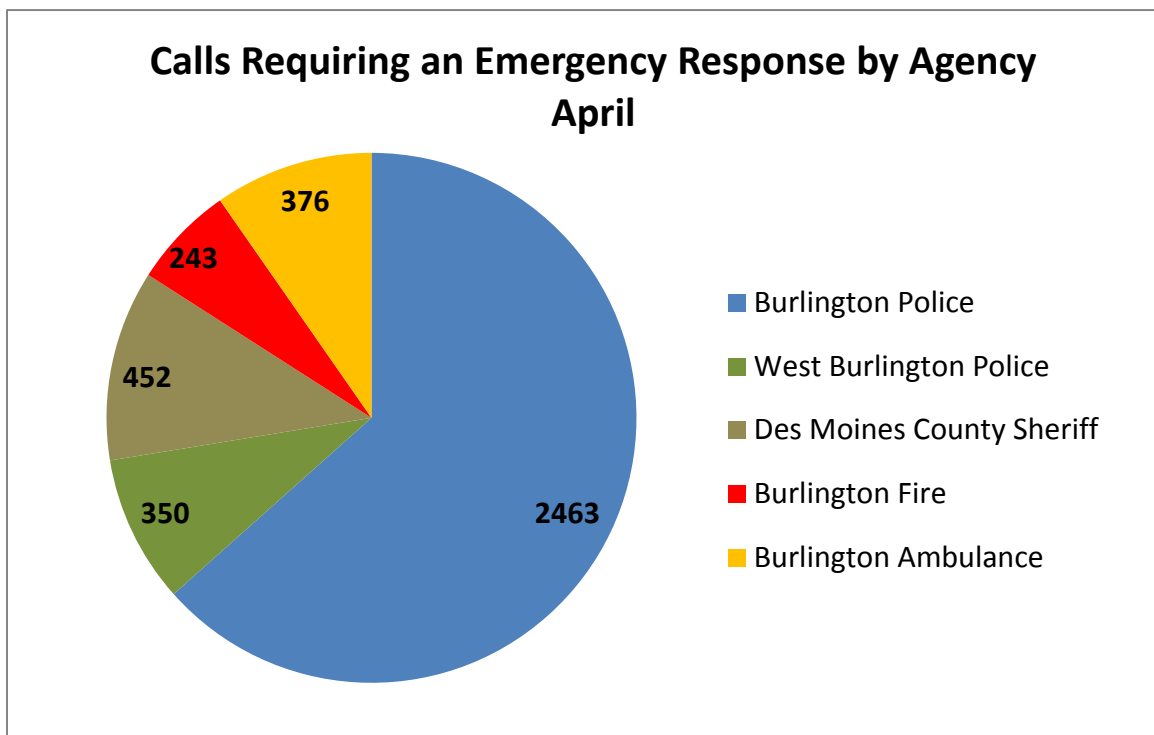

Re: Police Department Activities – April, 2017



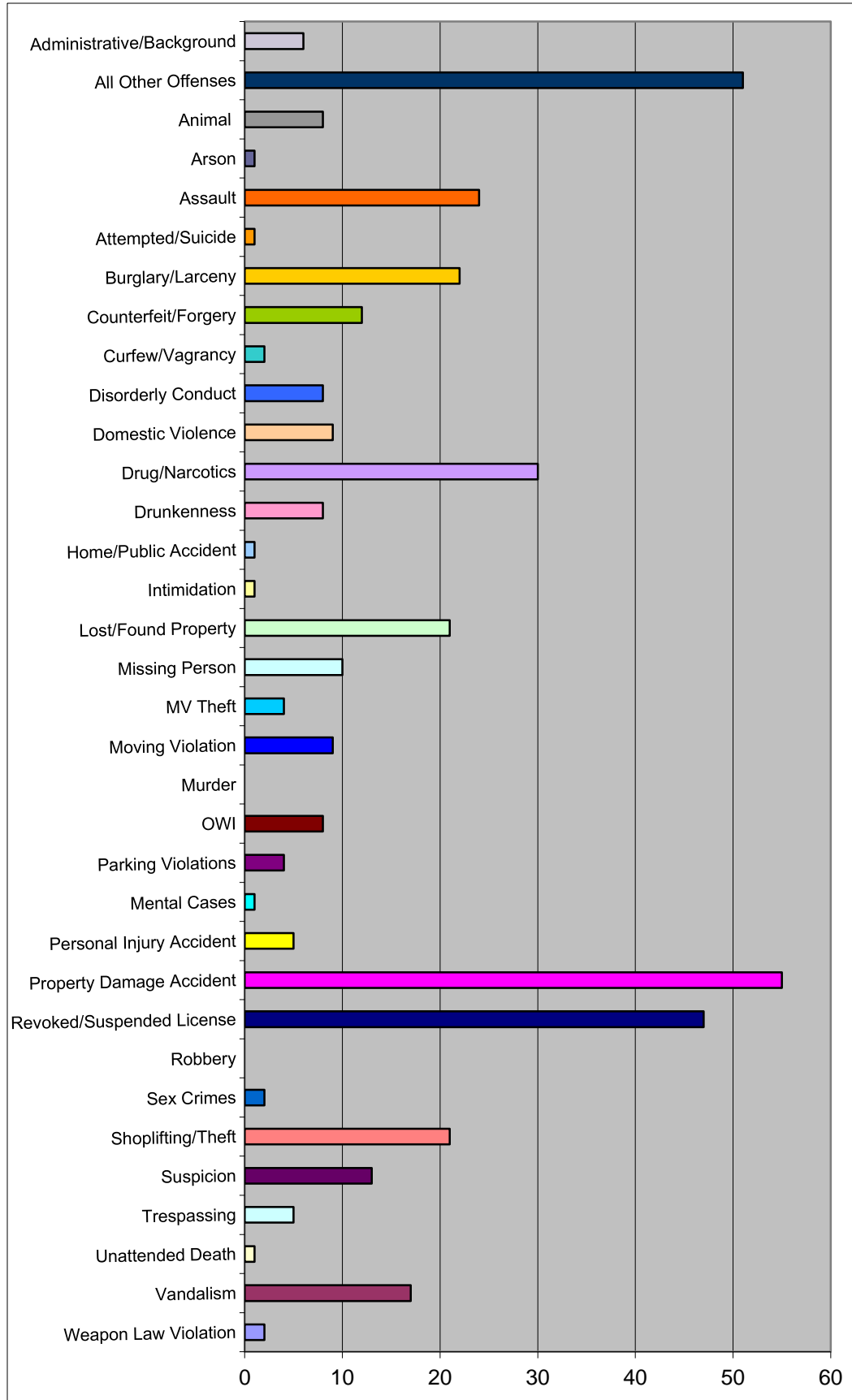
- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

