

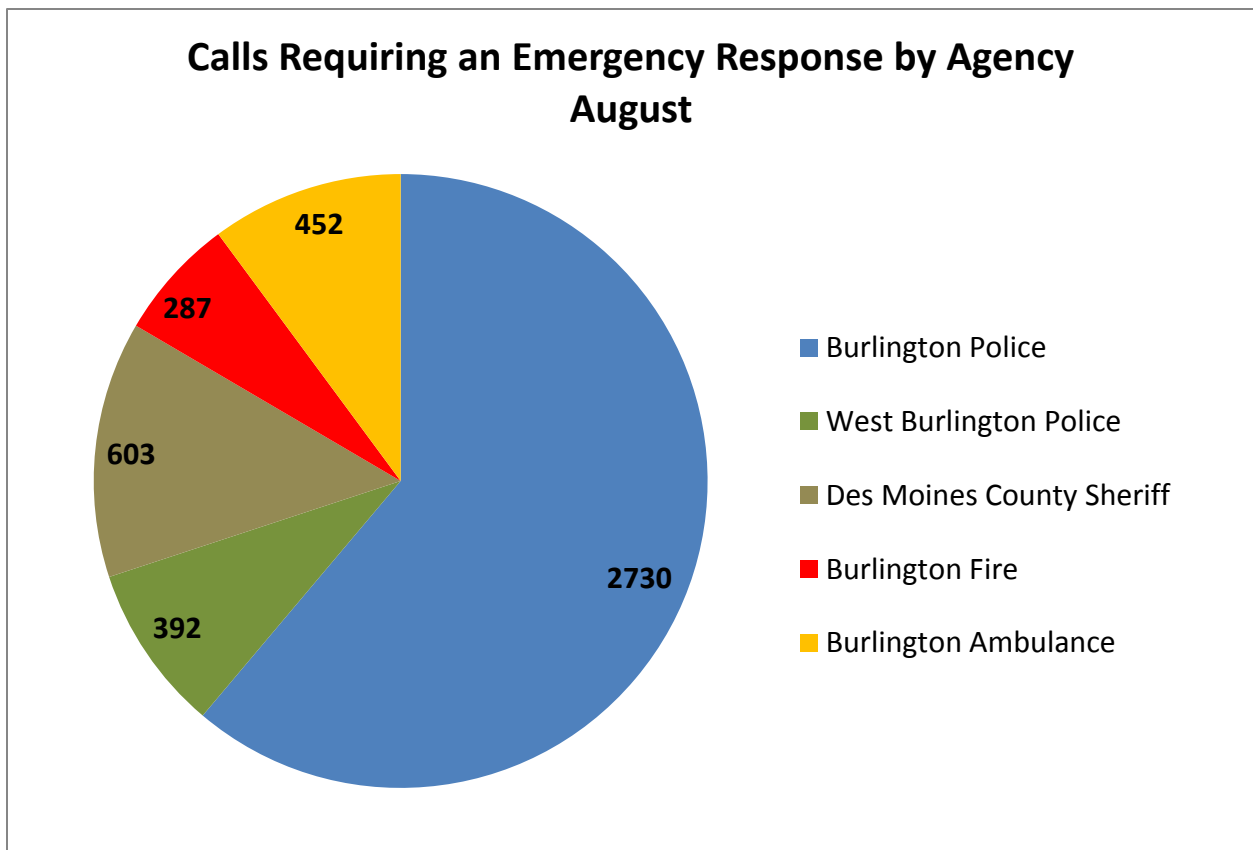

Re: Police Department Activities – August, 2017

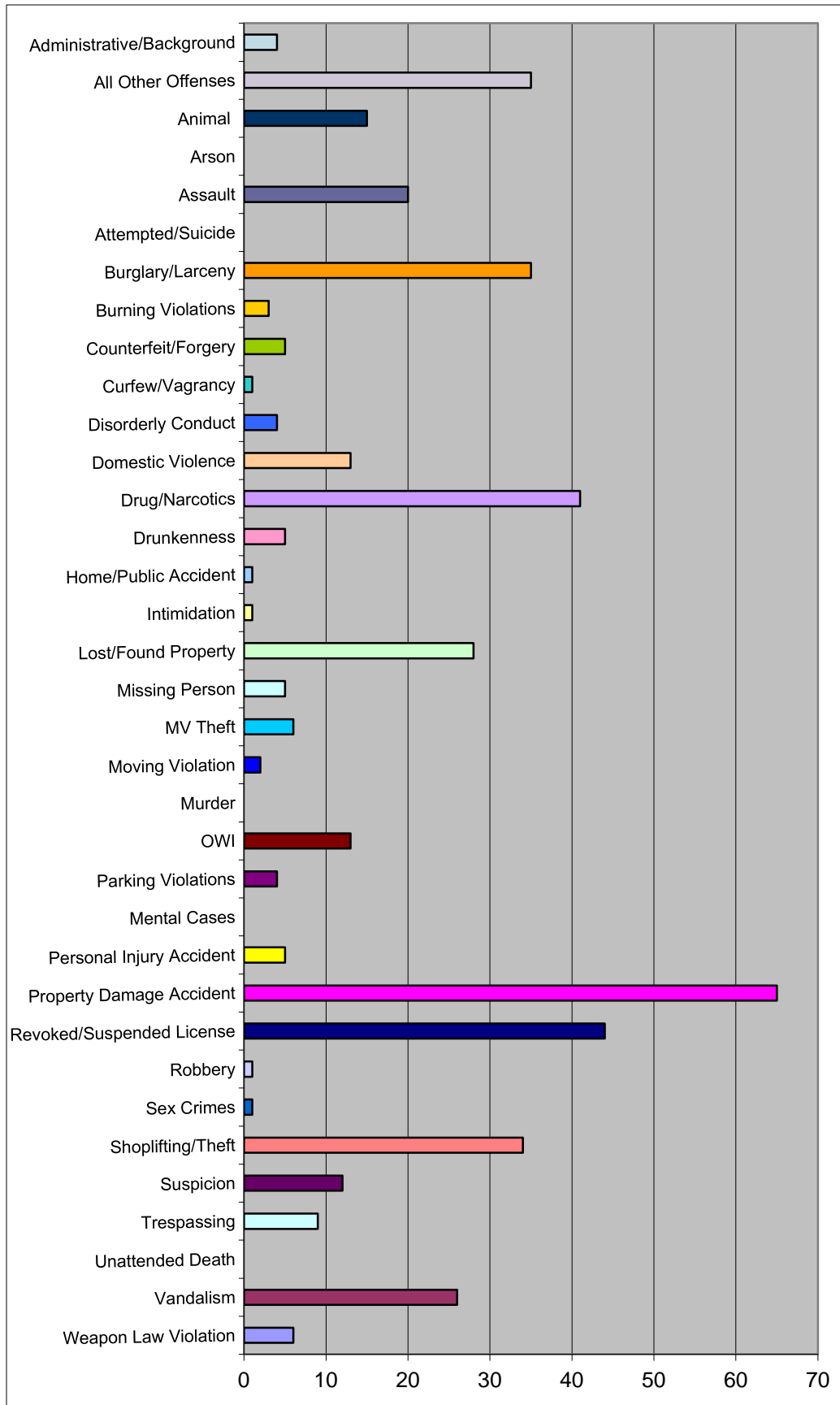


- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

- Major Grimshaw attended the Crisis Intervention Team meeting.

