Re: Police Department Activities – May 2014

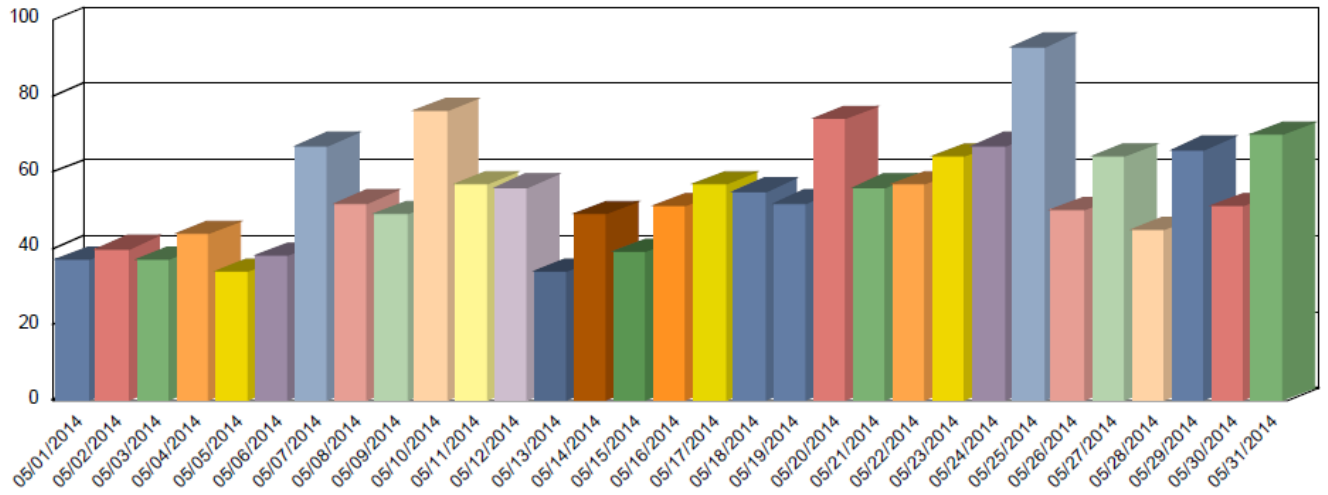


- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

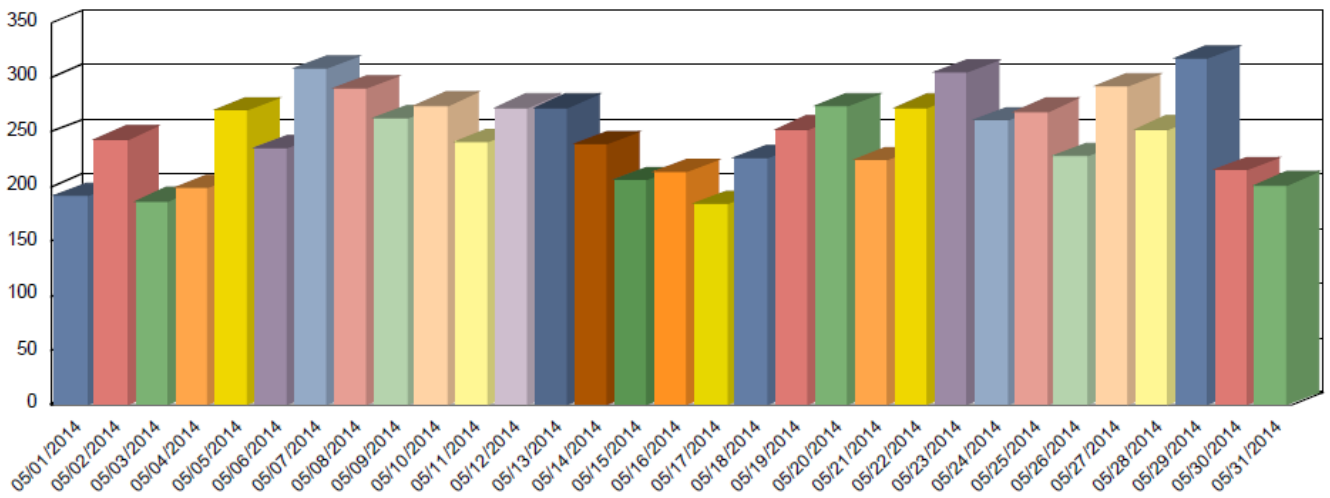
