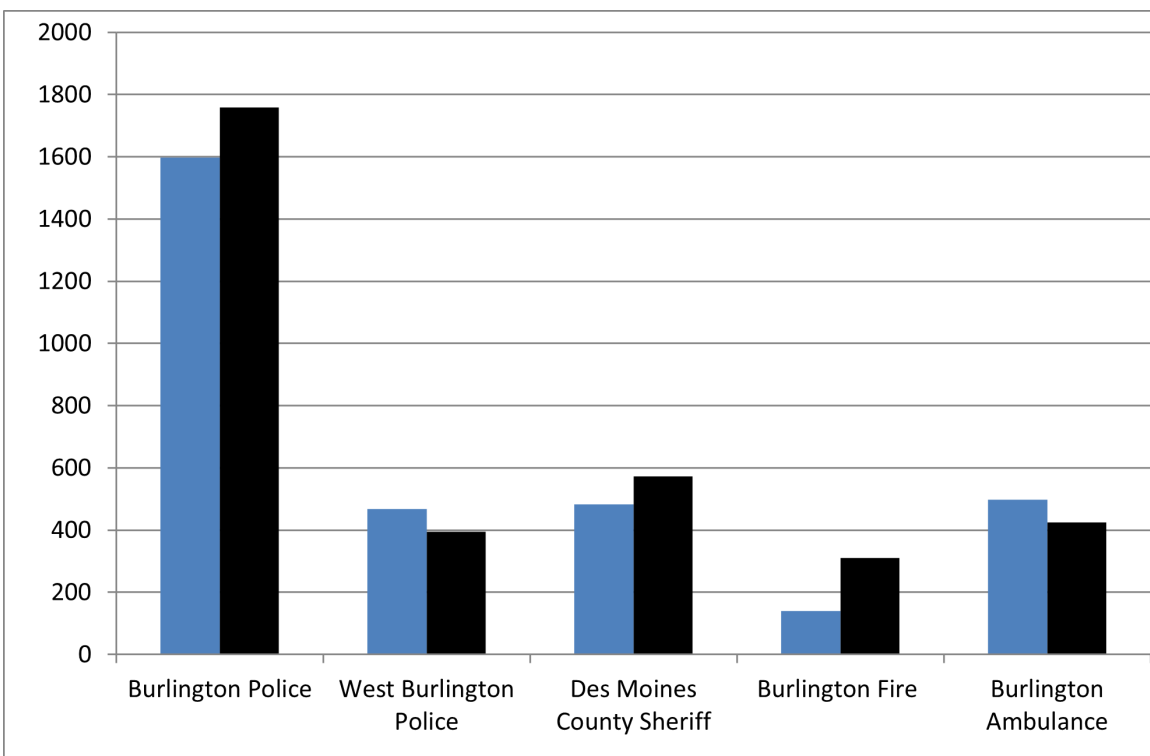

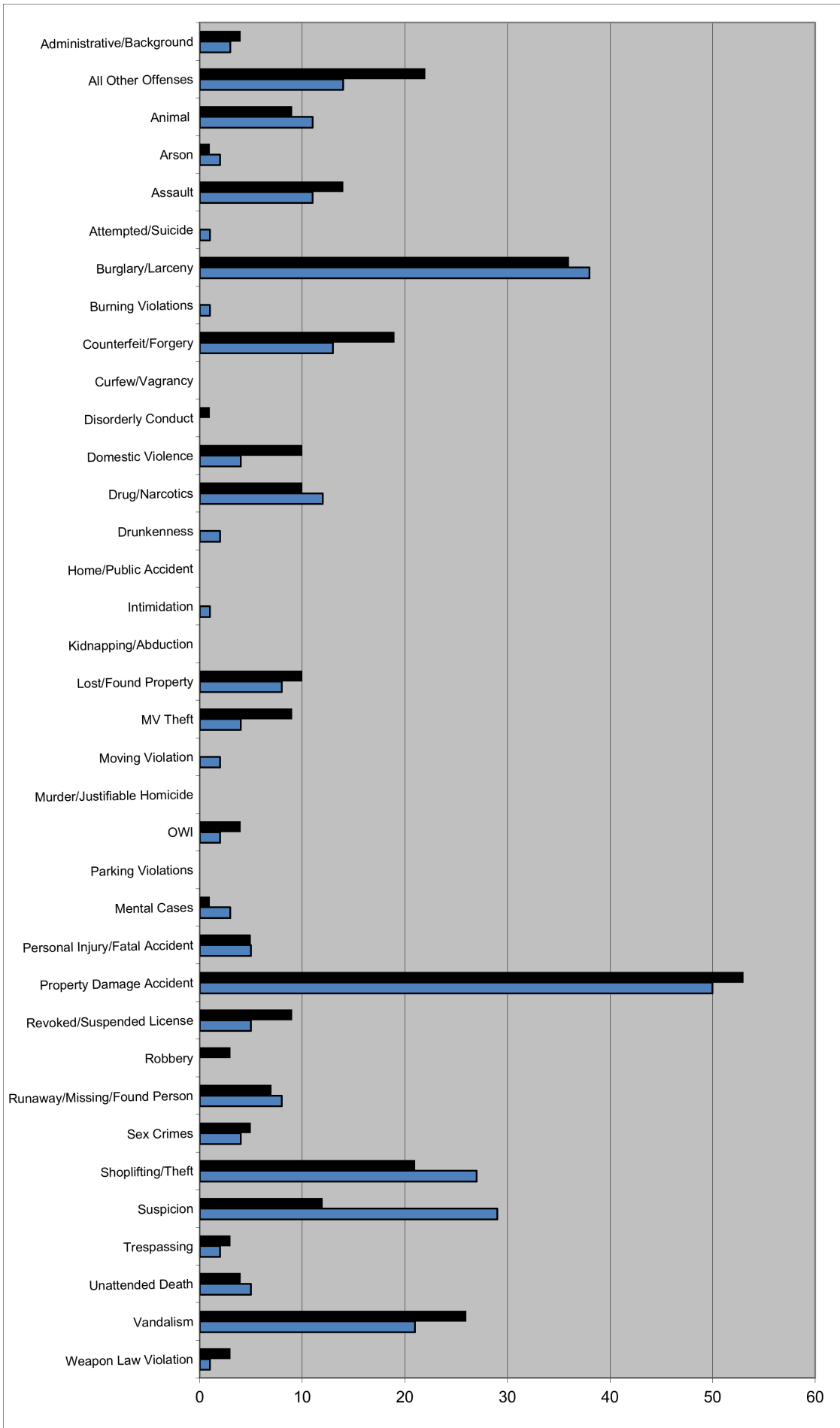

December **2021** vs. December **2020**



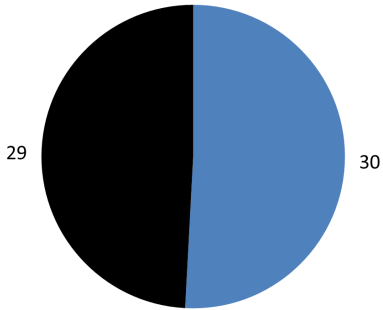

