

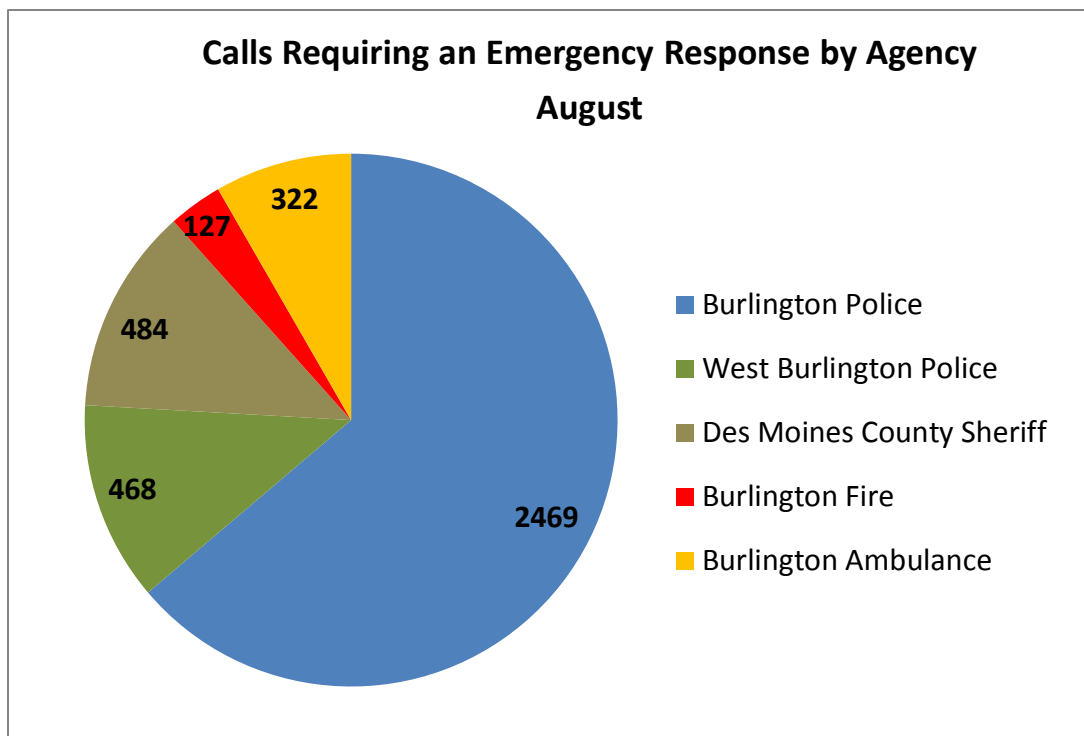
# MEMORANDUM

Re: Police Department Activities – August 2014

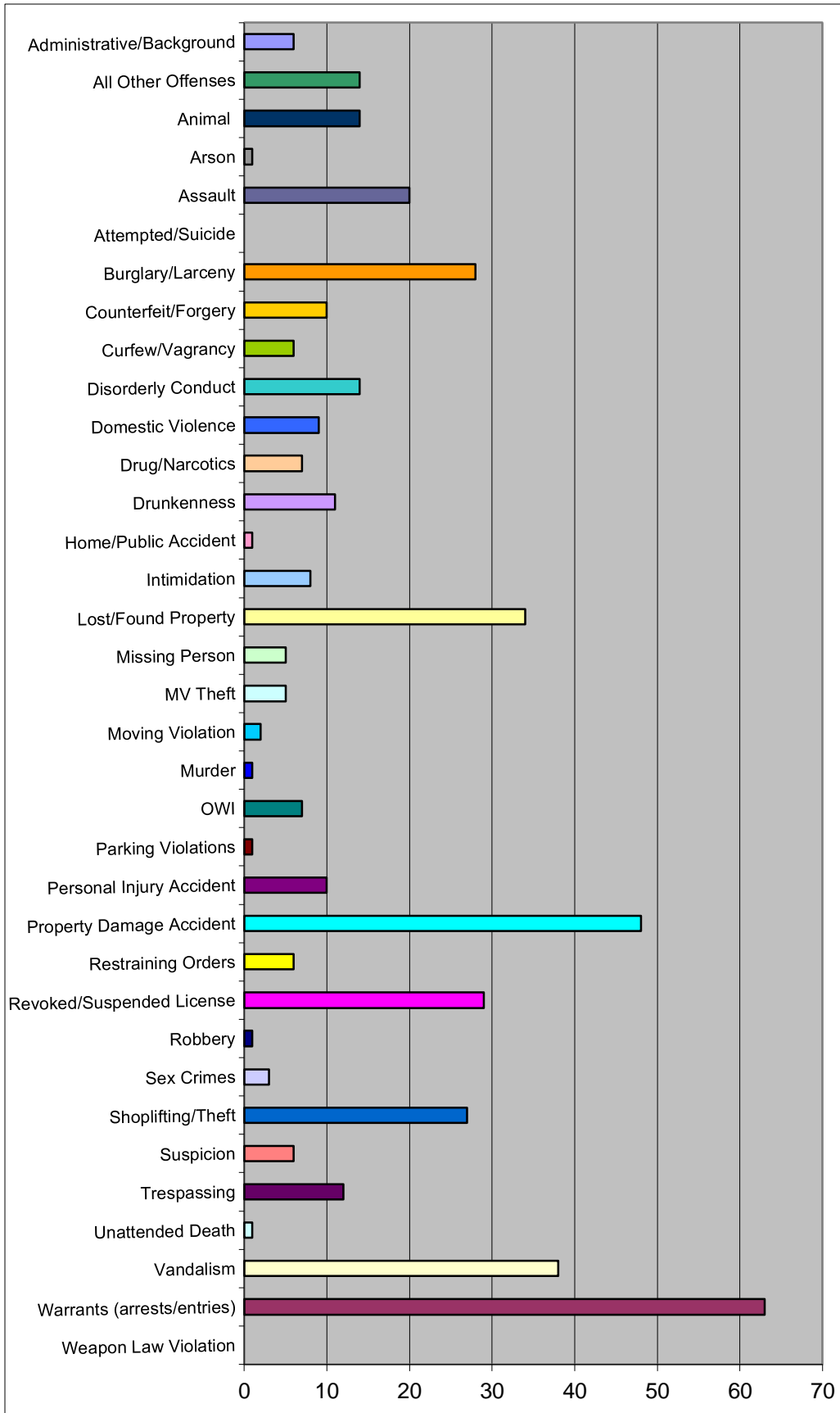


- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

- The Chief and Major Grimshaw met with Andy Hoffman of the Hawk Eye in regard to