

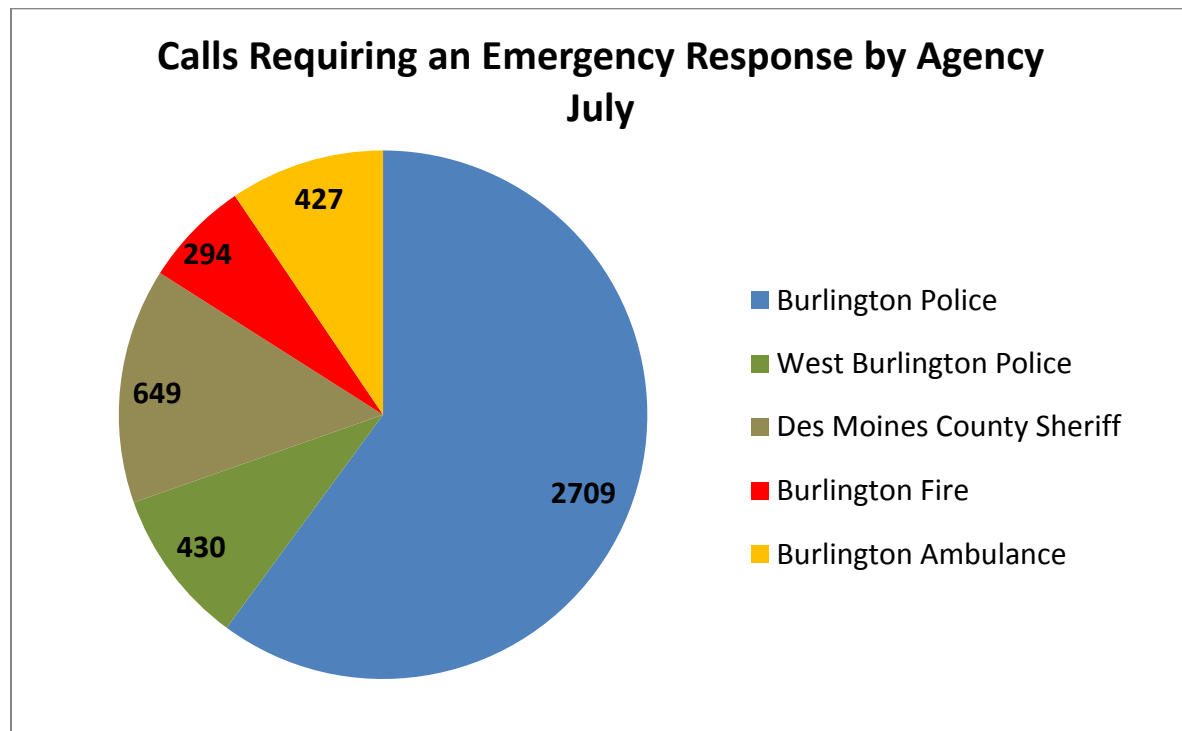

Re: Police Department Activities – July, 2017

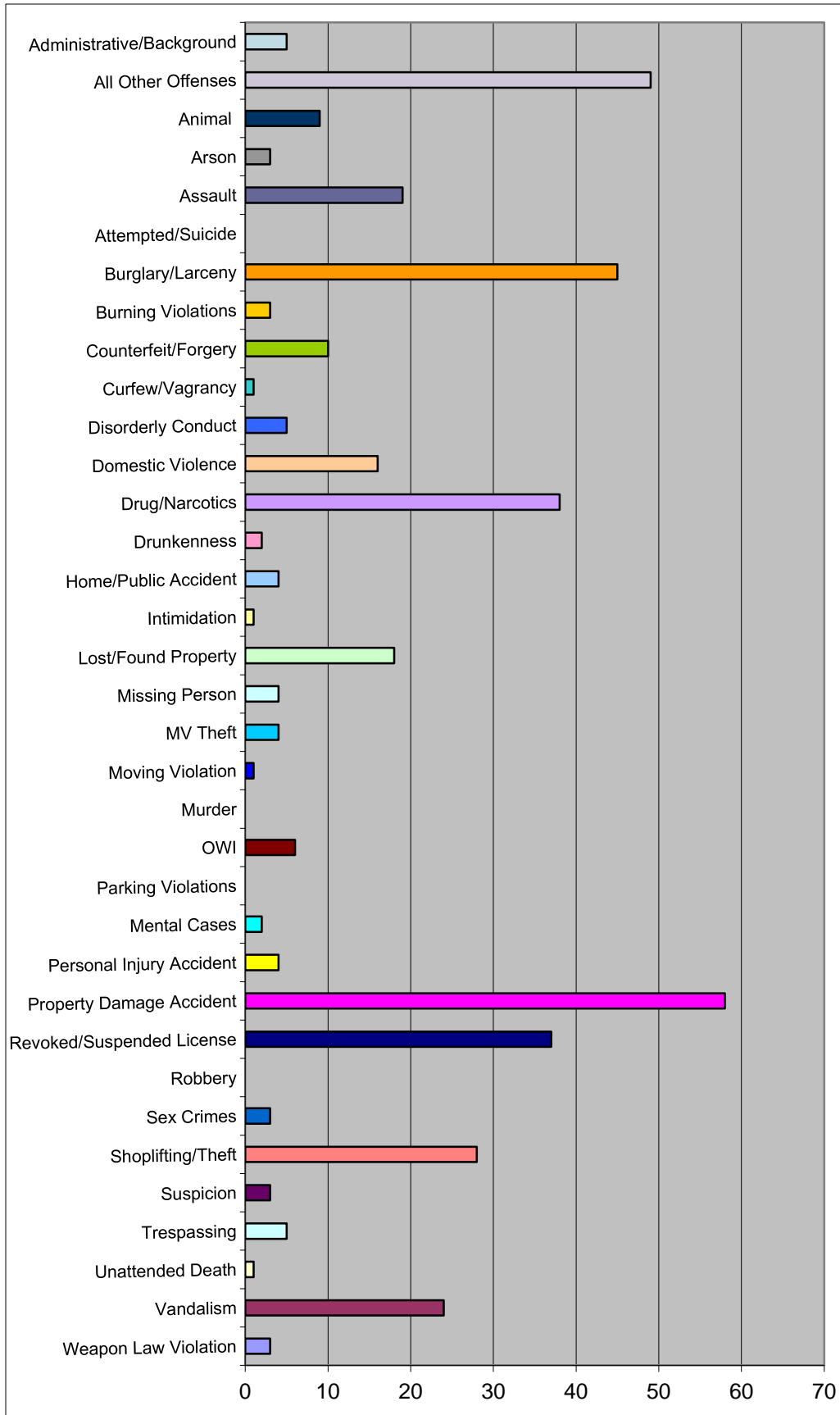


- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

- Major Kramer and Major Grimshaw met with Carl A. Nelson Company to review the bids awarded for the new police facility construction.