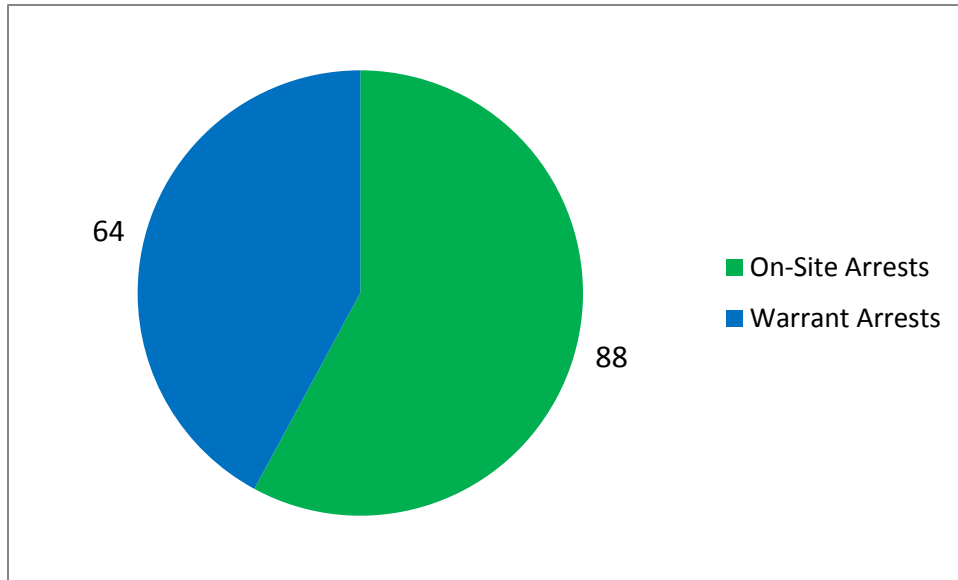

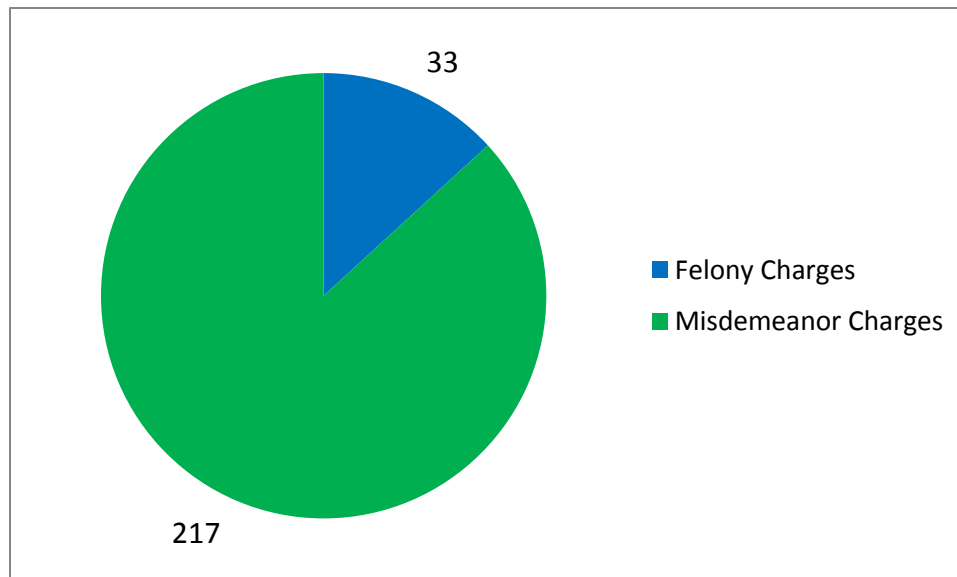
