- Major Grimshaw presented information about the After School Program's and its relationship with the B.P.D. to the Rotary Club.

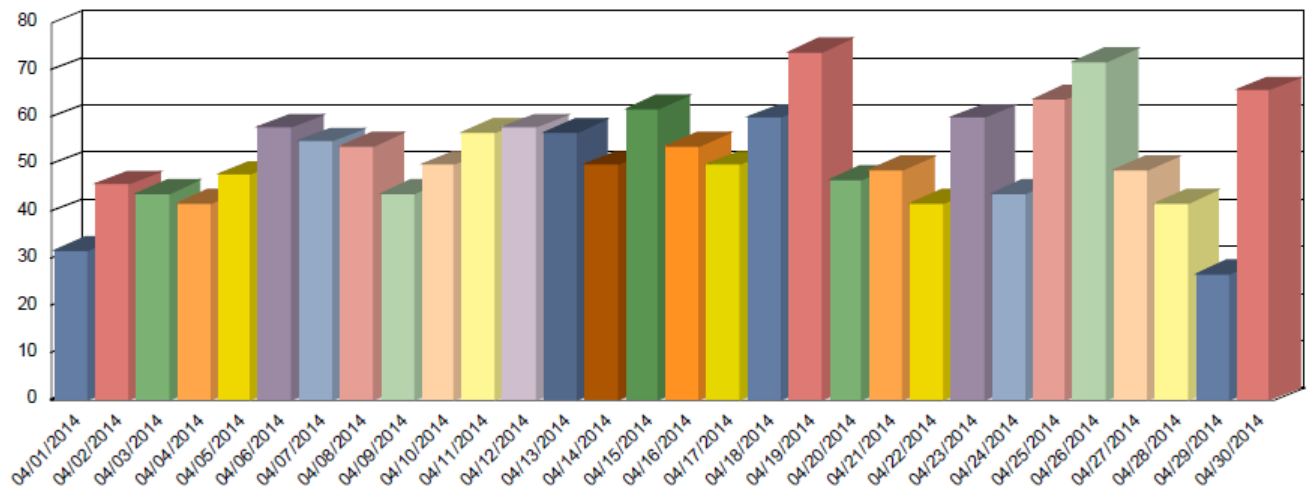
- School Resource Officer interviews were held and officers selected for the high school and middle schools for the upcoming school year.

