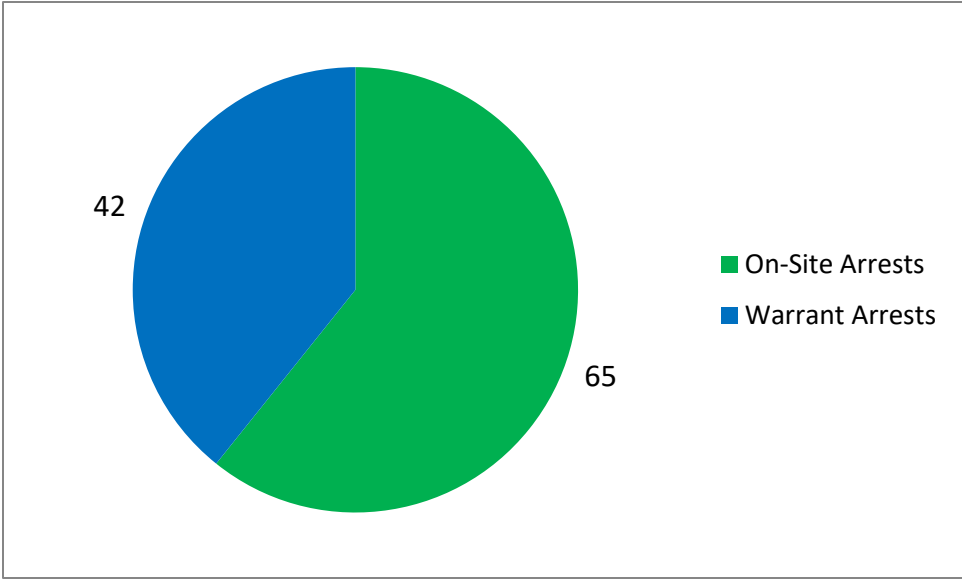

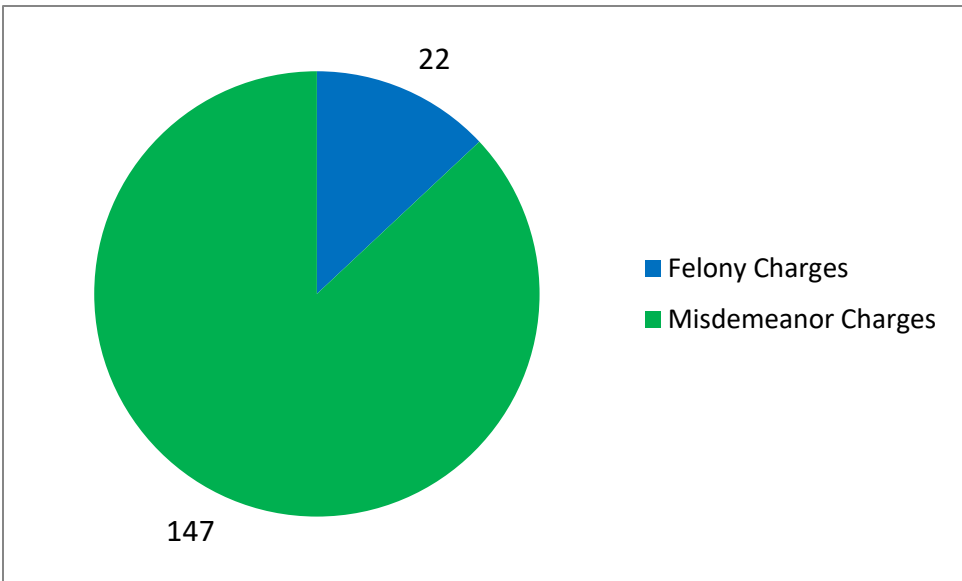
Incidents January 2019