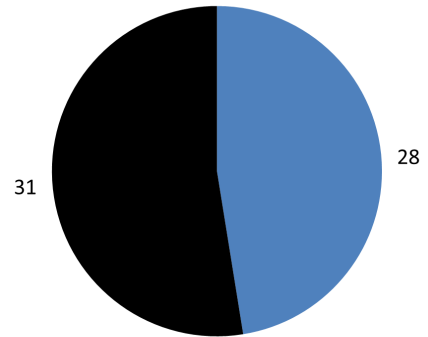


Arrest Types

On-Site Arrests

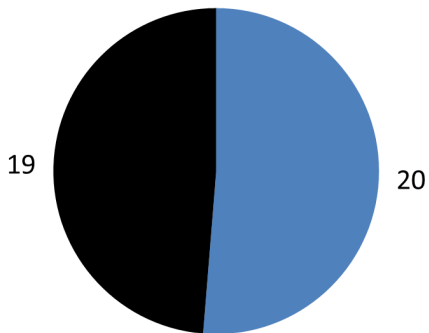


Warrant Arrests

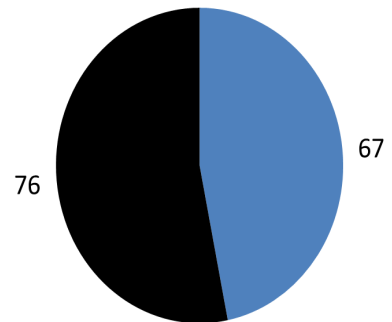


Charge Types
