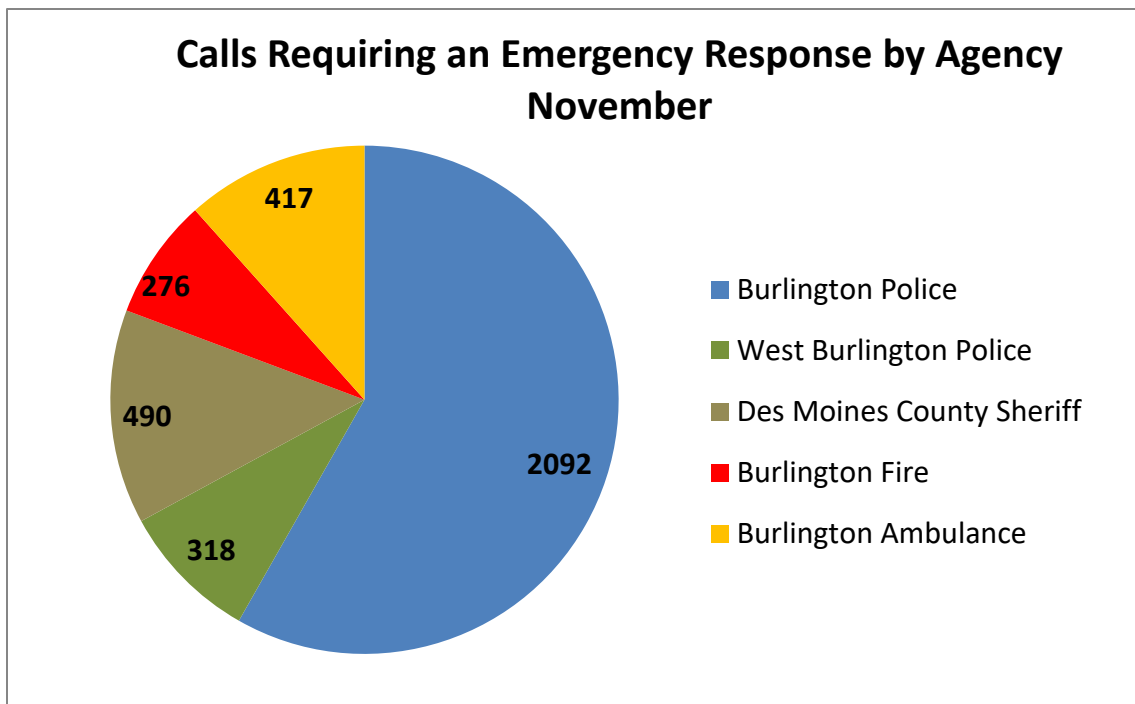

Re: Police Department Activities – November, 2018

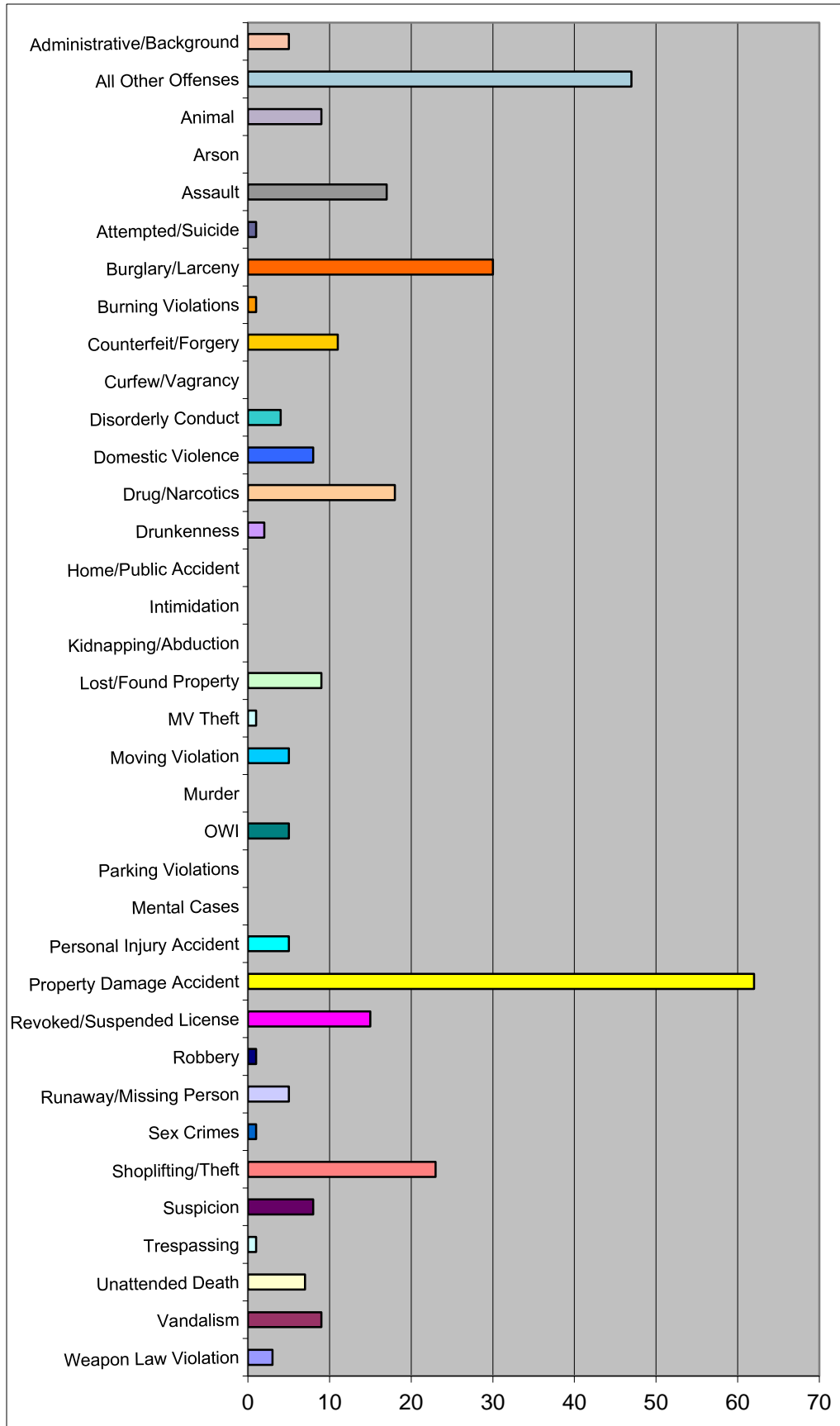
- Chief Kramer attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

