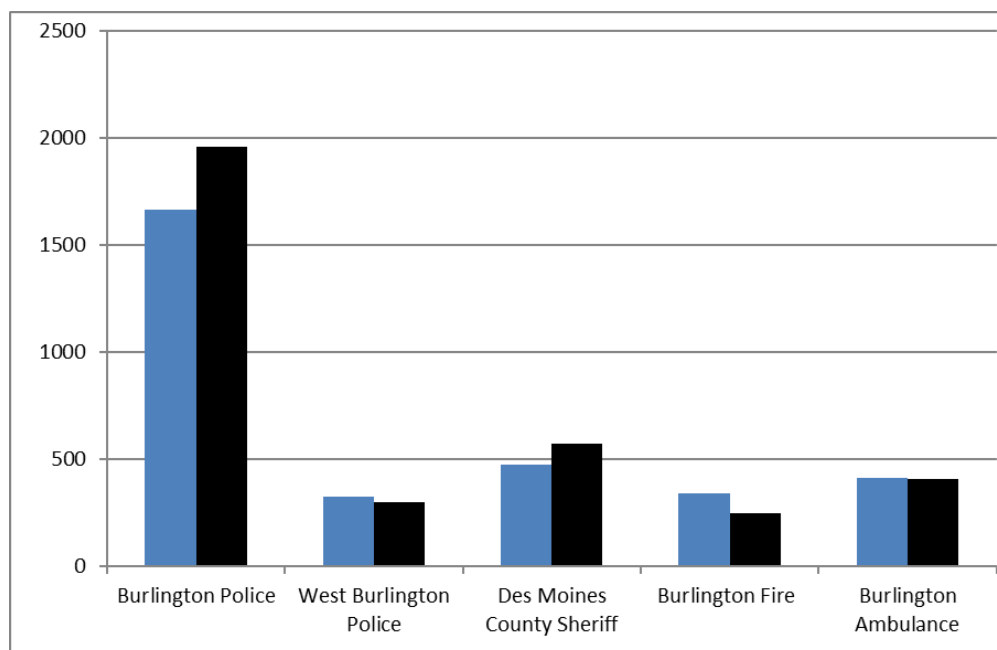

During the month of January, there were 62 animals received at the Animal Shelter. Please see the attached police department statistics for the month of February 2021 as well as comparative stats from February 2020:

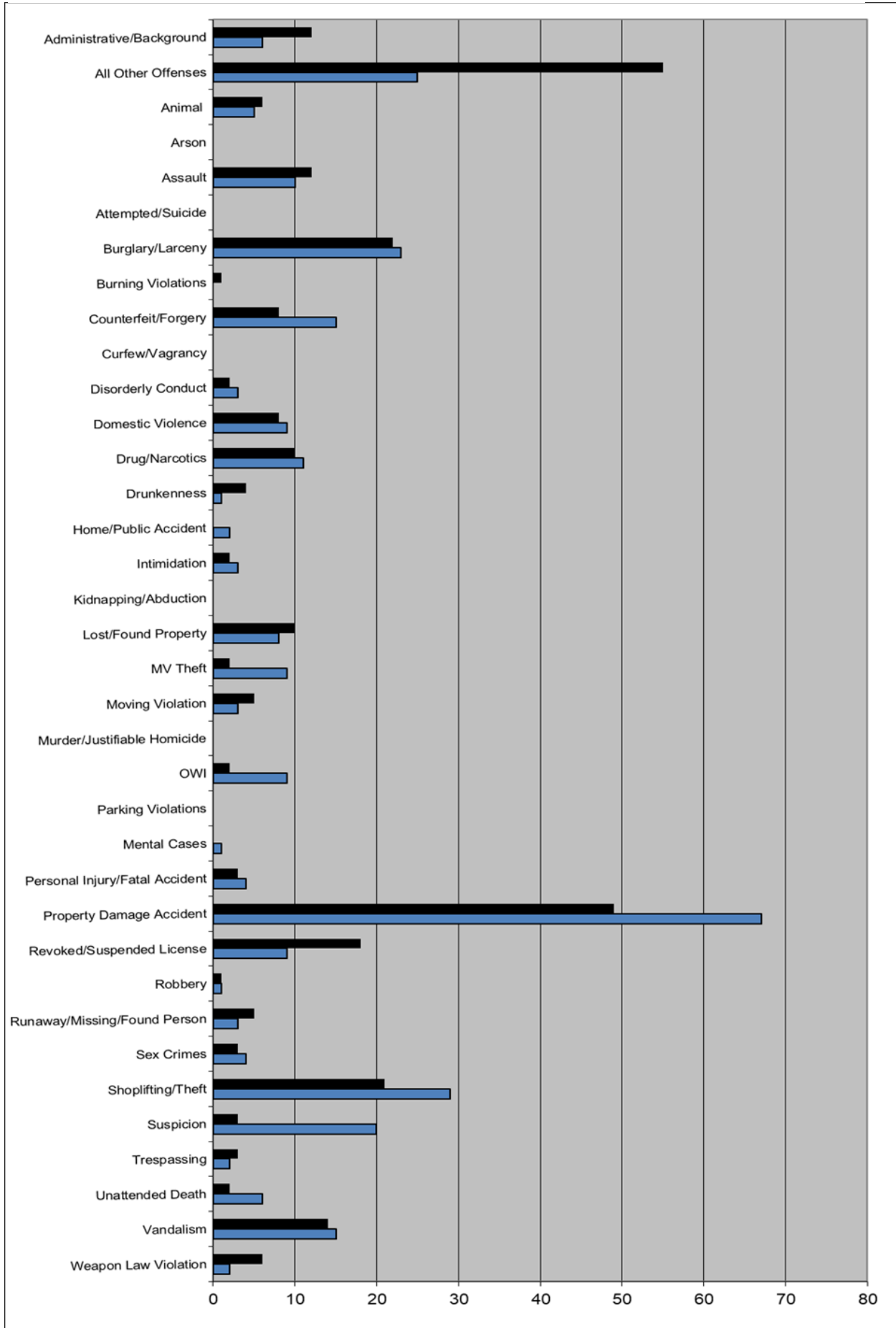

February 2021 vs. February 2020

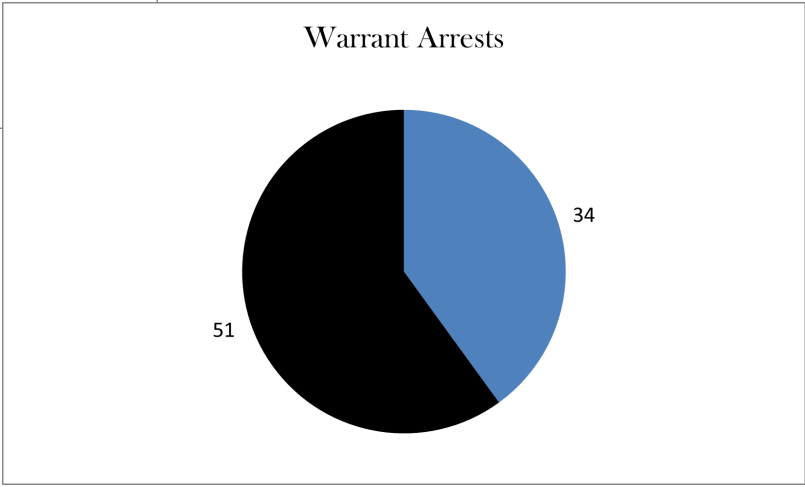
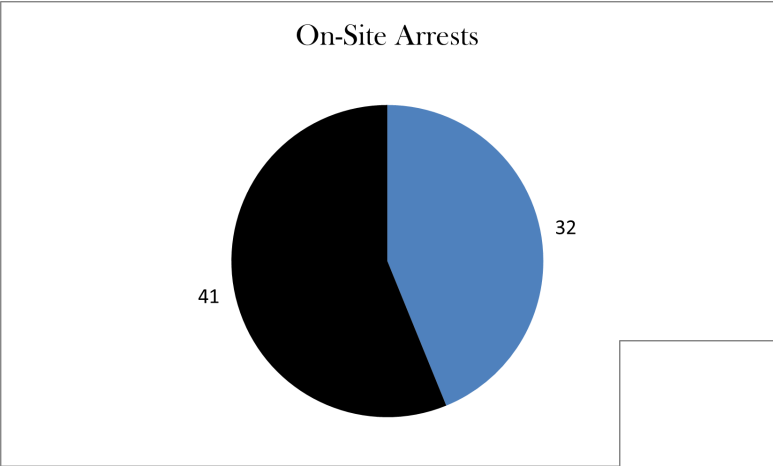

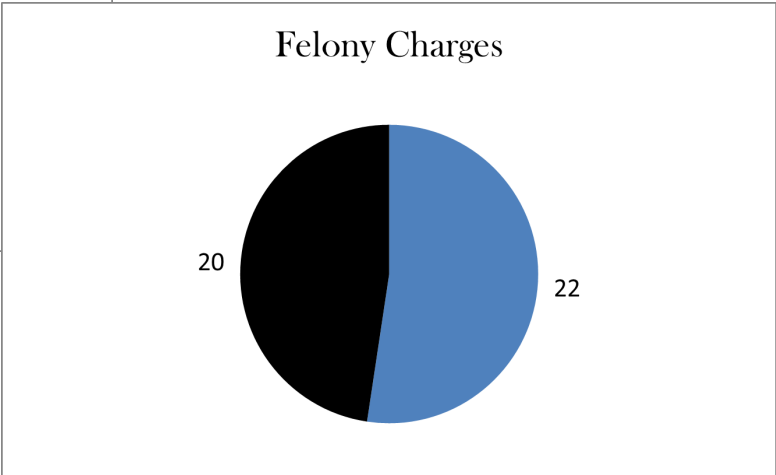
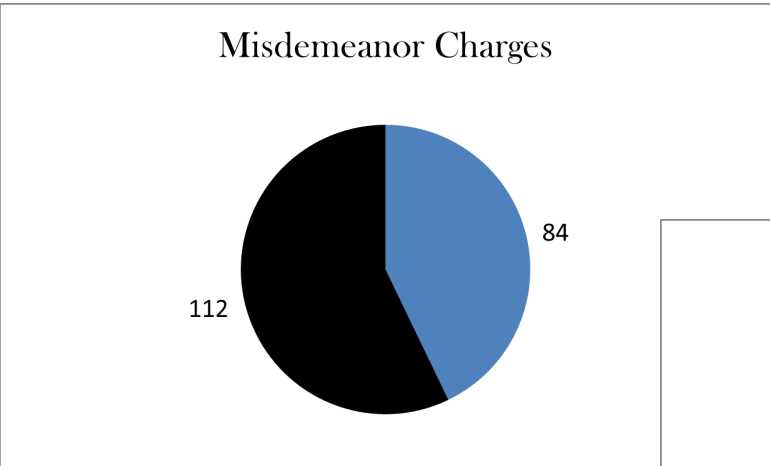
February 2021 vs. February 2020
