Re: Police Department Activities – February 2014



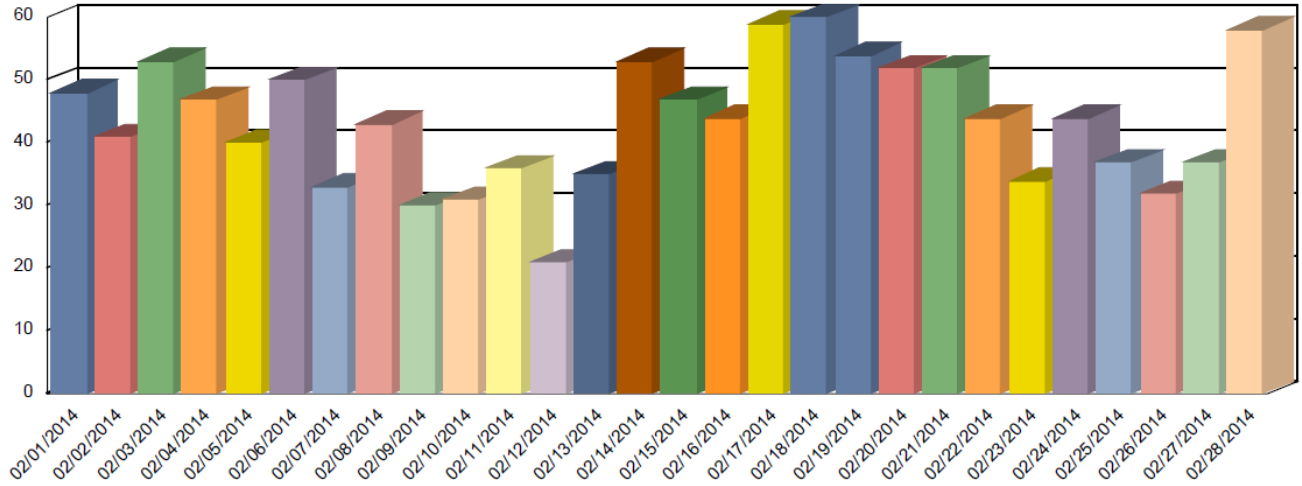
- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

