

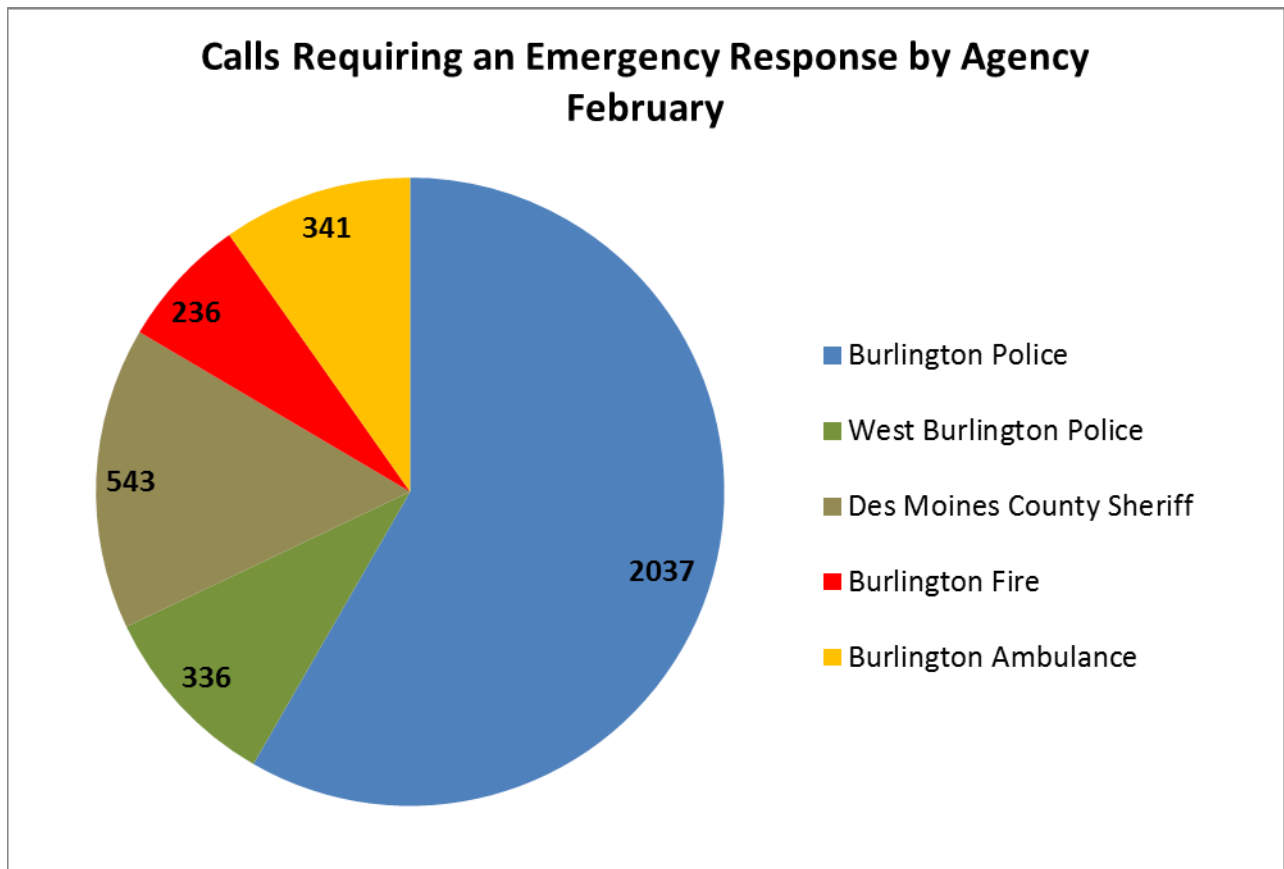

Re: Police Department Activities – February, 2017

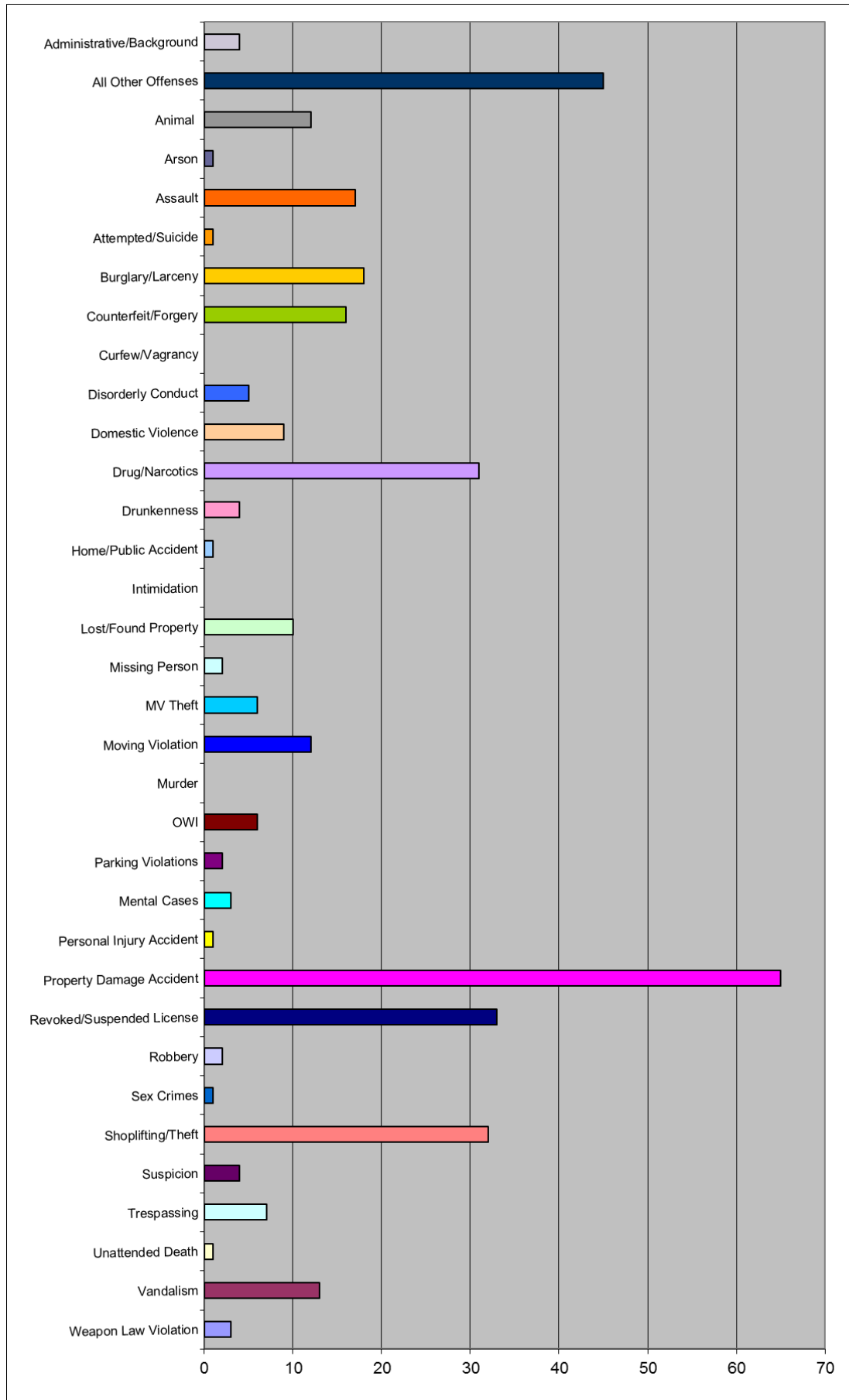


- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

- Major Kramer reviewed the applications received for the part-time Evidence Technician vacancy. Interviews were held.

