

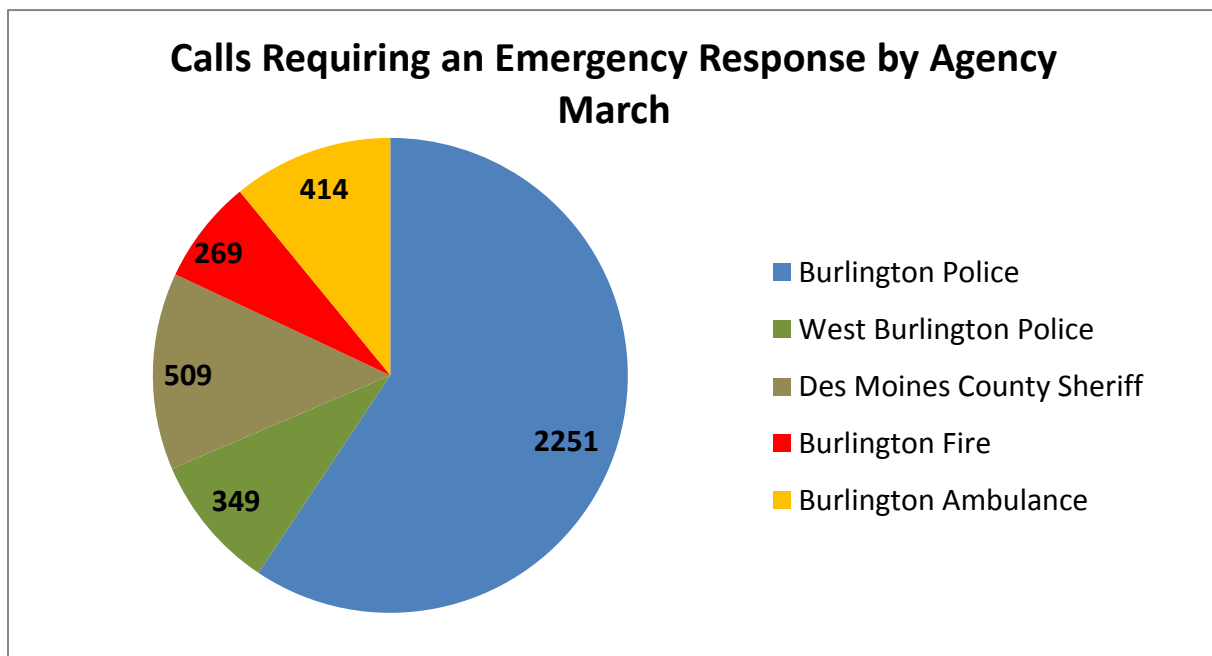

Re: Police Department Activities – March, 2017

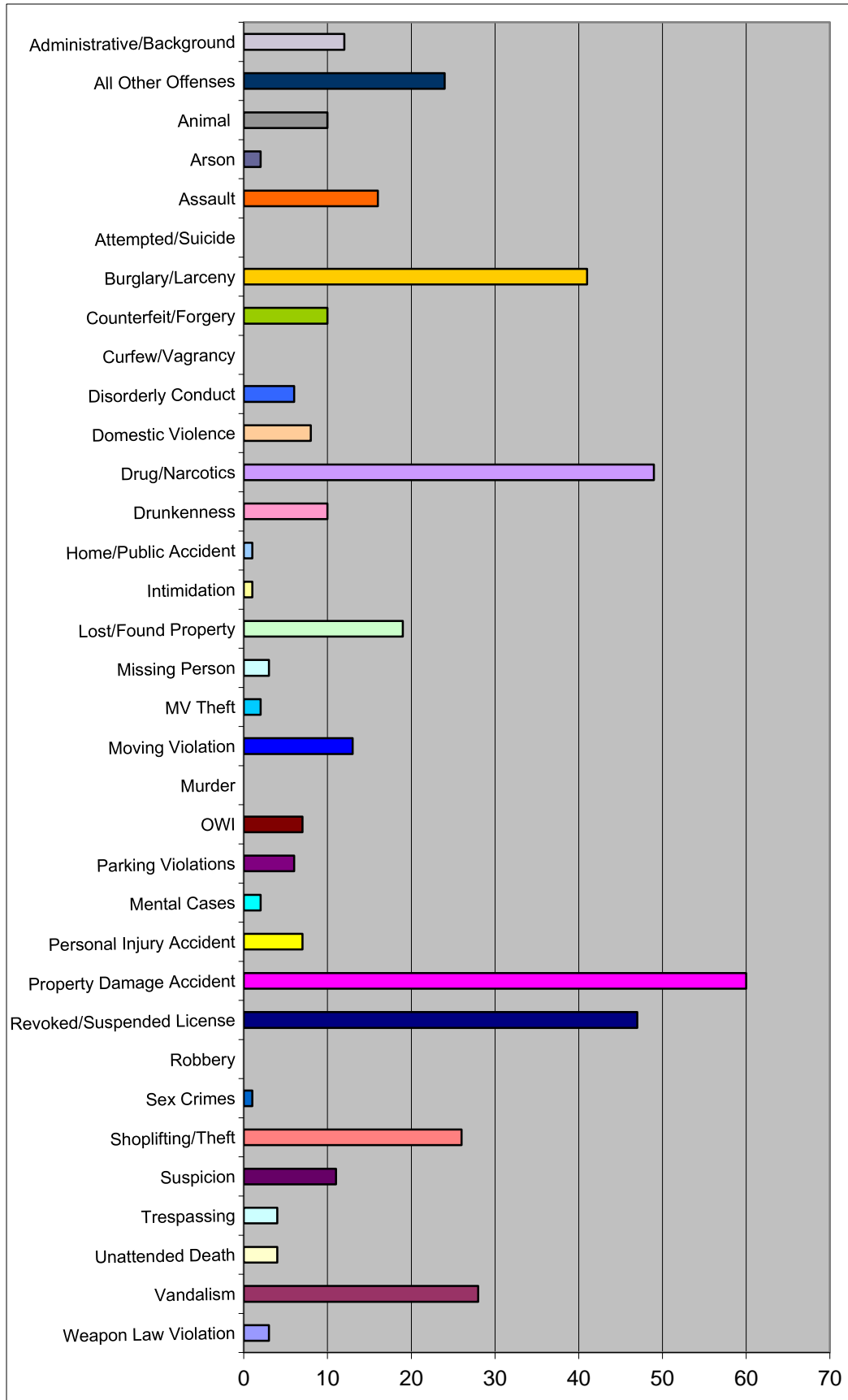


- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

- The Salamander ID card system printer was installed and the software enabled for entering information for every city employee.

