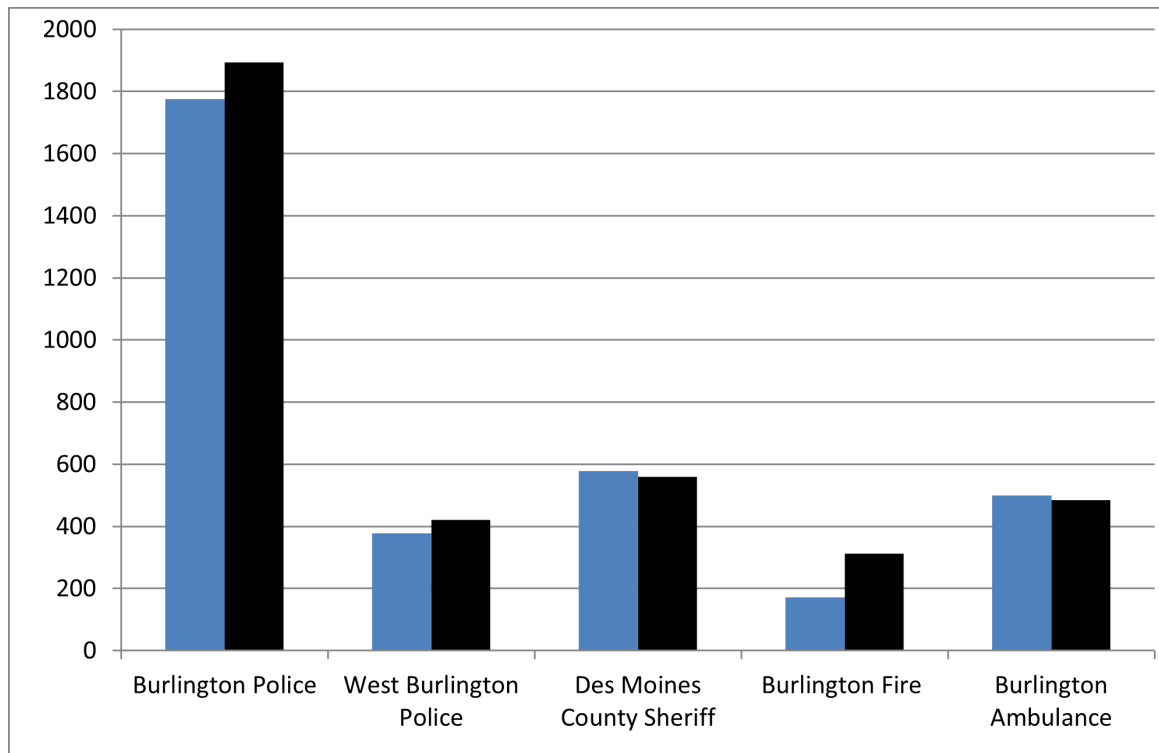
## Events attended by various Command Officers and Police Officers included:

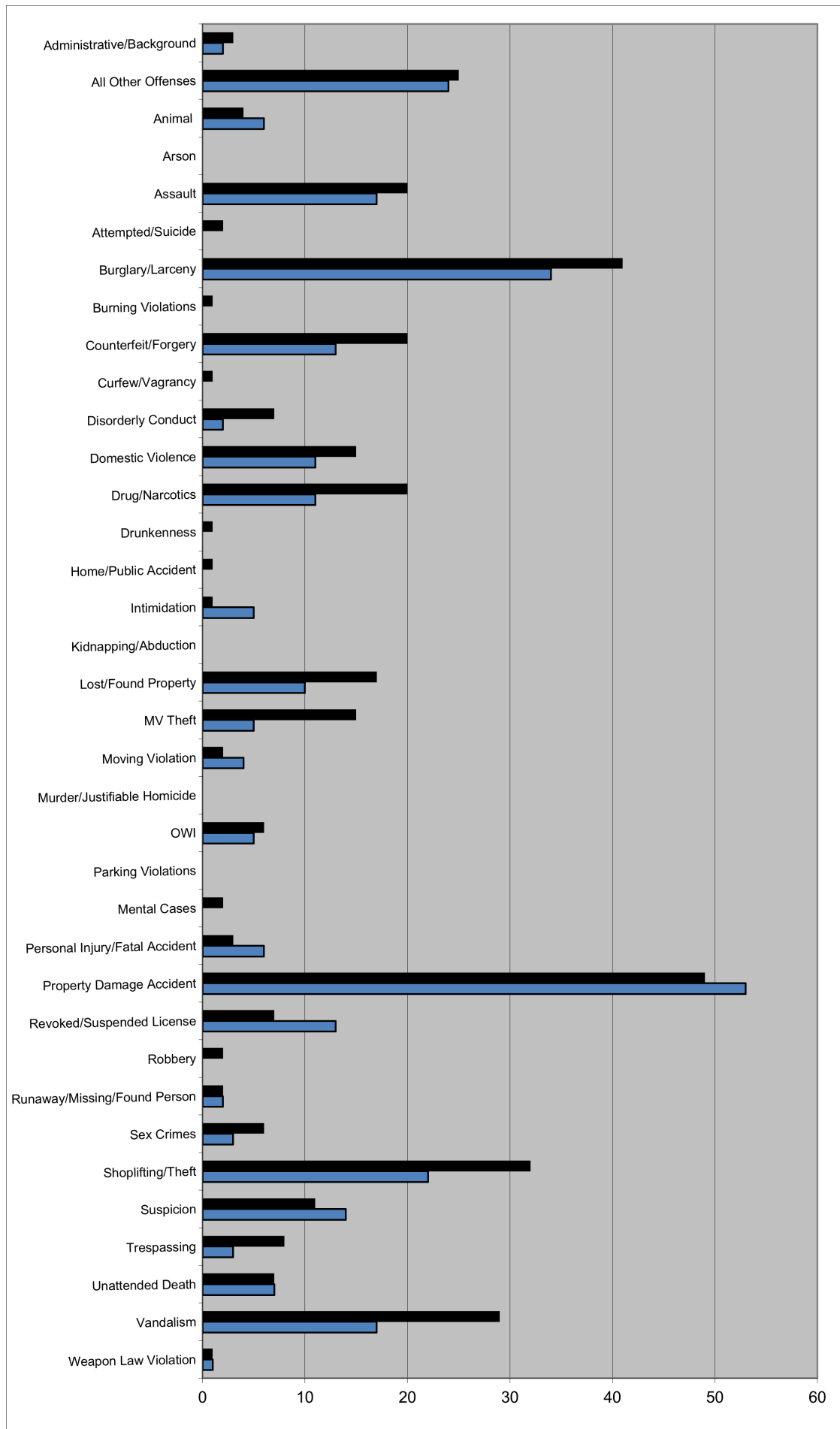

October 2021 vs. October 2020



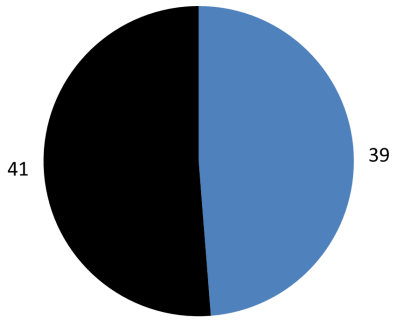

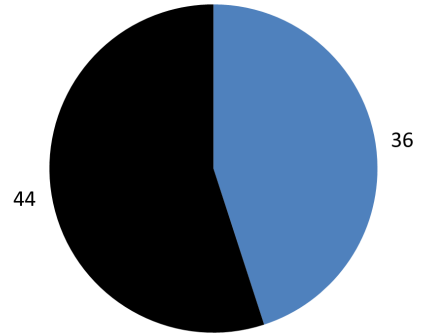


Arrest Types

On-Site Arrests

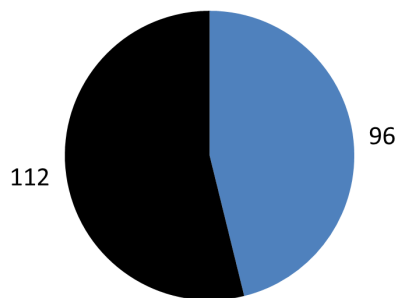


Warrant Arrests

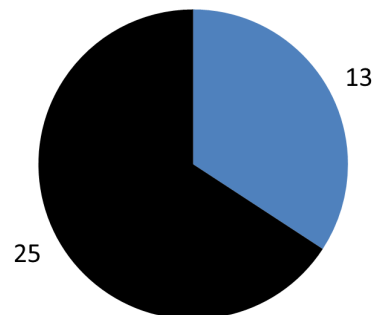


Charge Types