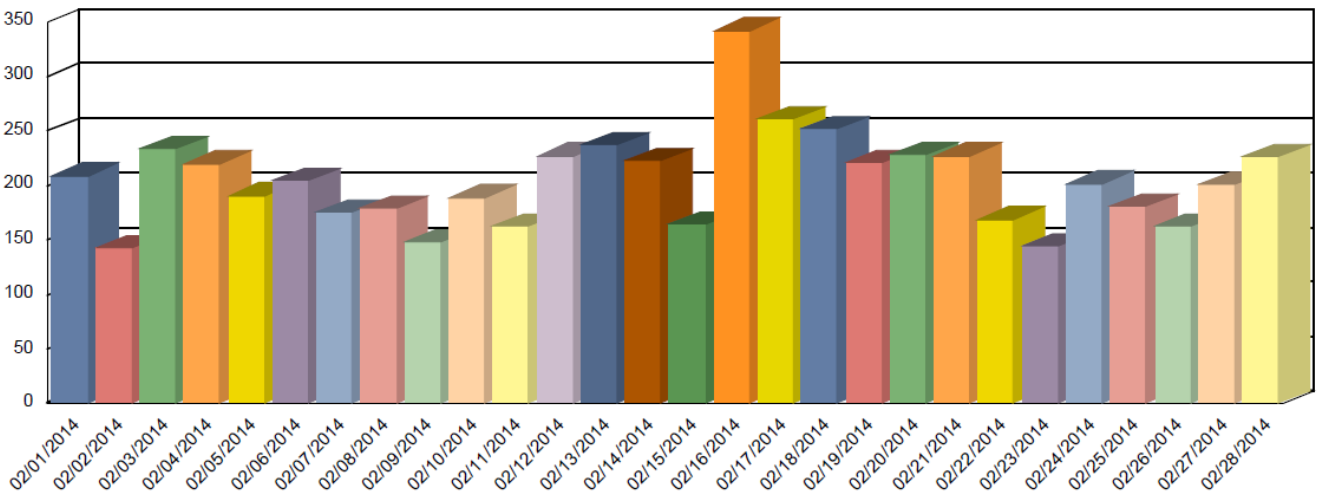
Incoming 9-1-1 Calls February 2014

Number of Calls : 1,215

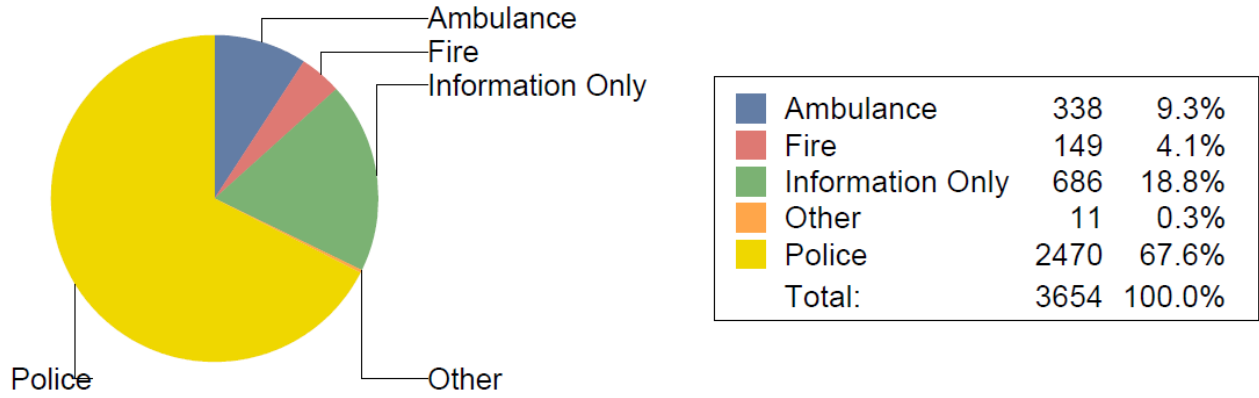


Incoming Calls to the Communications Center February 2014

