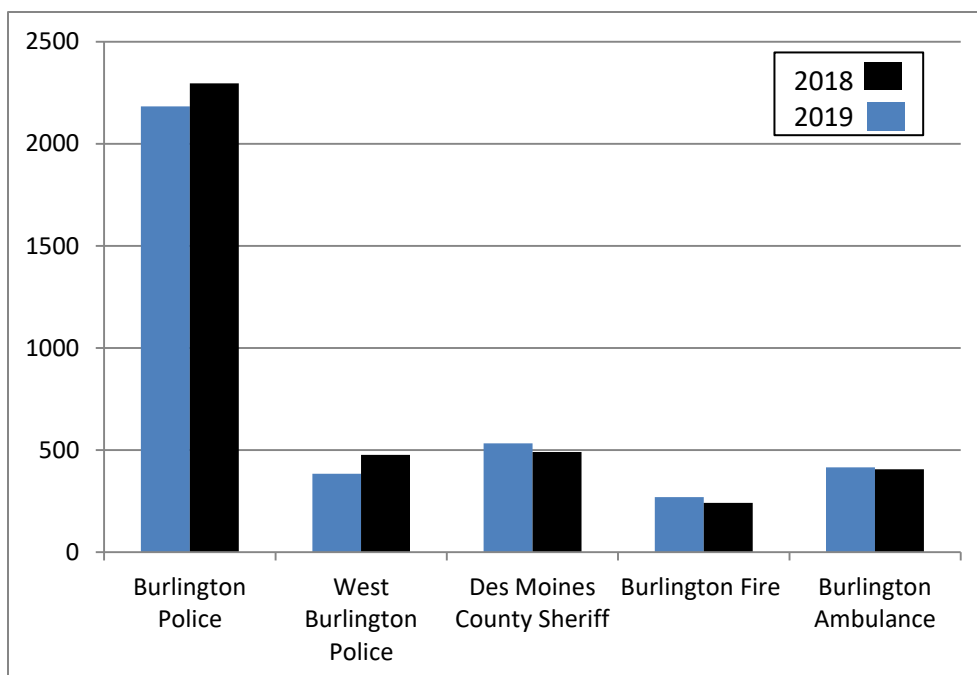

  - A meeting with Lt. Thomson and Des Moines County correctional staff about the Livescan fingerprint machine.

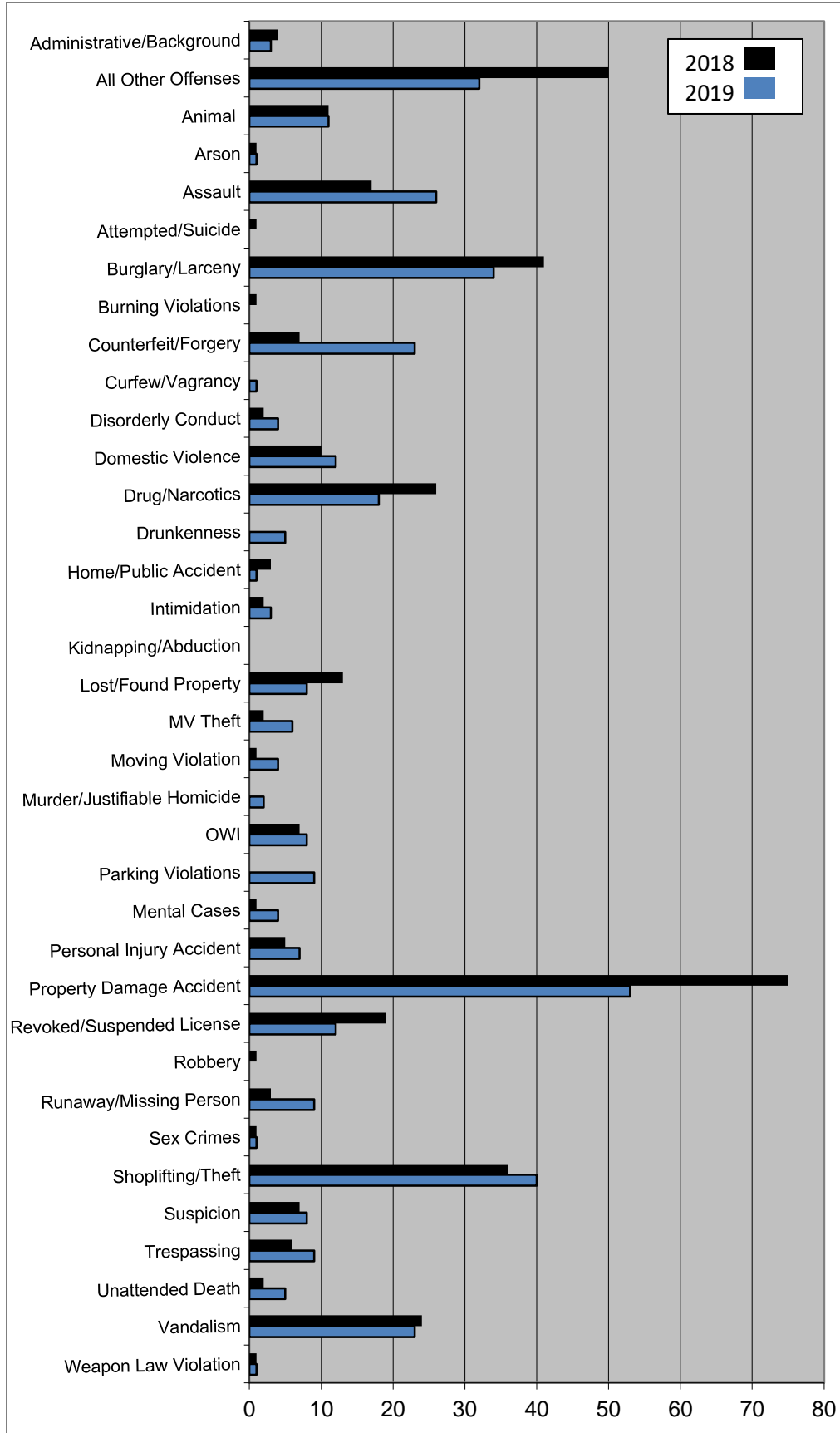
- End-of-Step meetings with two officers going through the FTO process.

