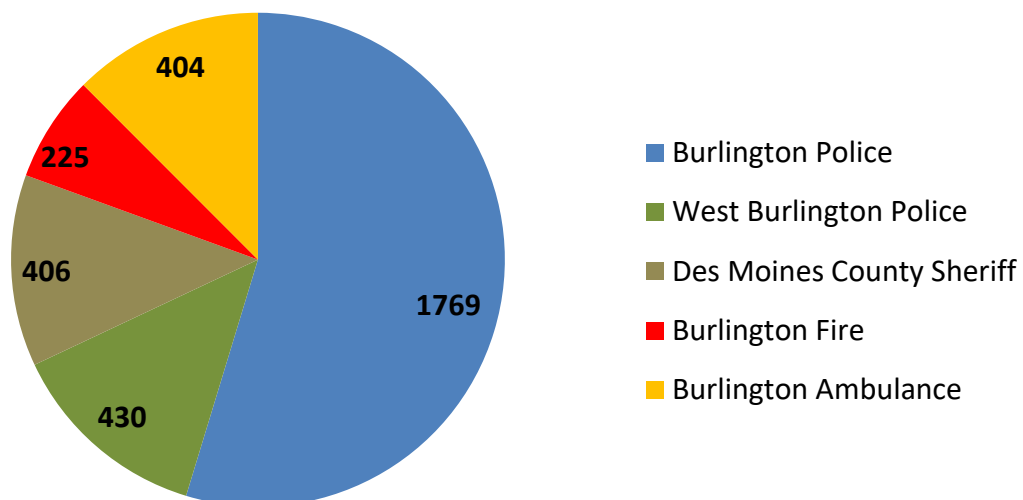

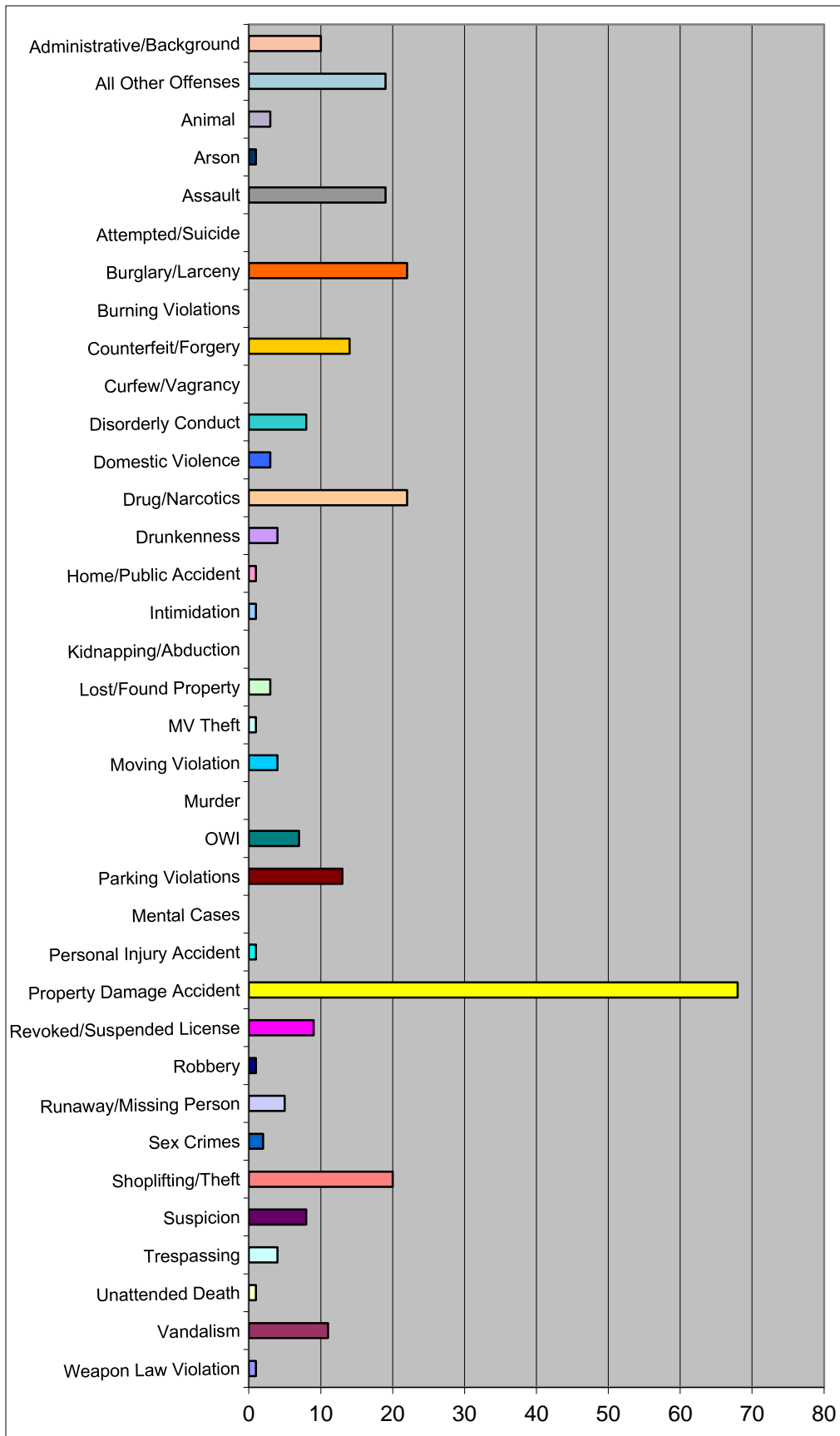
- Chief Kramer attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

