Re: Police Department Activities – August 2020

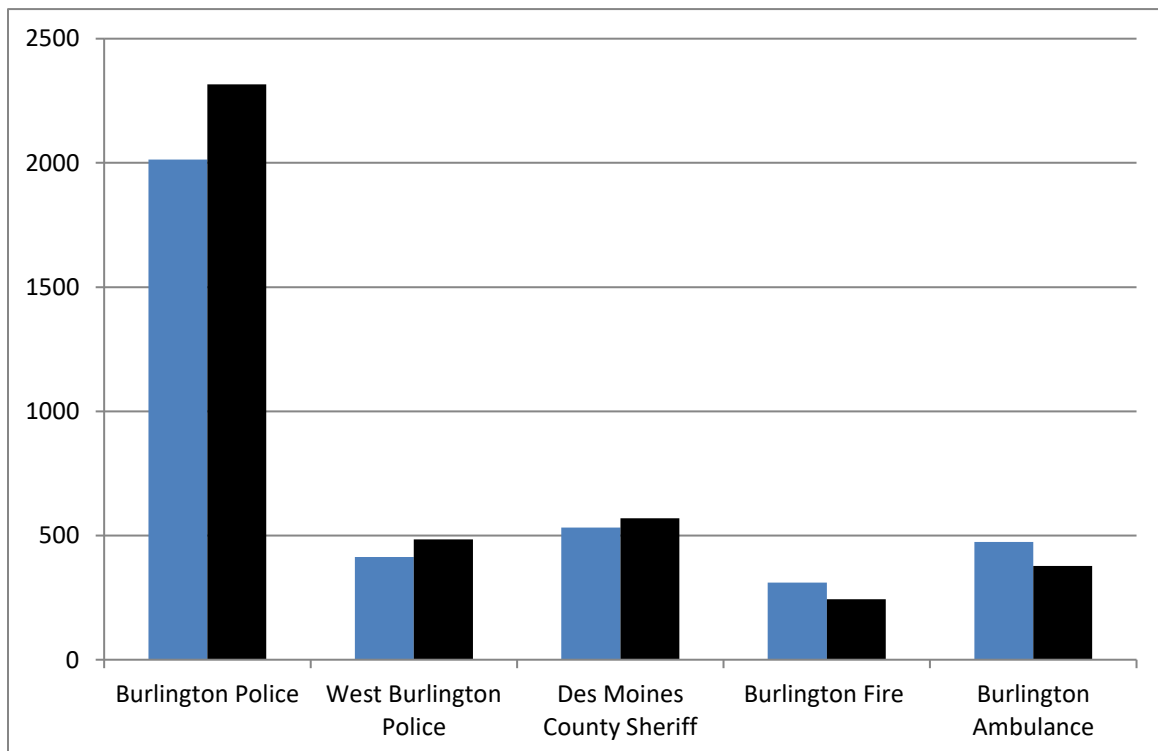
***The issuance of a State of Public Health Disaster Emergency by Gov. Reynolds on March 17<sup>th</sup> and Mayor Billups Emergency Proclamation also on March 17<sup>th</sup> directly impacted the citizens of the community and daily operations of the Burlington Police Department as can be seen in the following activity report and statistics.***