## Incoming 9-1-1 Calls May 2014

Number of Calls : 1,681

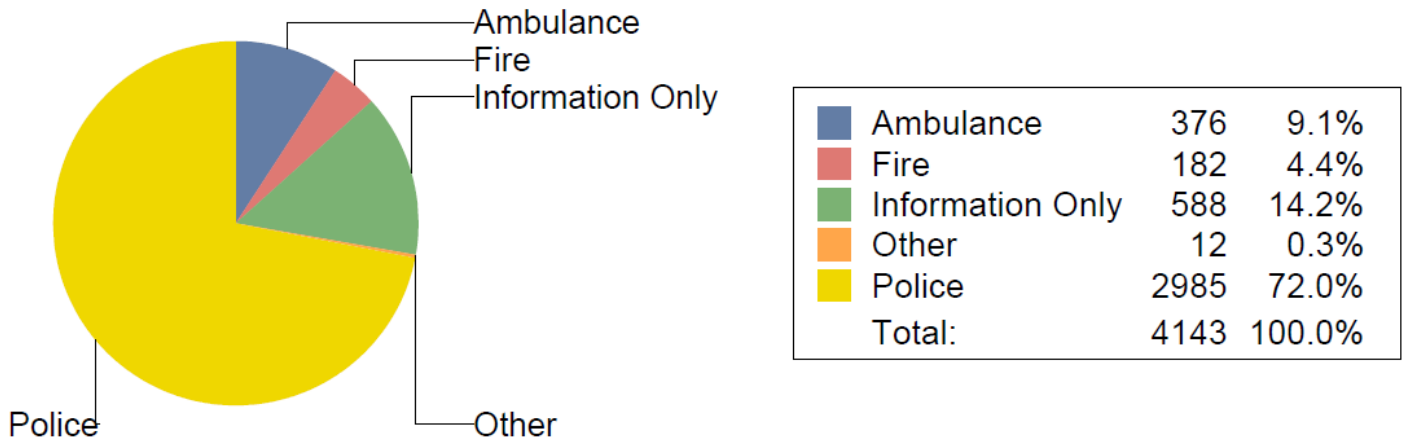


## Incoming Calls to the Communications Center May 2014