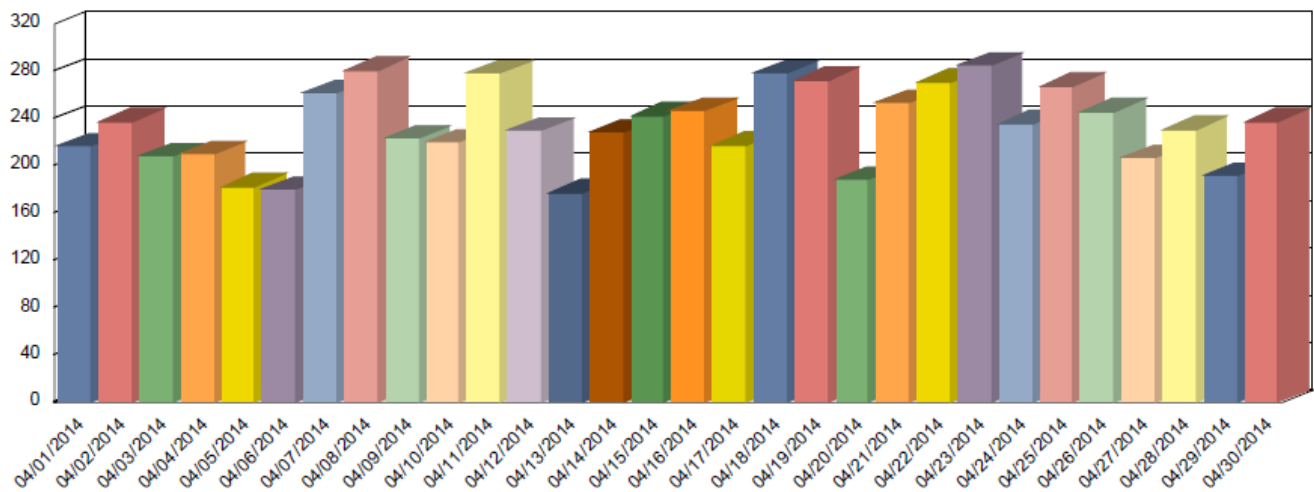
## Incoming 9-1-1 Calls April 2014

Number of Calls : 1,557

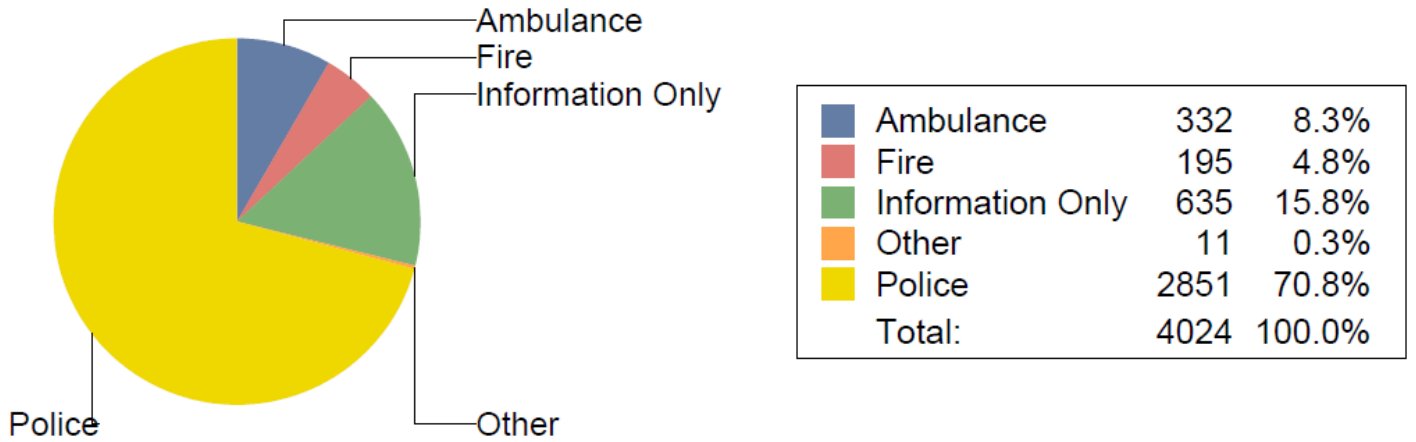


## Incoming Calls to the Communications Center