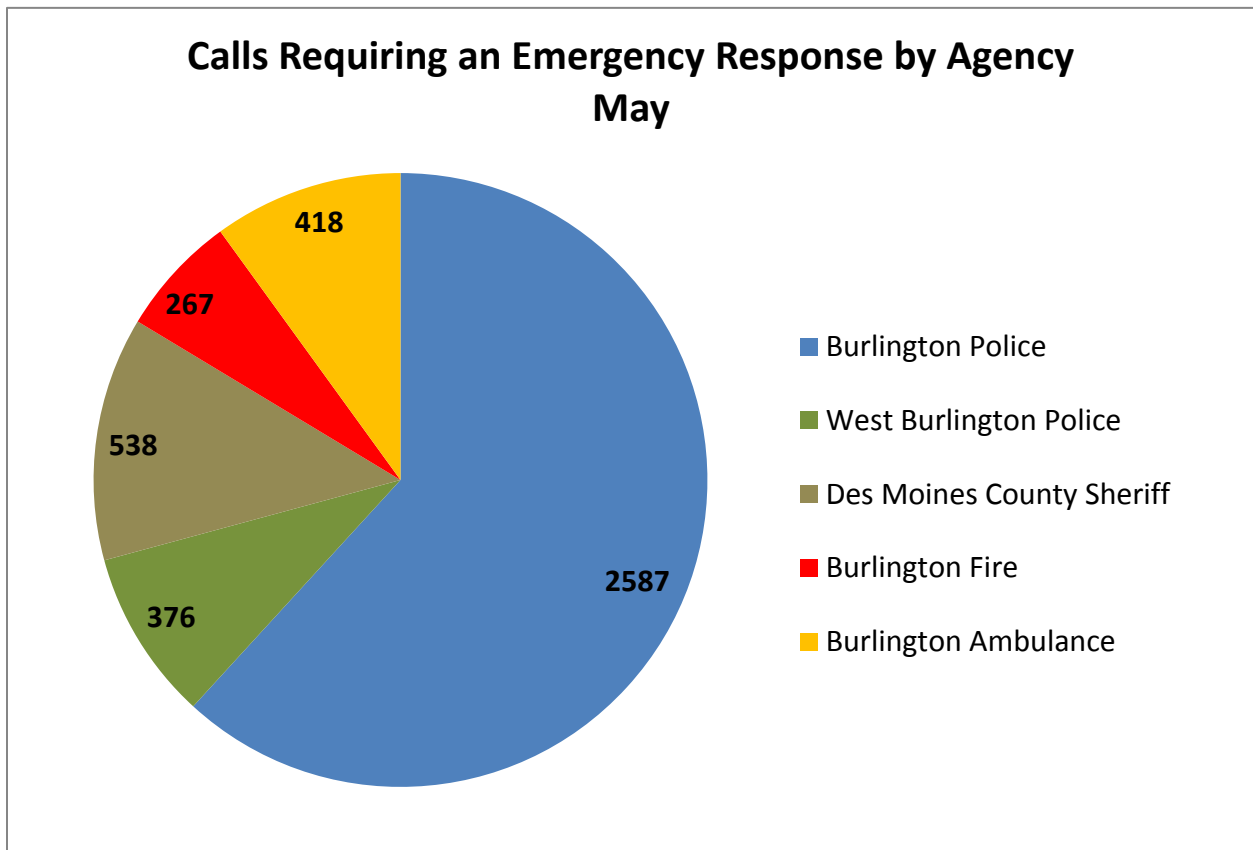

Re: Police Department Activities – May, 2017