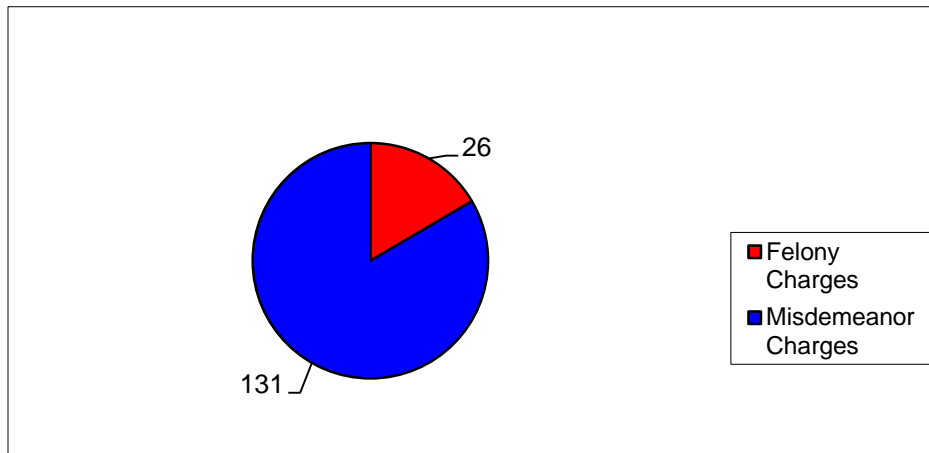

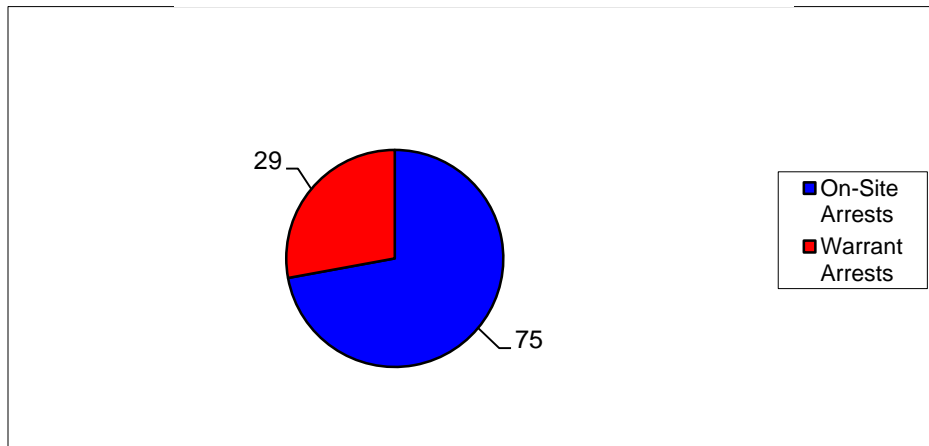
## Calls for Service May 2014



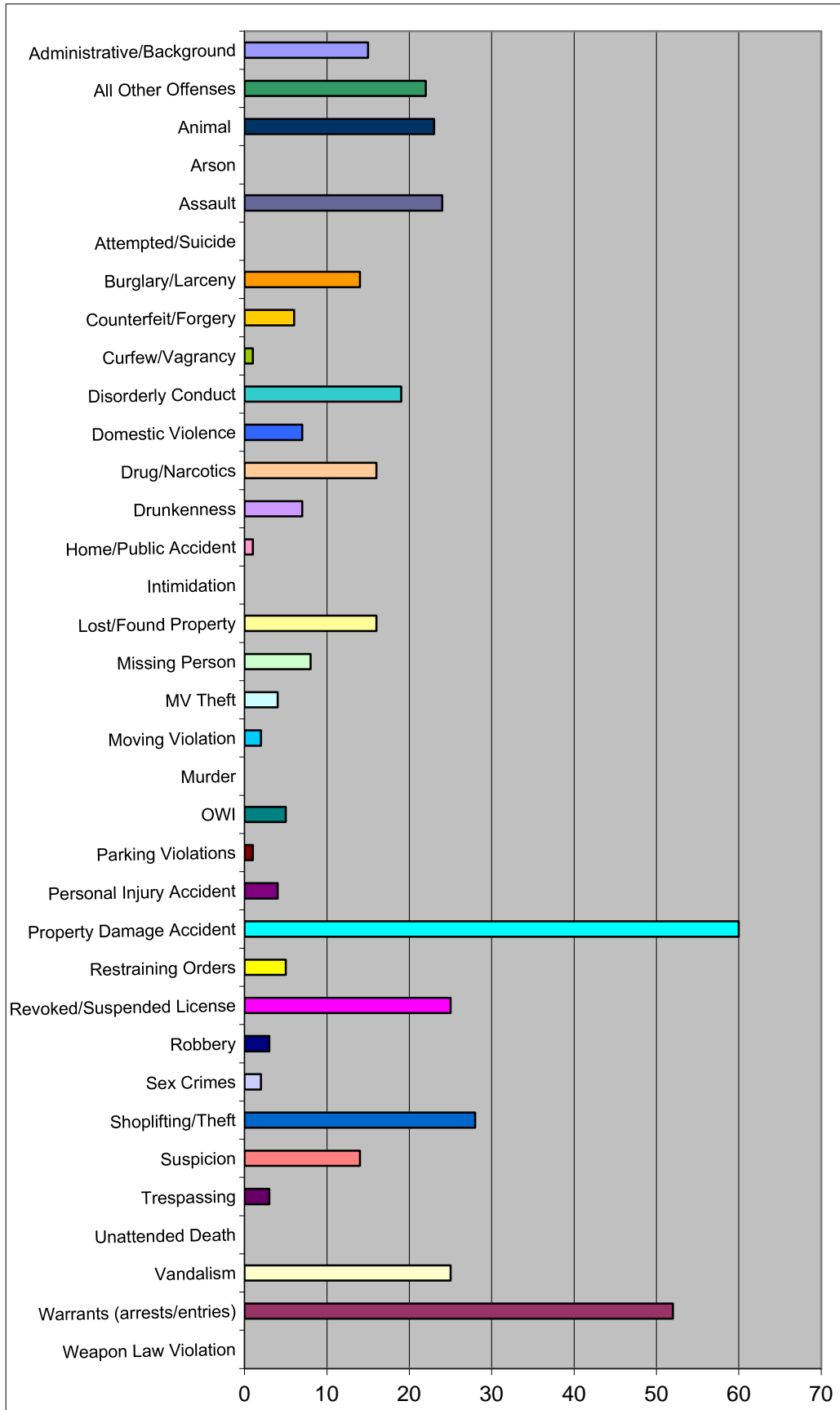
## Charges May 2014