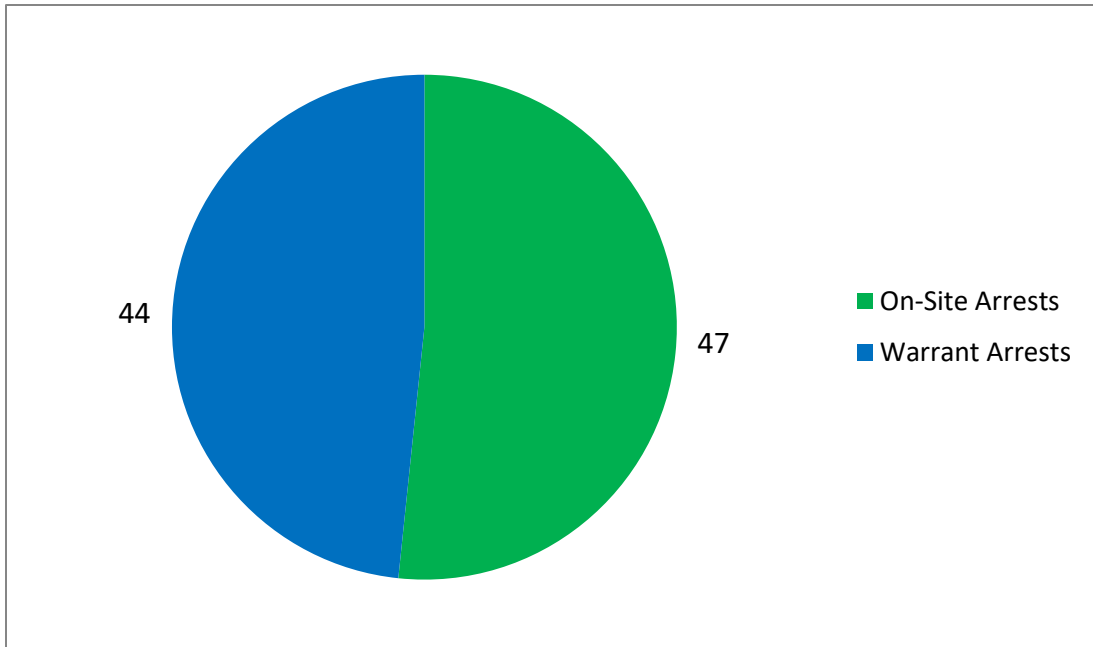
**Calls Requiring an Emergency Response by Agency  
February**



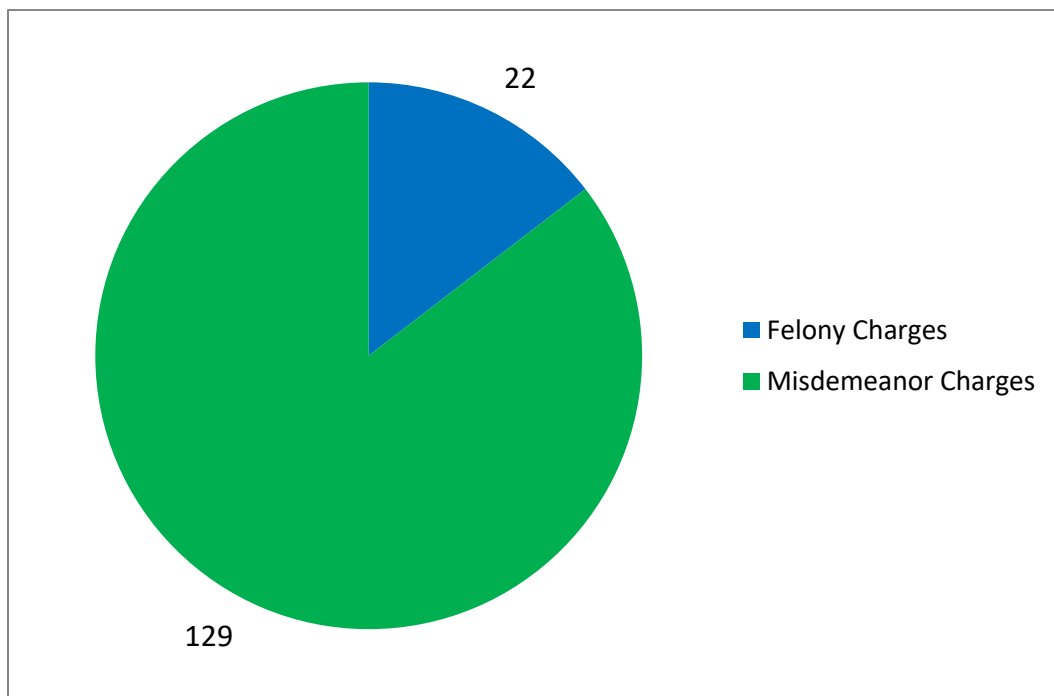
# Incidents February 2019
