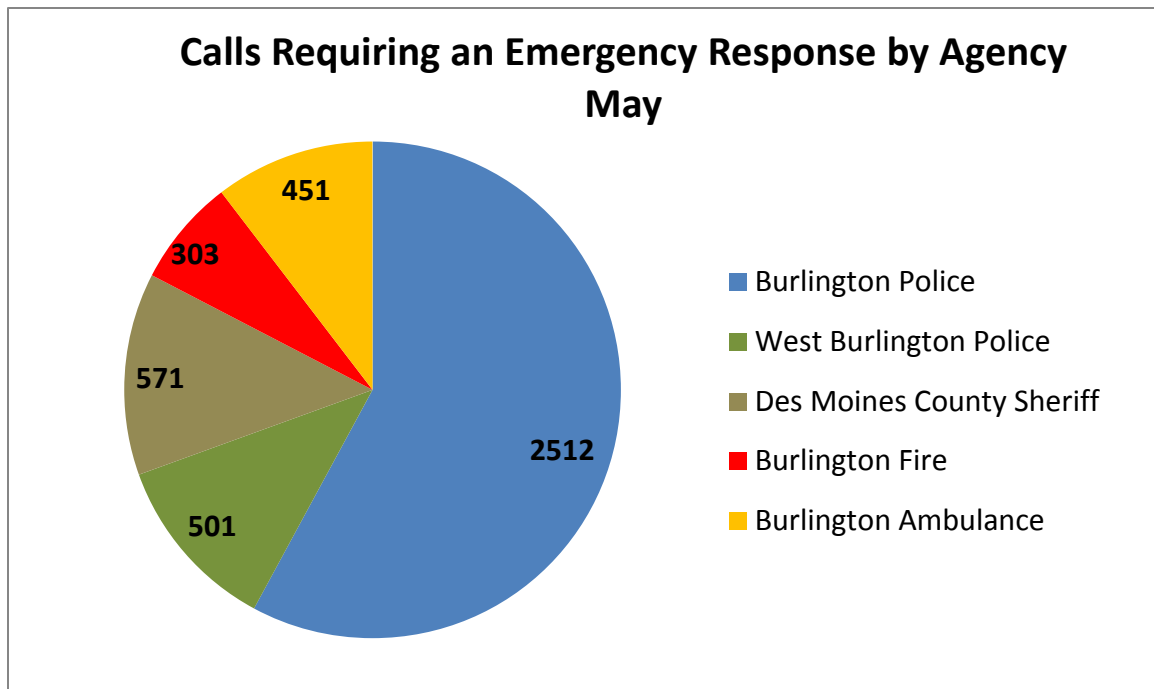

- Chief Kramer attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

- Chief Kramer and Major Grimshaw and several officers attended the swearing in ceremony for Lt. Wayne Thomson and Sgt. Eric Short