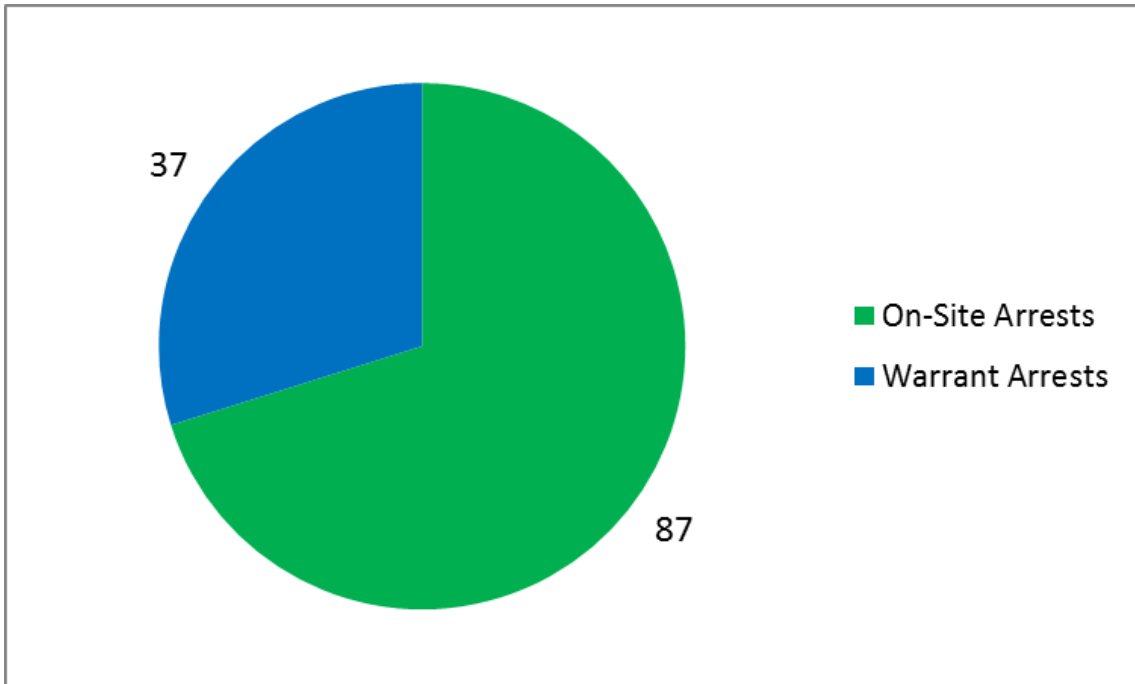
- Chief Beaird and Major Grimshaw presented at the Lions meeting.

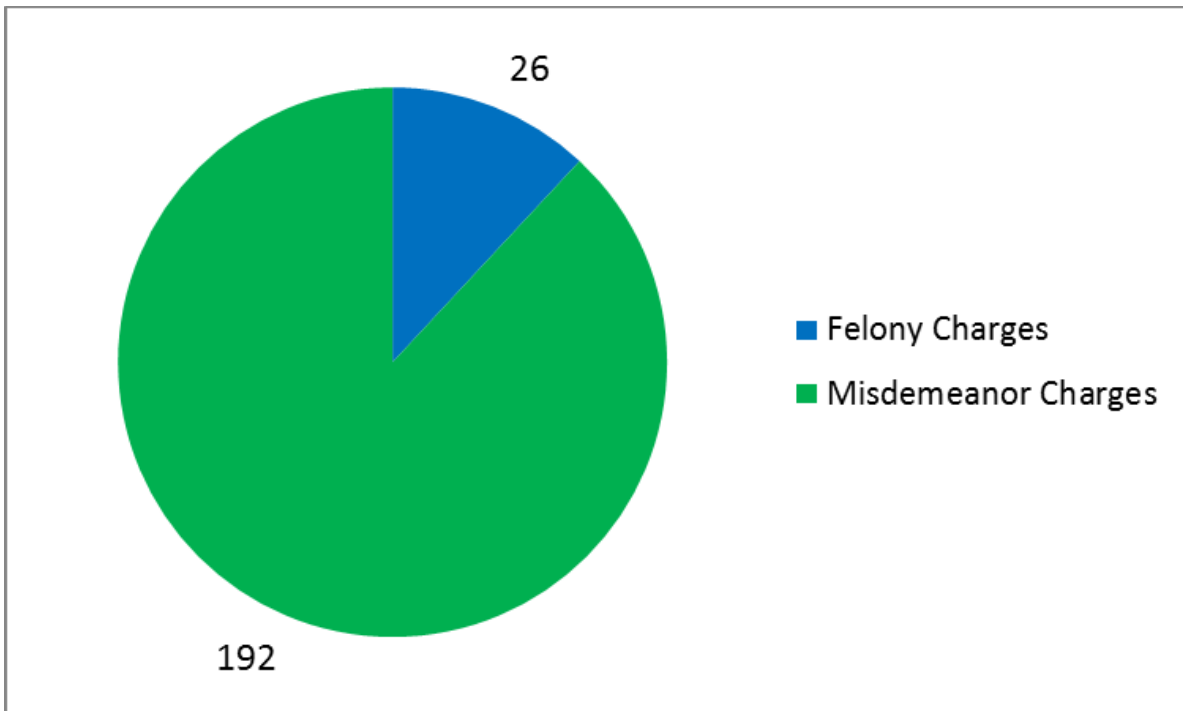
# Incidents February 2017