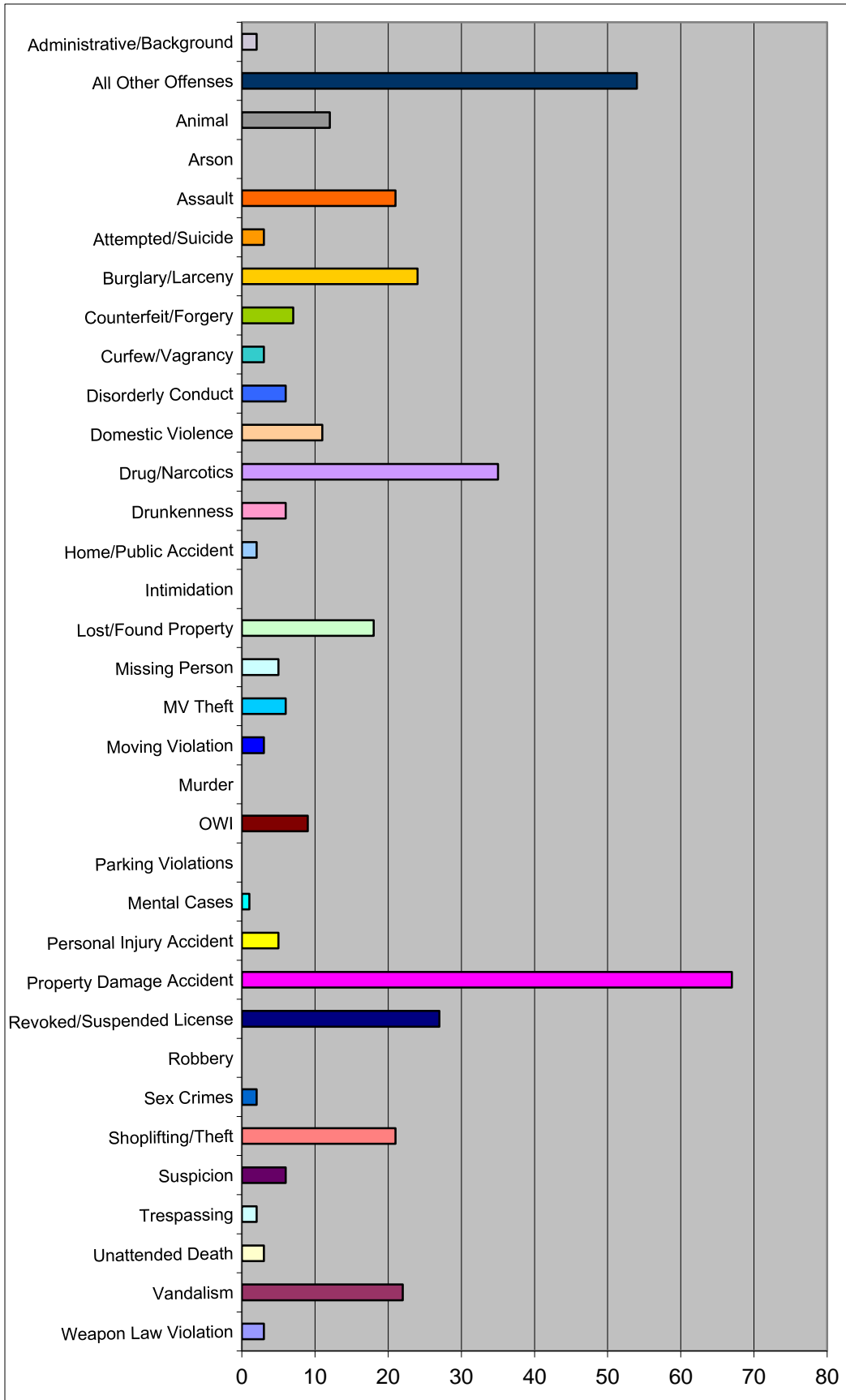
- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

