


During the month of January, there were 62 animals received at the Animal Shelter. Please see the attached police department statistics for the month of February 2021 as well as comparative stats from February 2020:

Calls for Service Incidents Arrests and Charges Violent Crime (2015 to present)


Calls Requiring an Emergency Response by Agency February **2021** vs. February **2020** 




Incidents