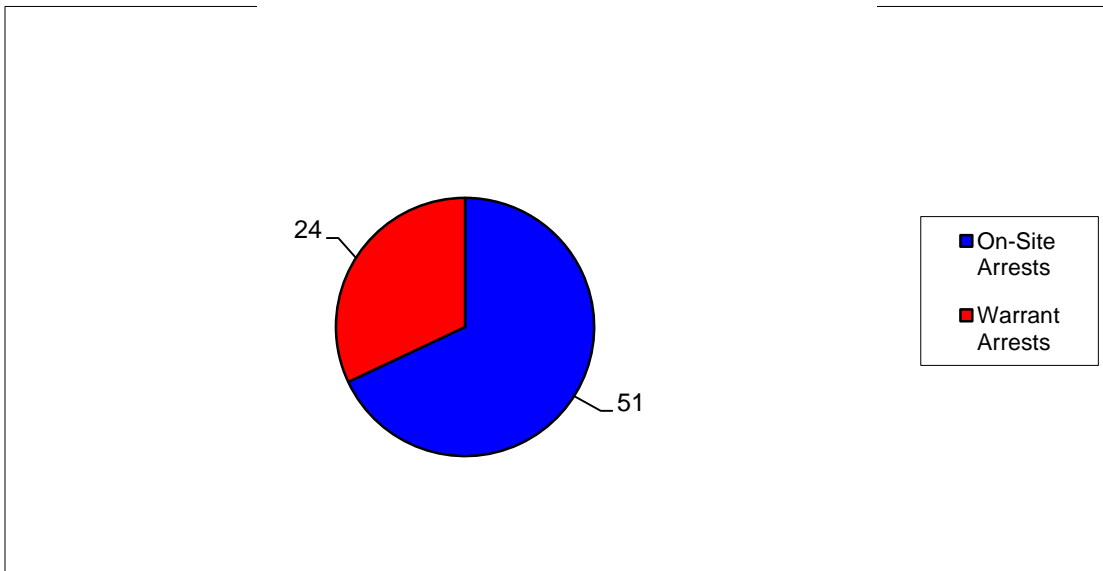

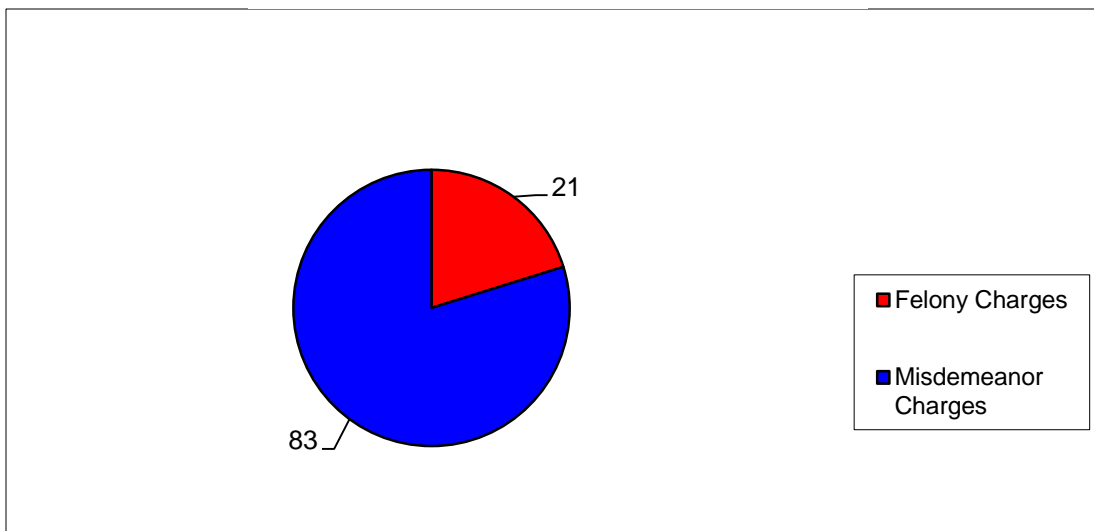
Calls for Service February 2014



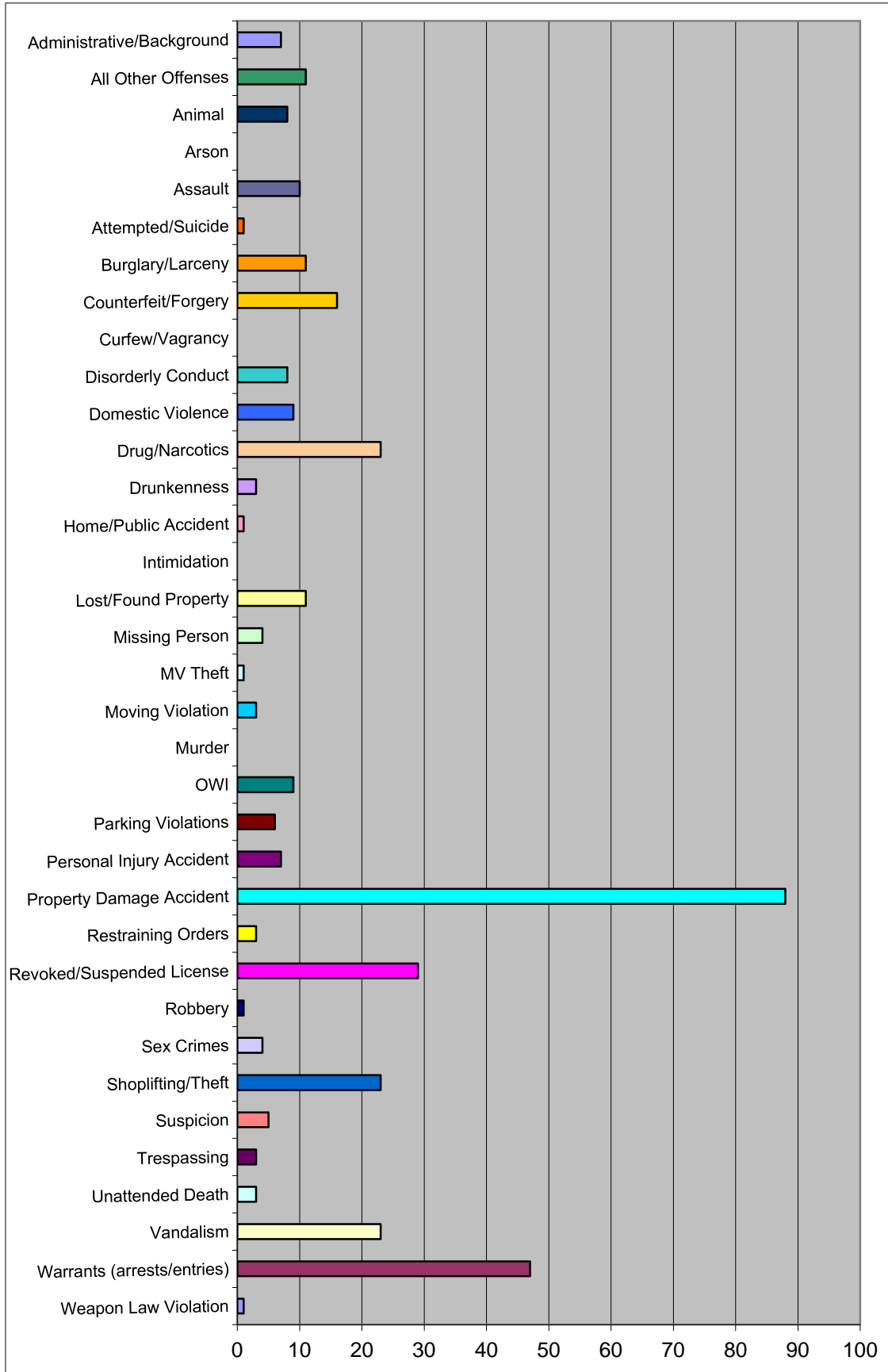
Arrests February 2014