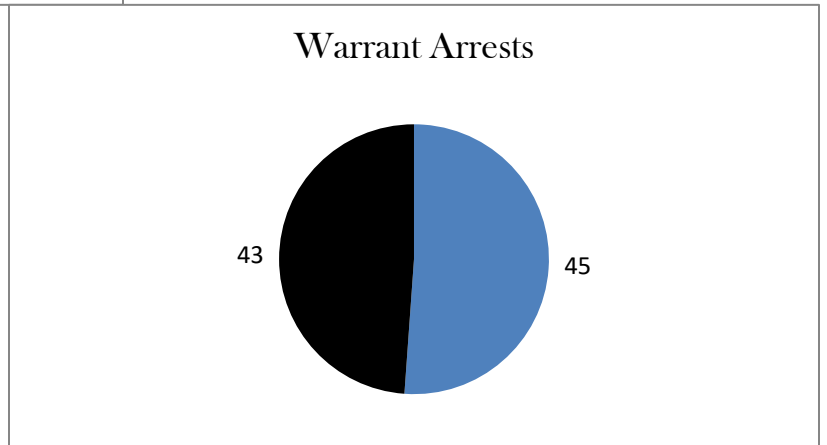
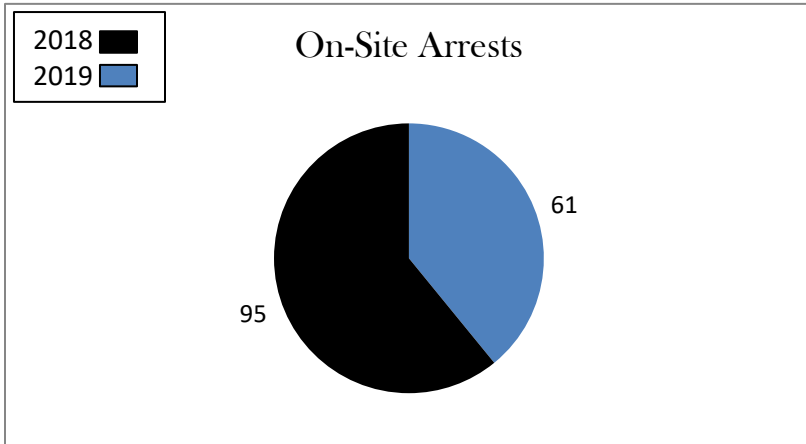

September 2018 vs. September 2019



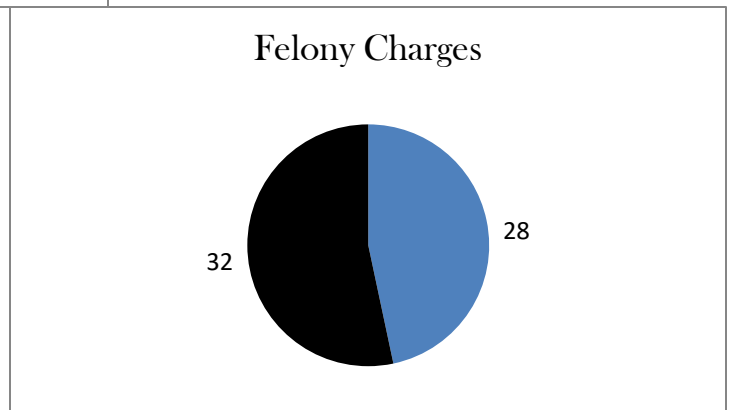
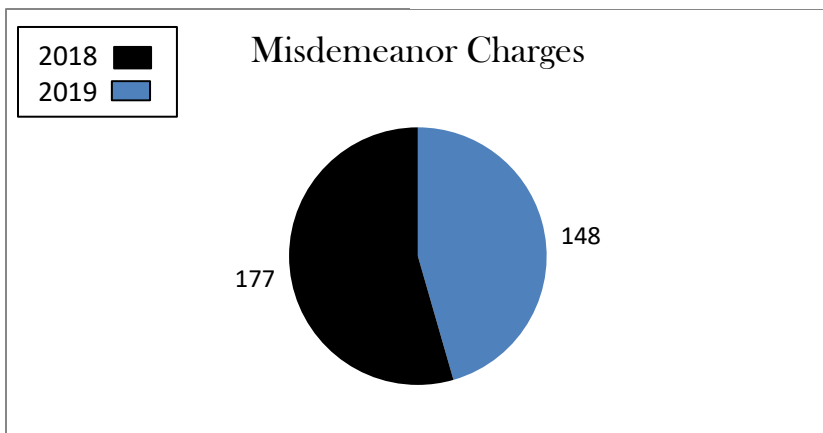
## Arrest Types
