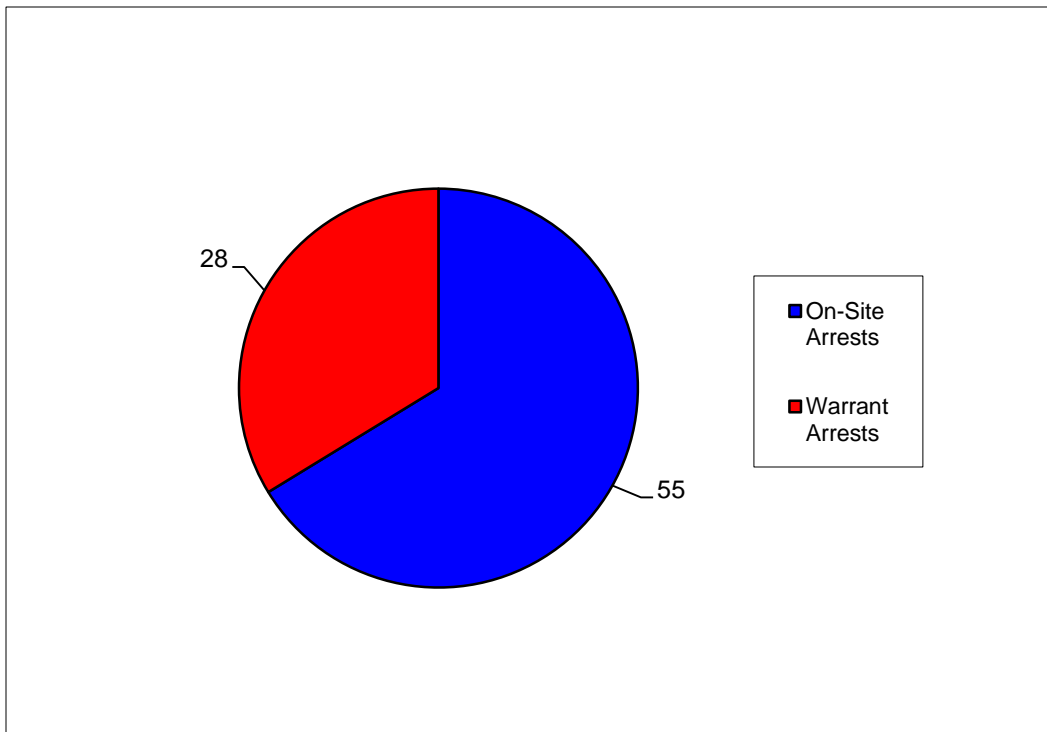
- Chief Beard and Major Kramer accepted a donation from the Van Meter Foundation for the K-9 Unit.

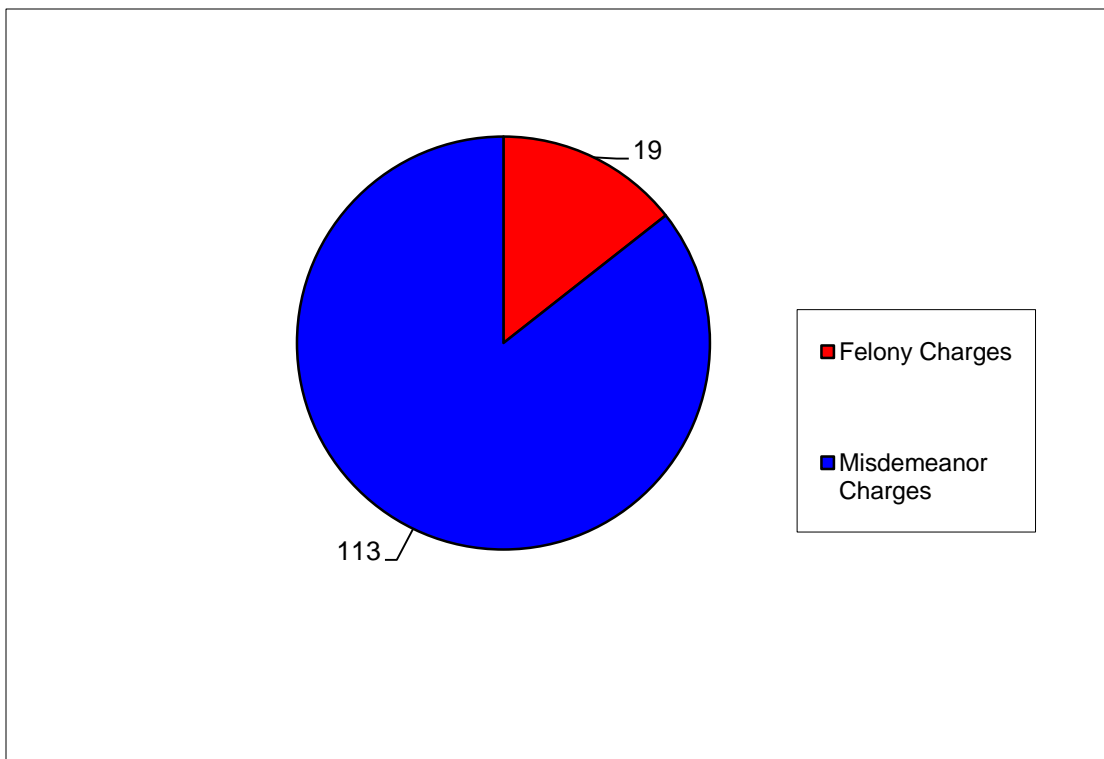
Incidents September 2016
