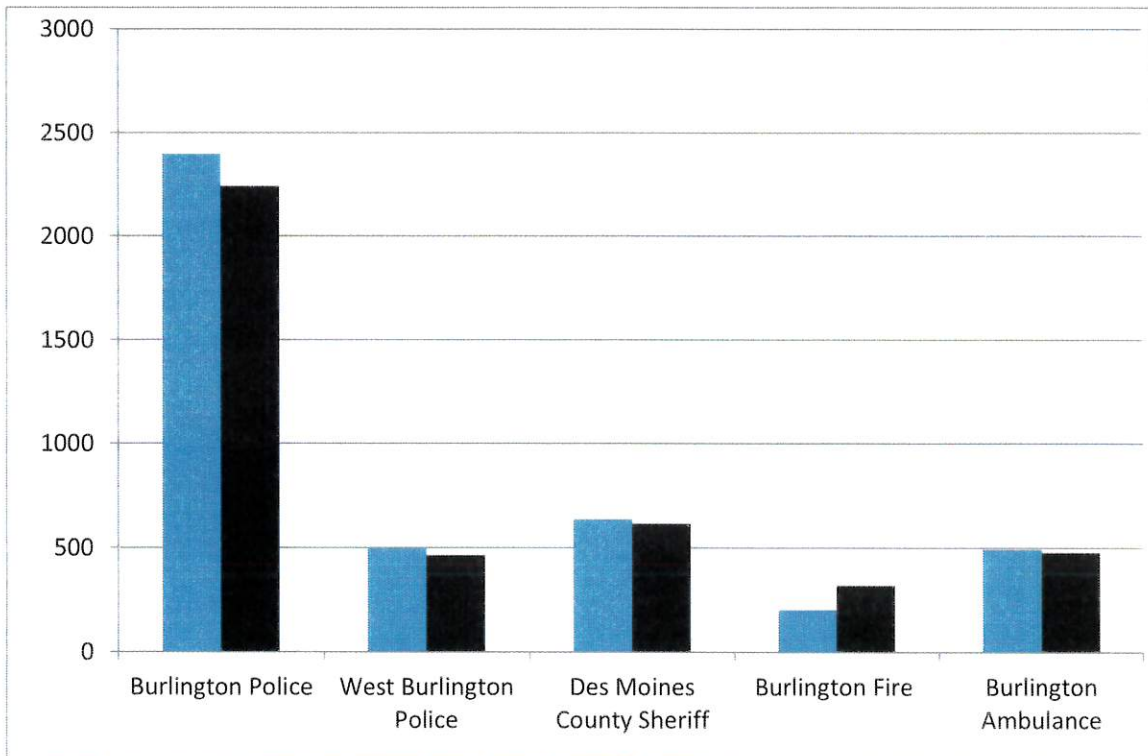

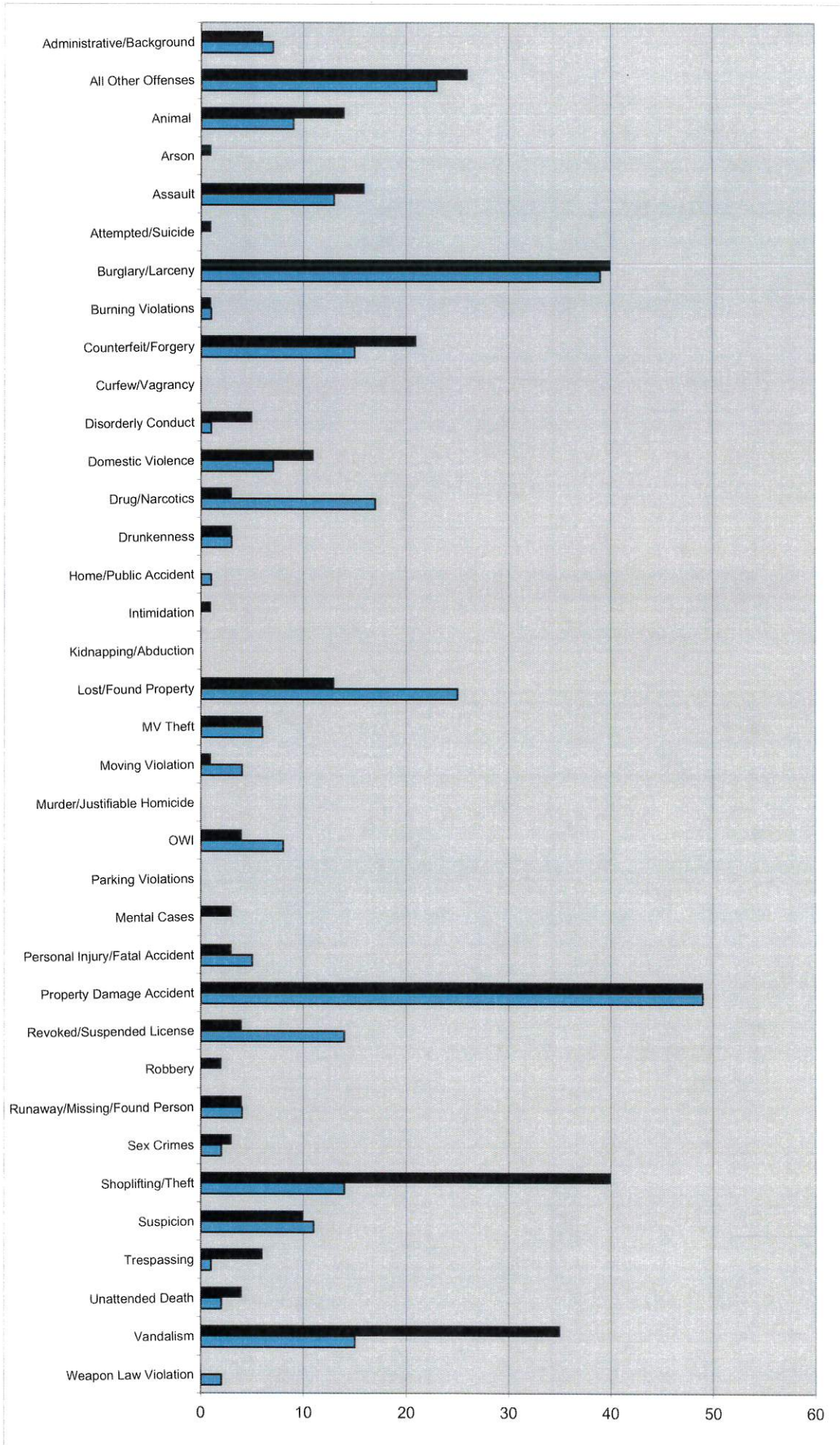
Calls Requiring an Emergency Response by Agency  
August 2021 vs. August 2020





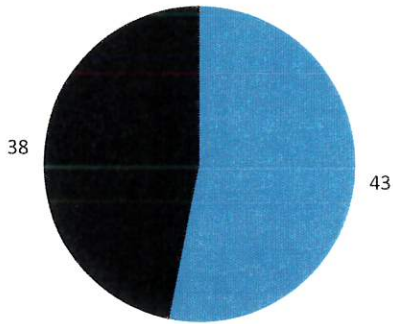

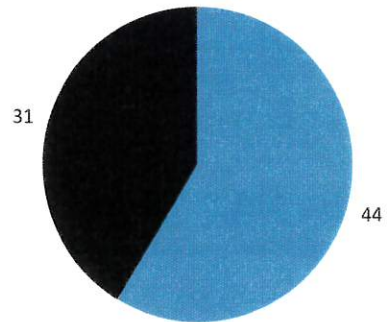


### Arrest Types August 2021 vs August 2020

On-Site Arrests

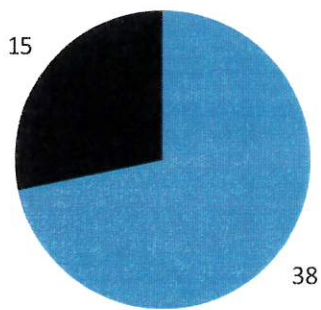


Warrant Arrests

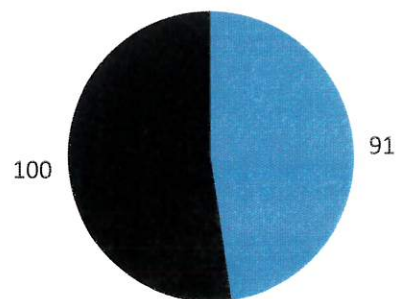


### Charge Types August 2021 vs August 2020

Misdemeanor Charges

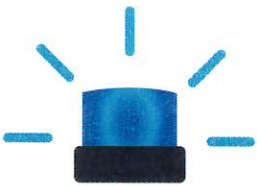