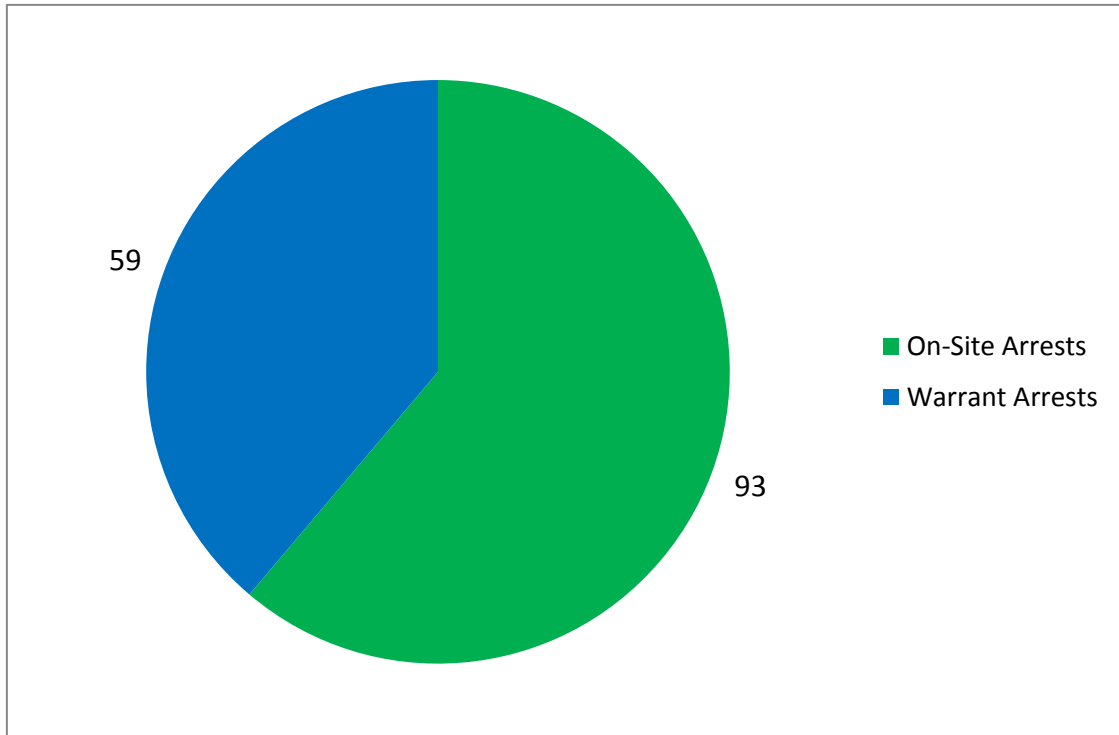
- Chief Beaird presented the 2016 Police Department Annual Report to the City Council.

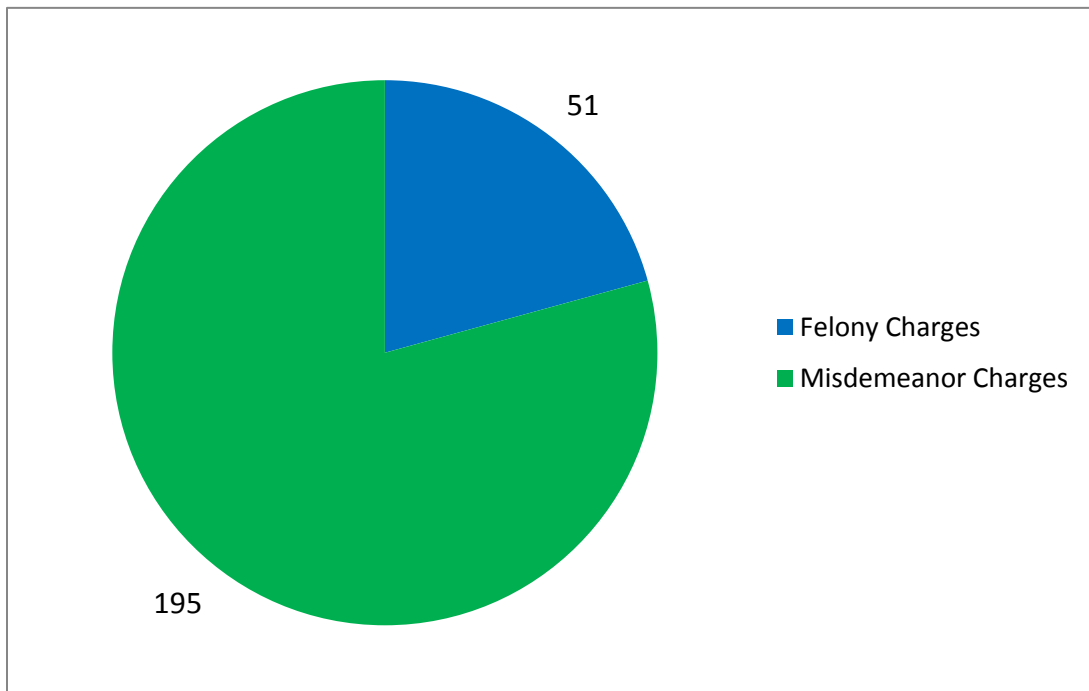
Incidents March 2017