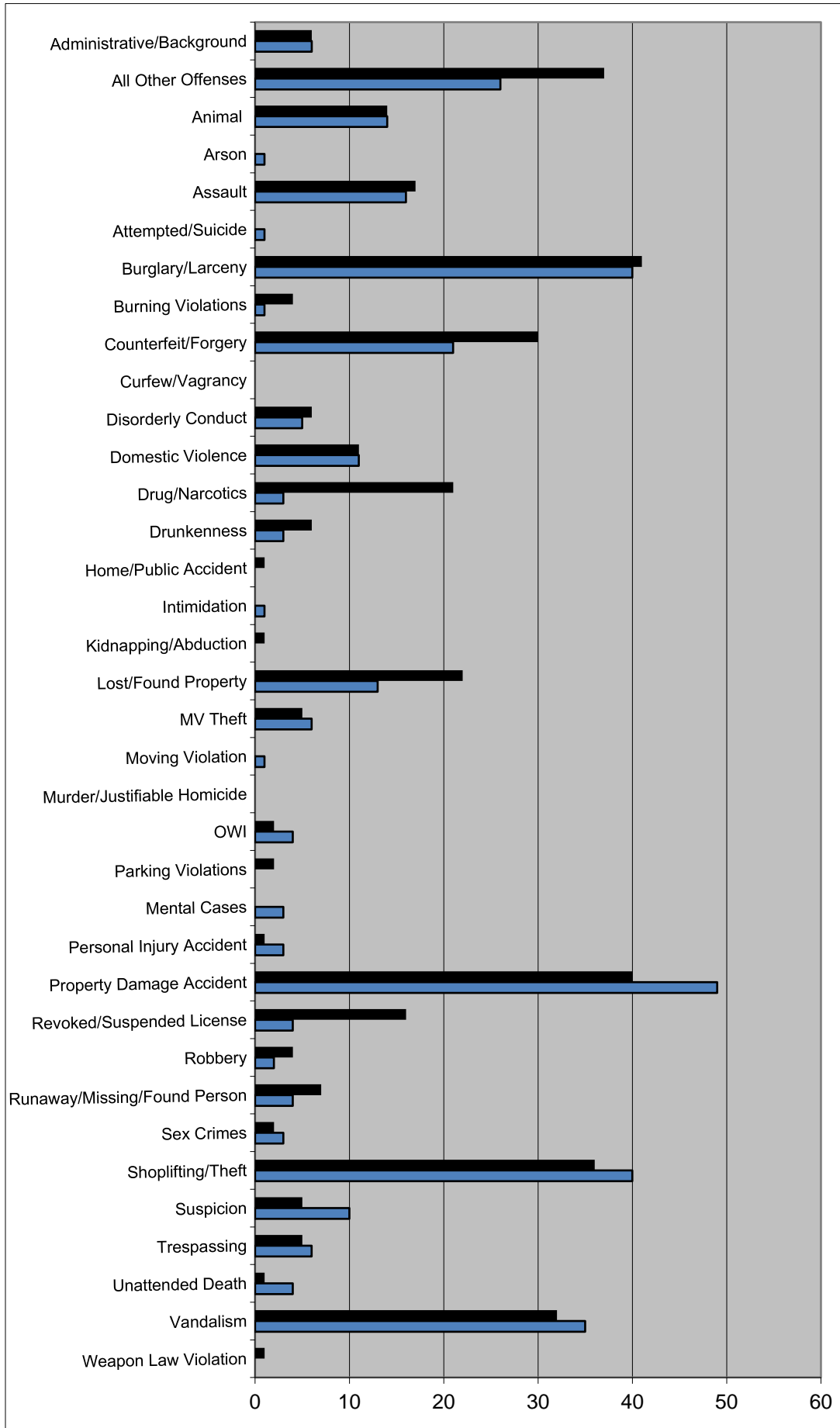

August 2020 vs. August 2019



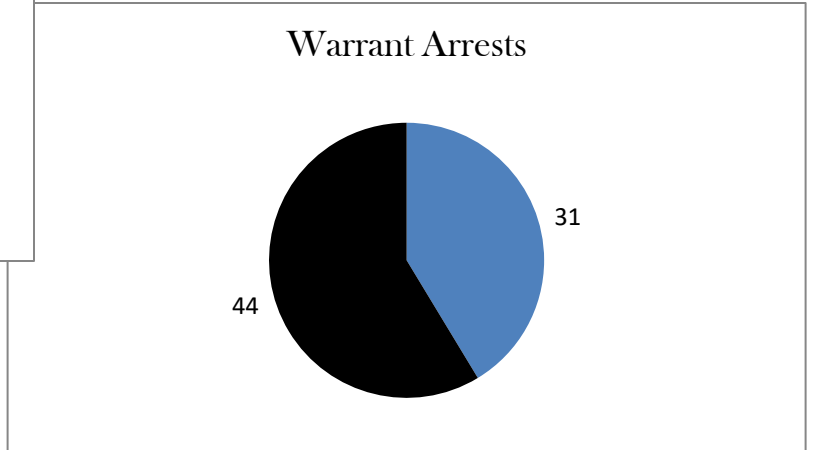
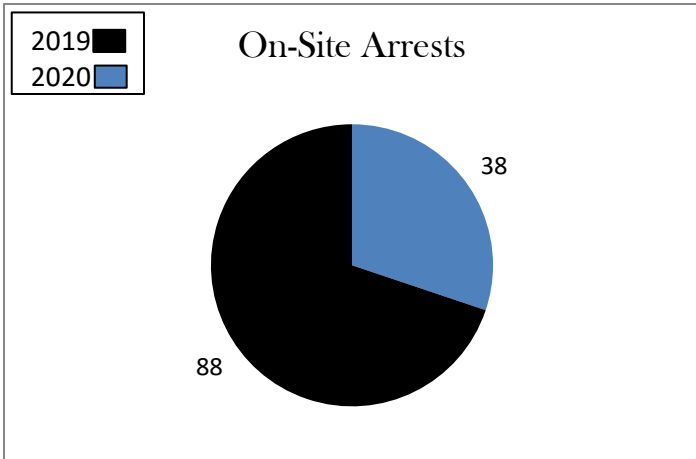