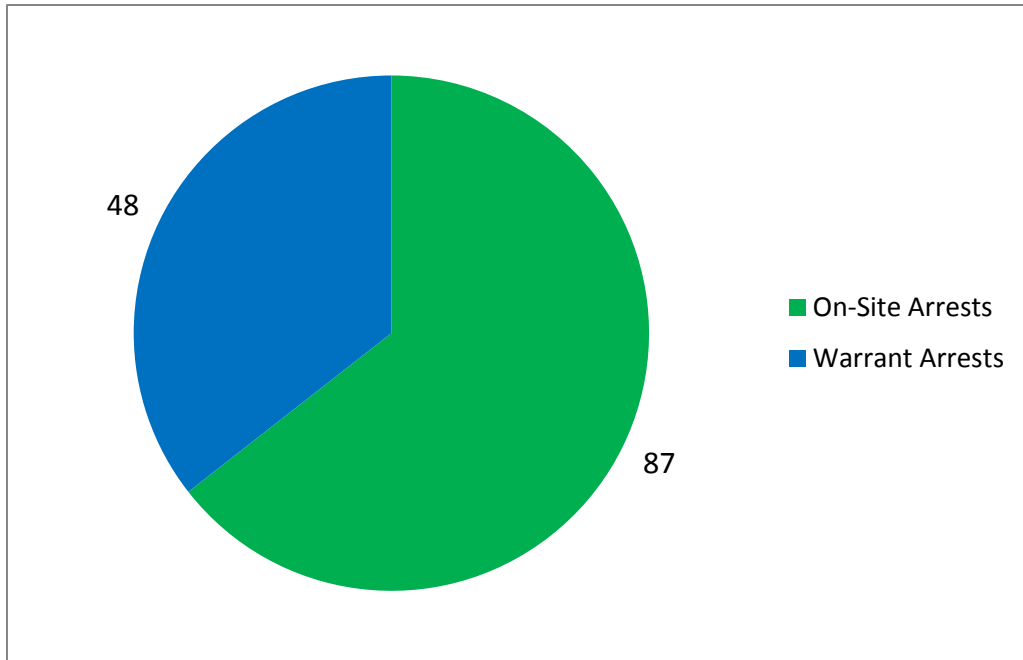

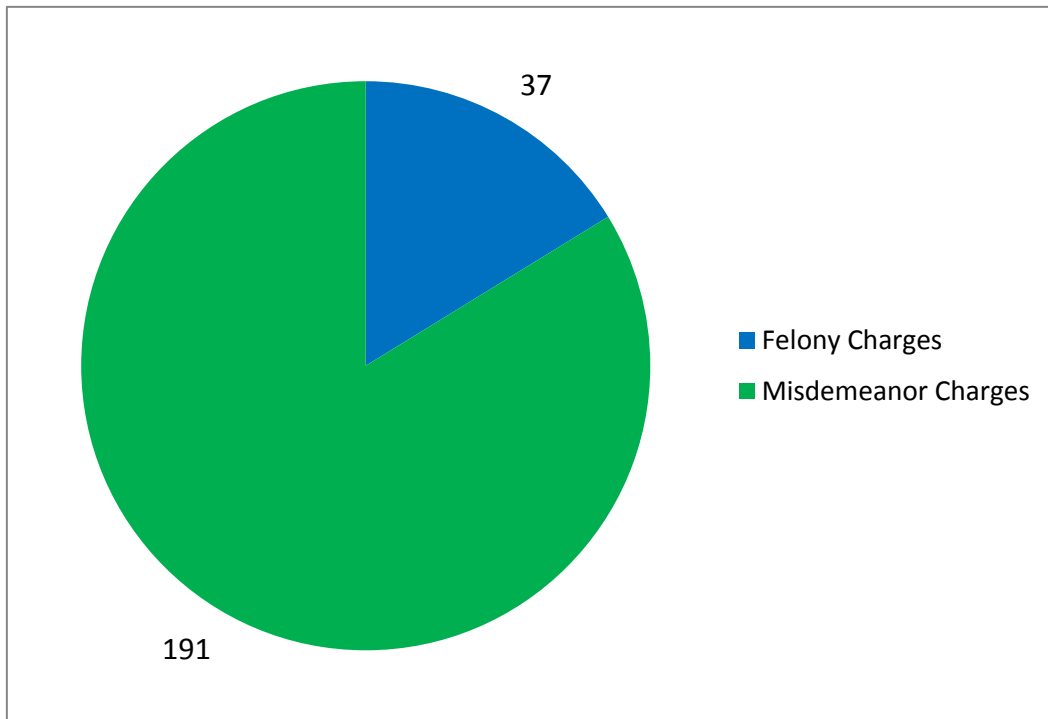
Incidents May 2017