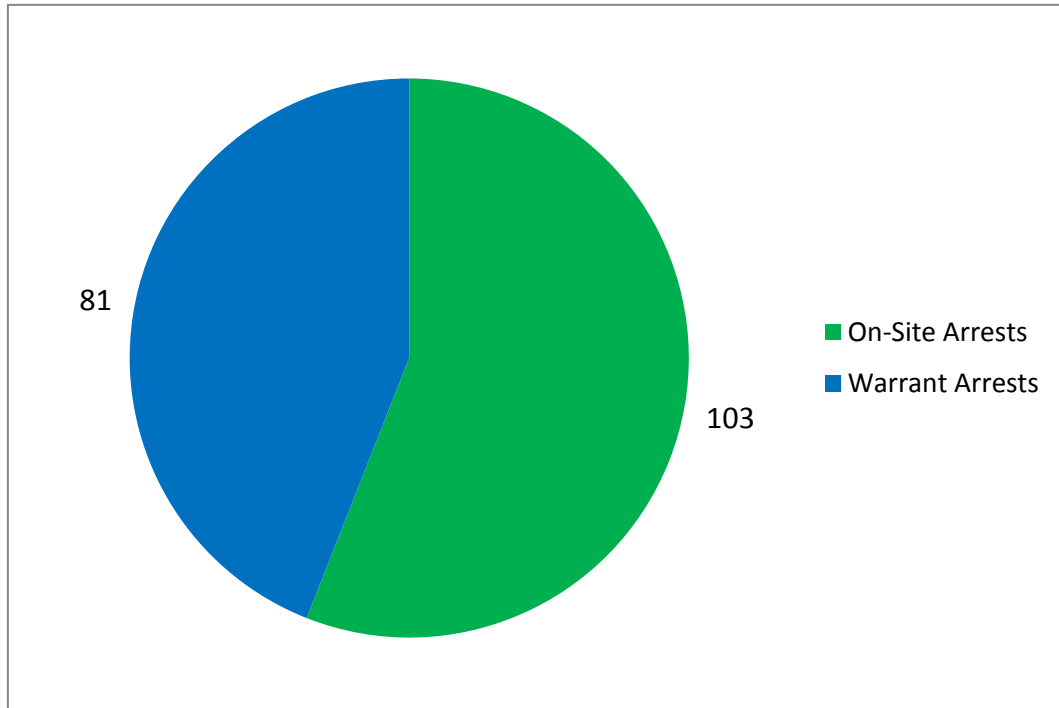
- Officer Daniel Ramiro was sworn in as the newest officer of the Burlington Police Department.

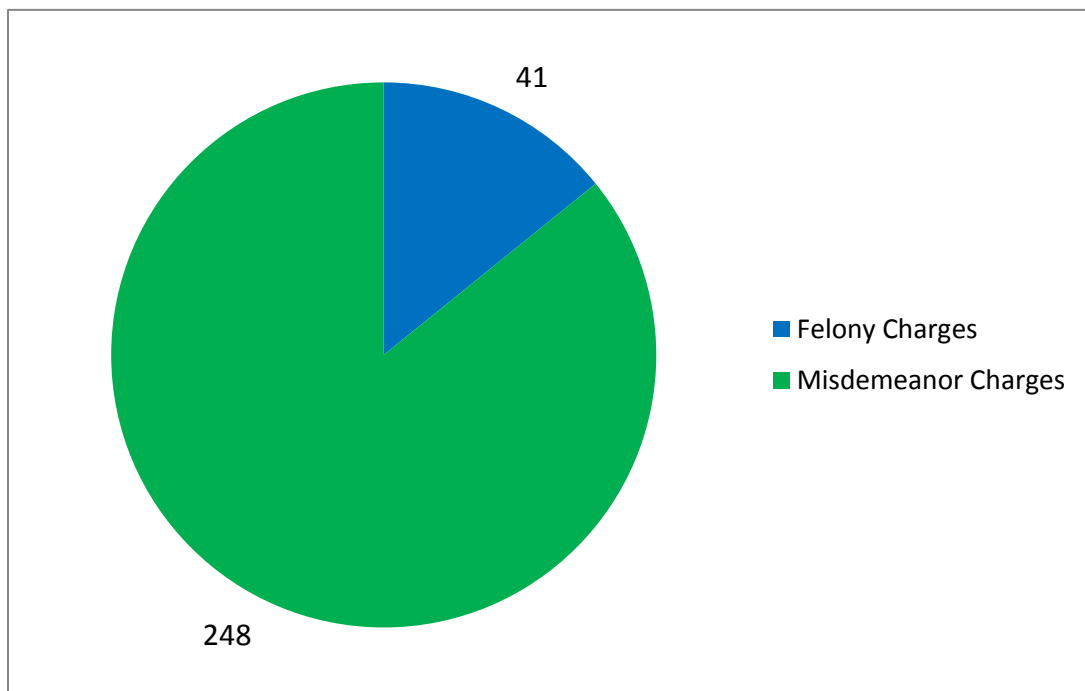
# Incidents August 2017