August 2020 vs. August 2019



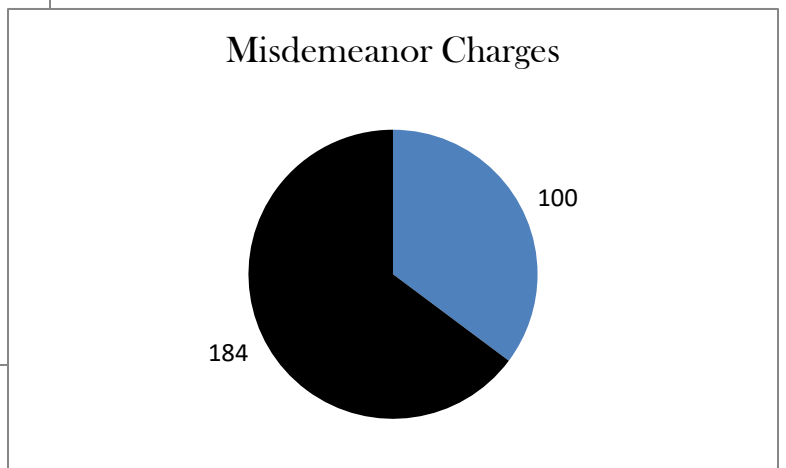
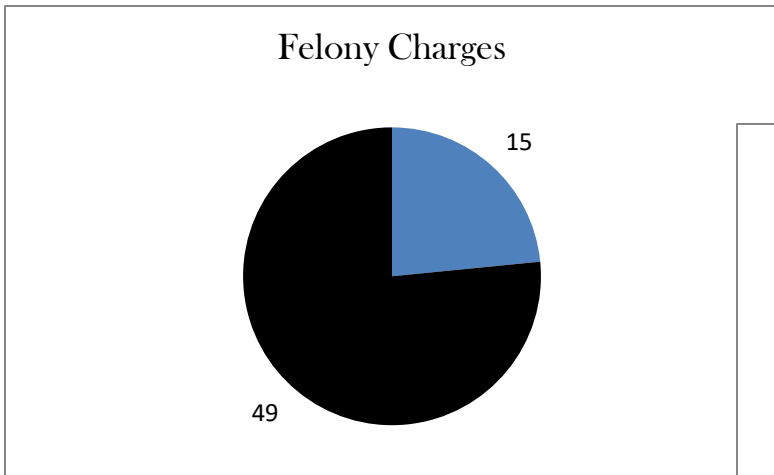
## Arrest Types