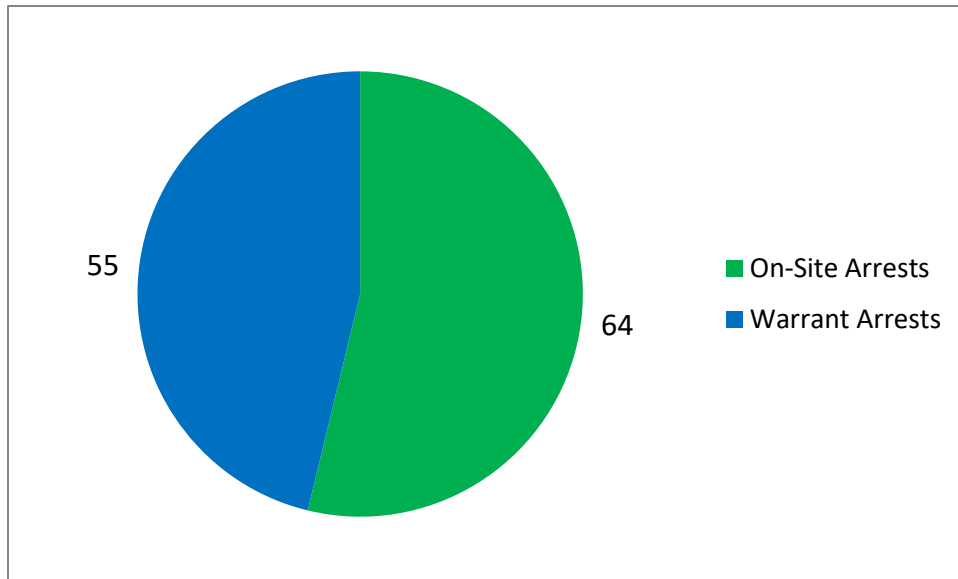

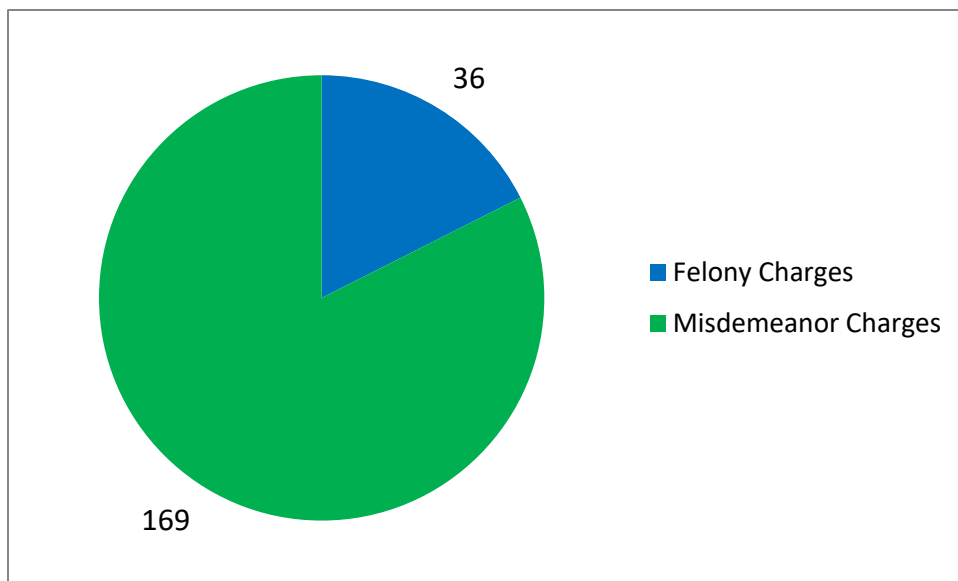
Incidents November 2018