an article he was writing about the establishment of a Reserve Program.

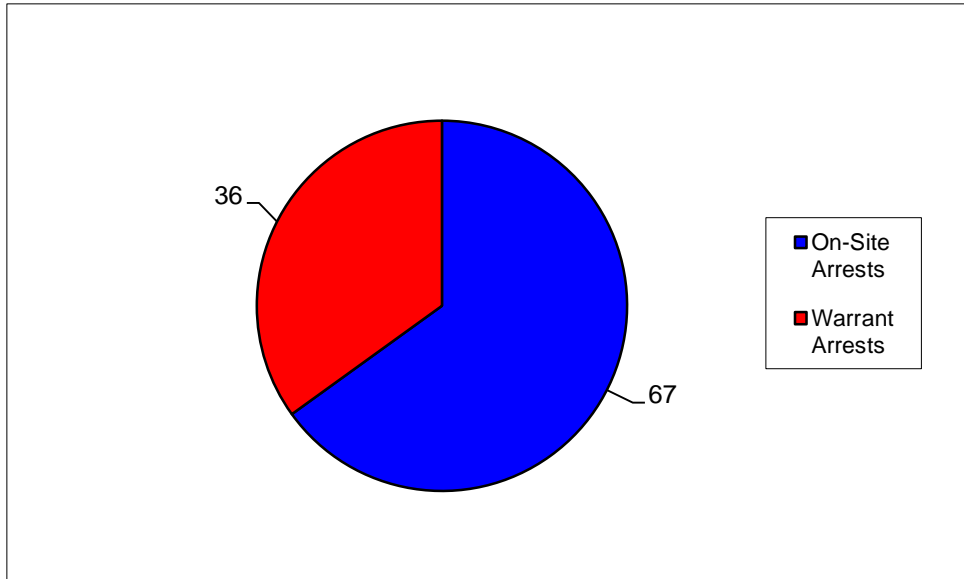
- Major Kramer and Major Grimshaw participated in an Emergency Preparedness meeting at Great Prairie AEA.

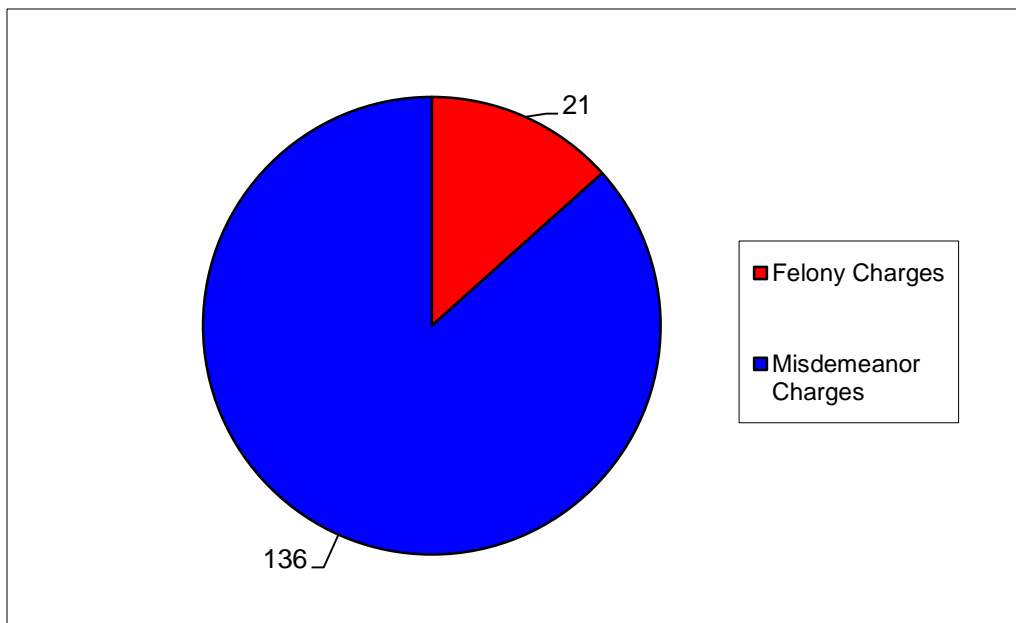
# Incidents August 2014