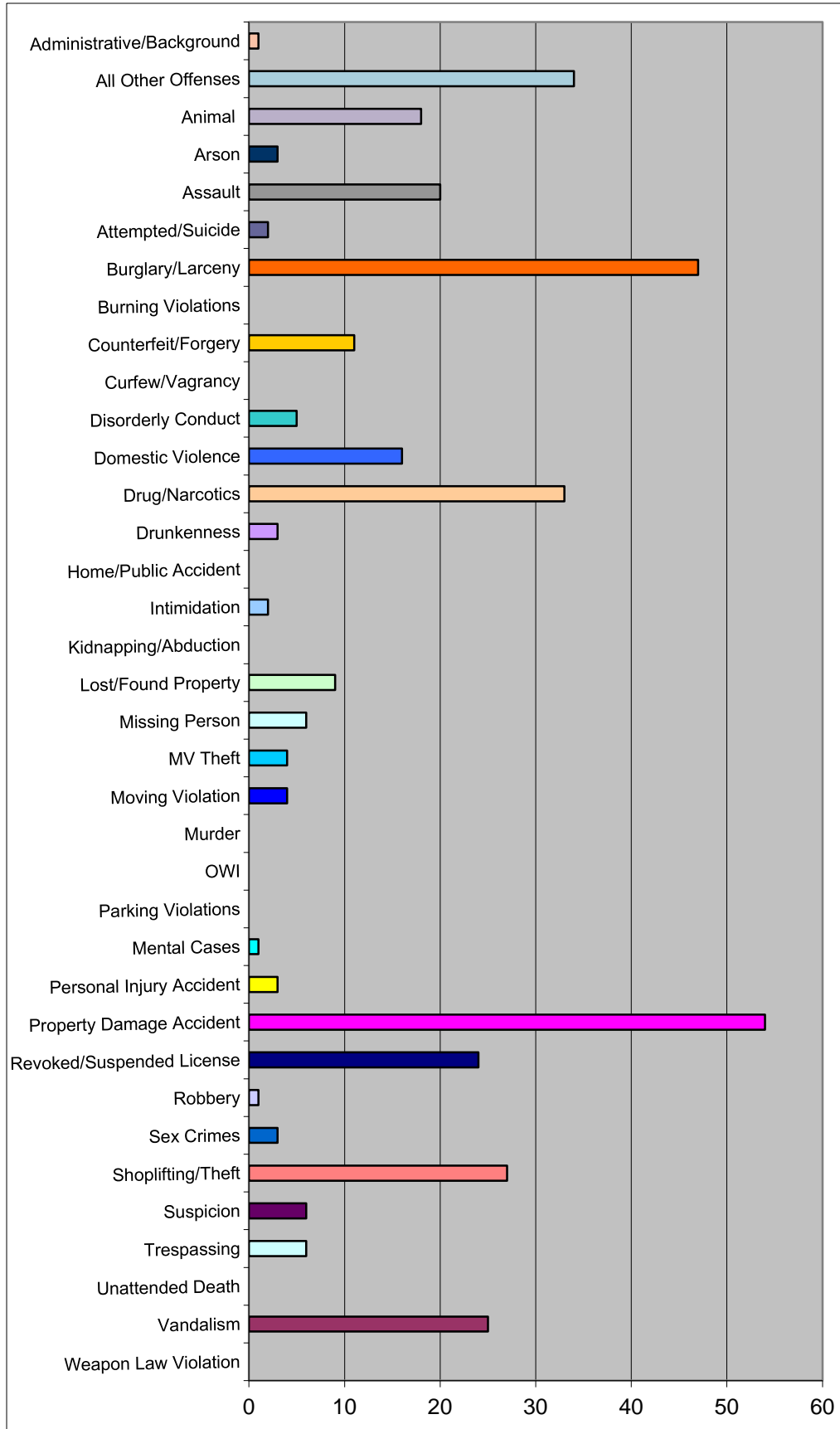

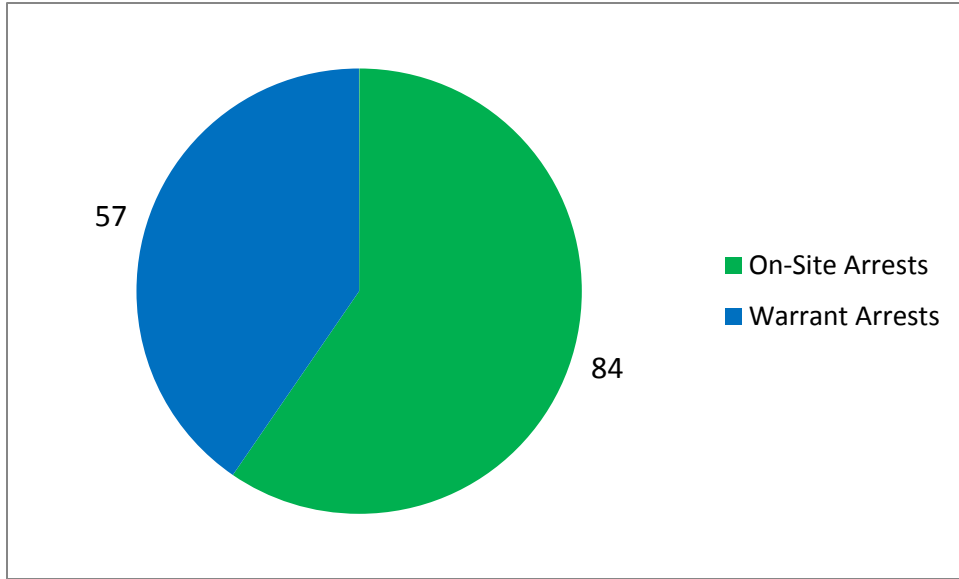

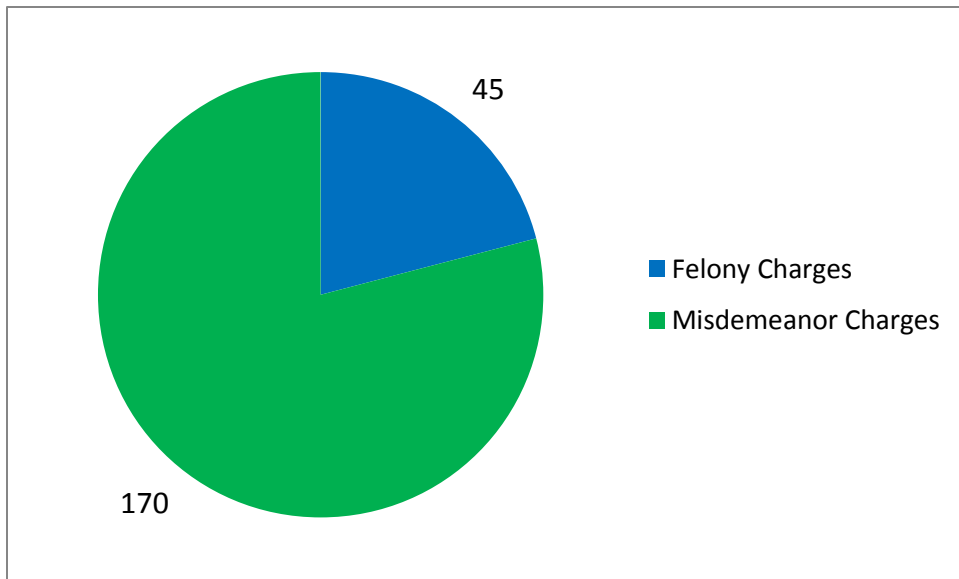
# Incidents May 2018