April 2014

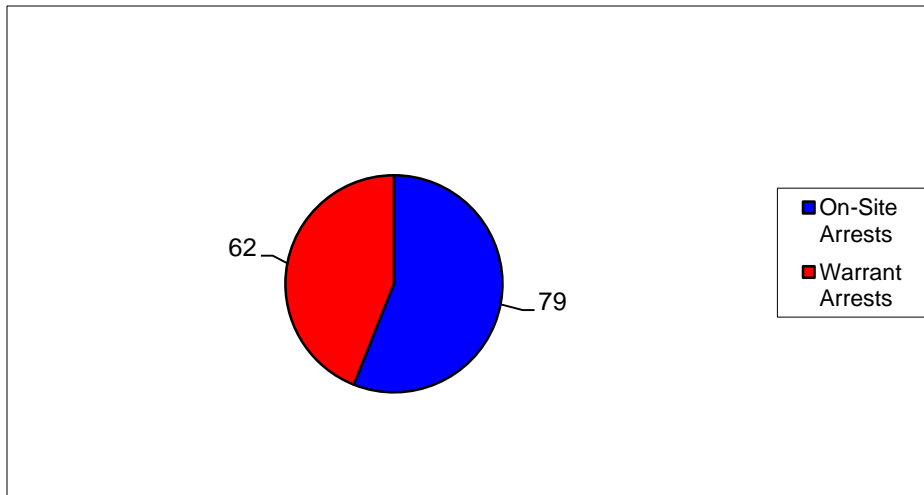

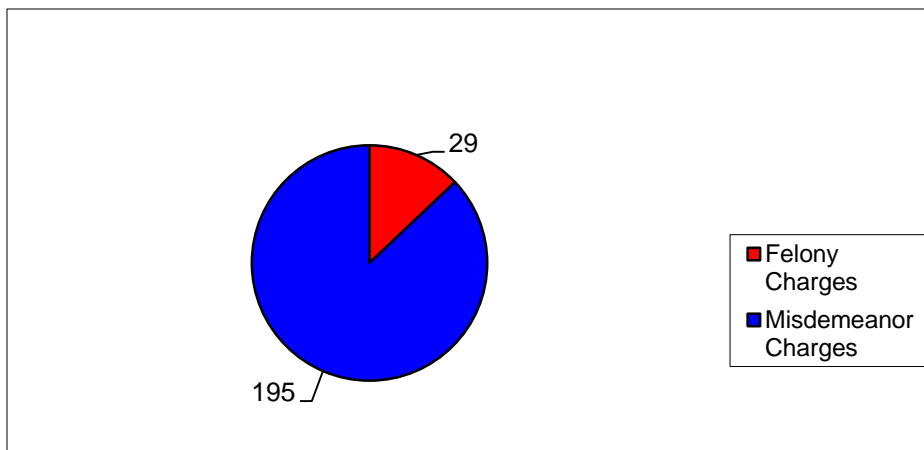
## Calls for Service April 2014



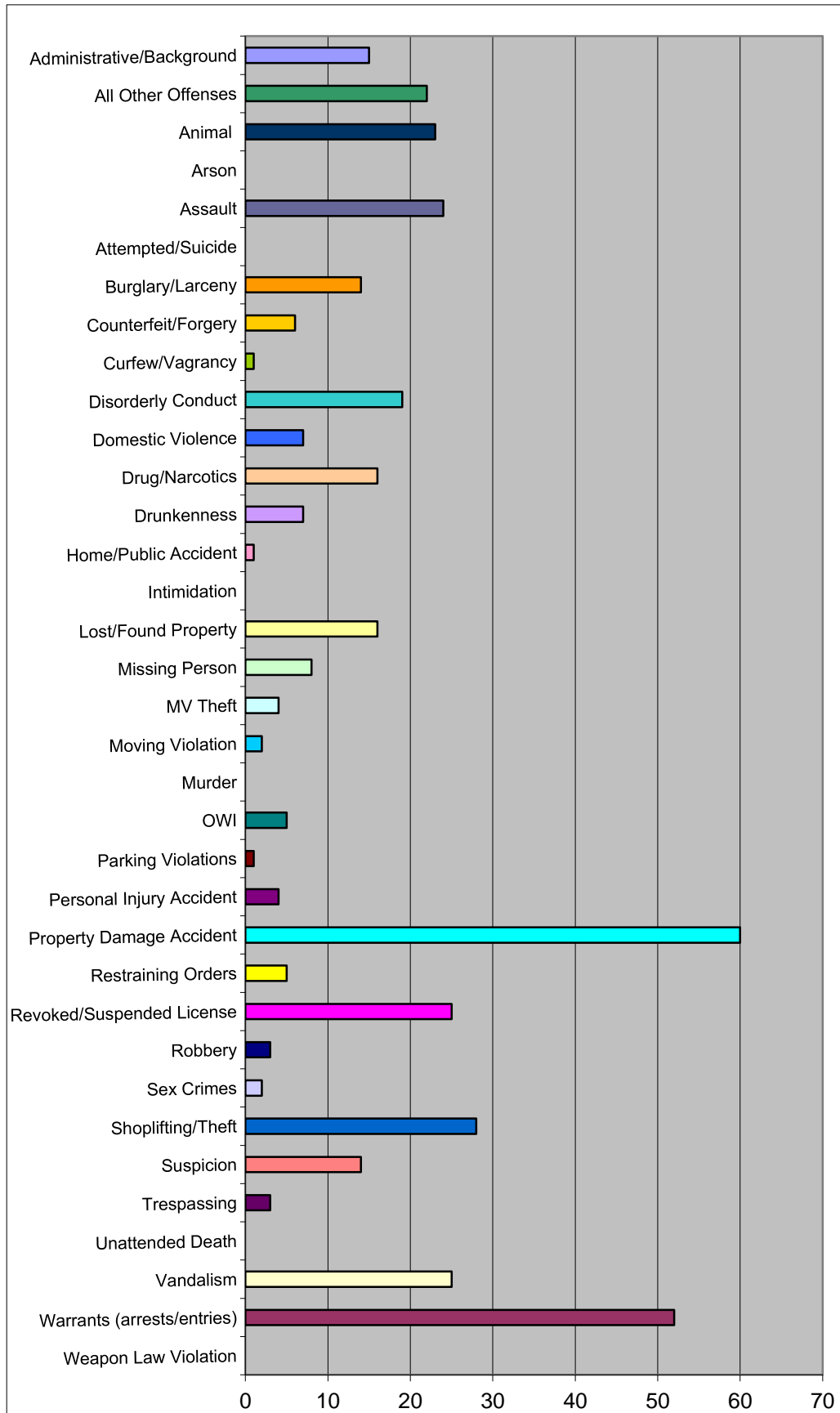
## Arrests April 2014