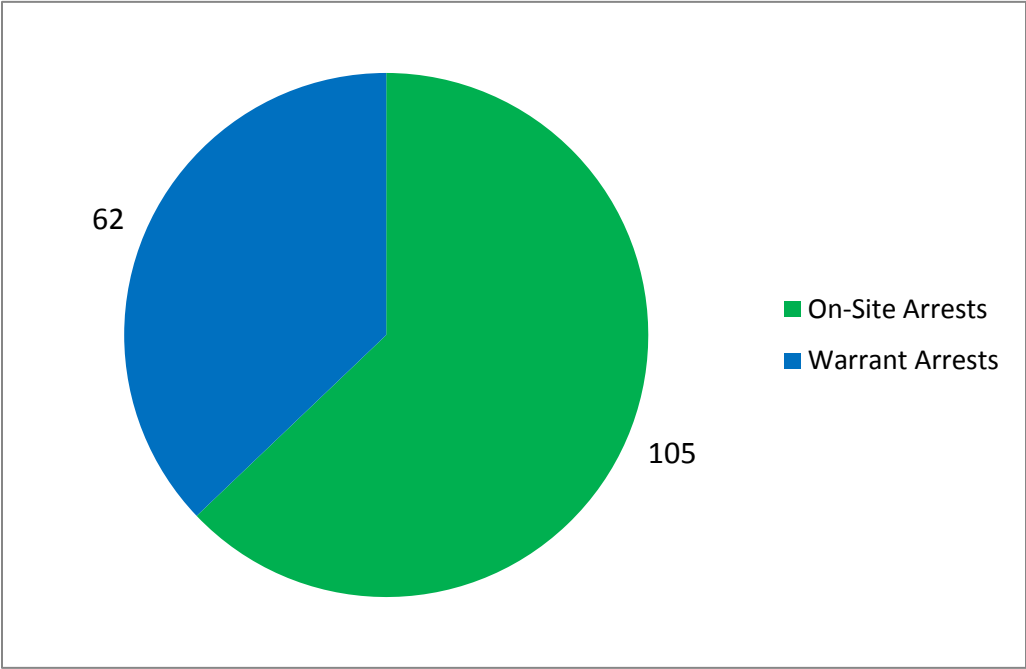
- Major Grimshaw attended the PCPA Police/Youth Summit in North Carolina.

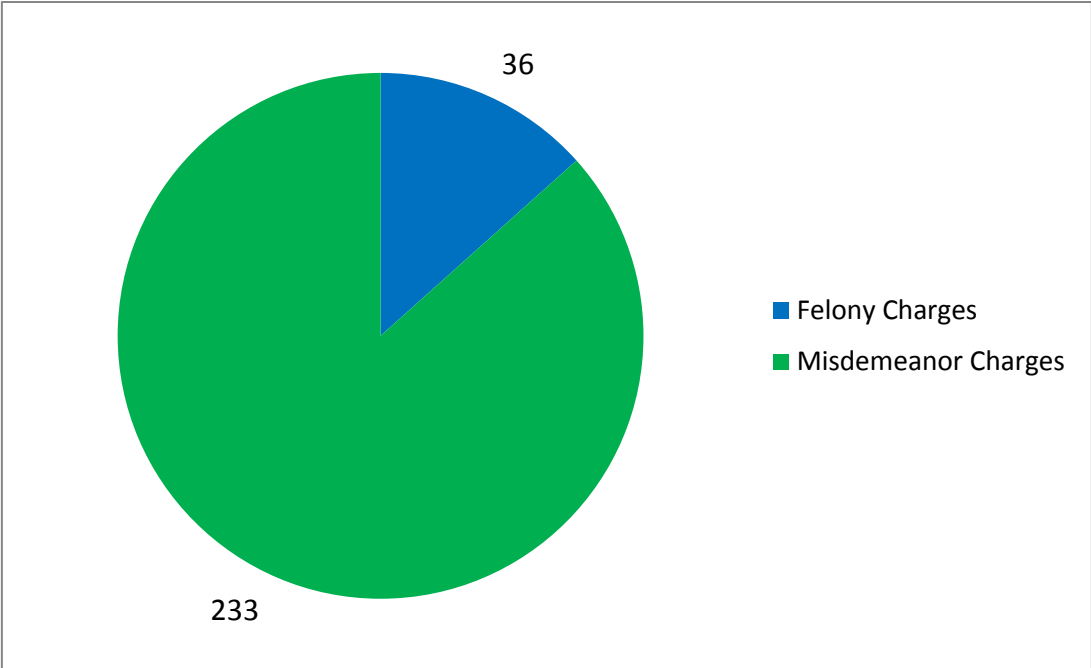
Incidents July 2017
