

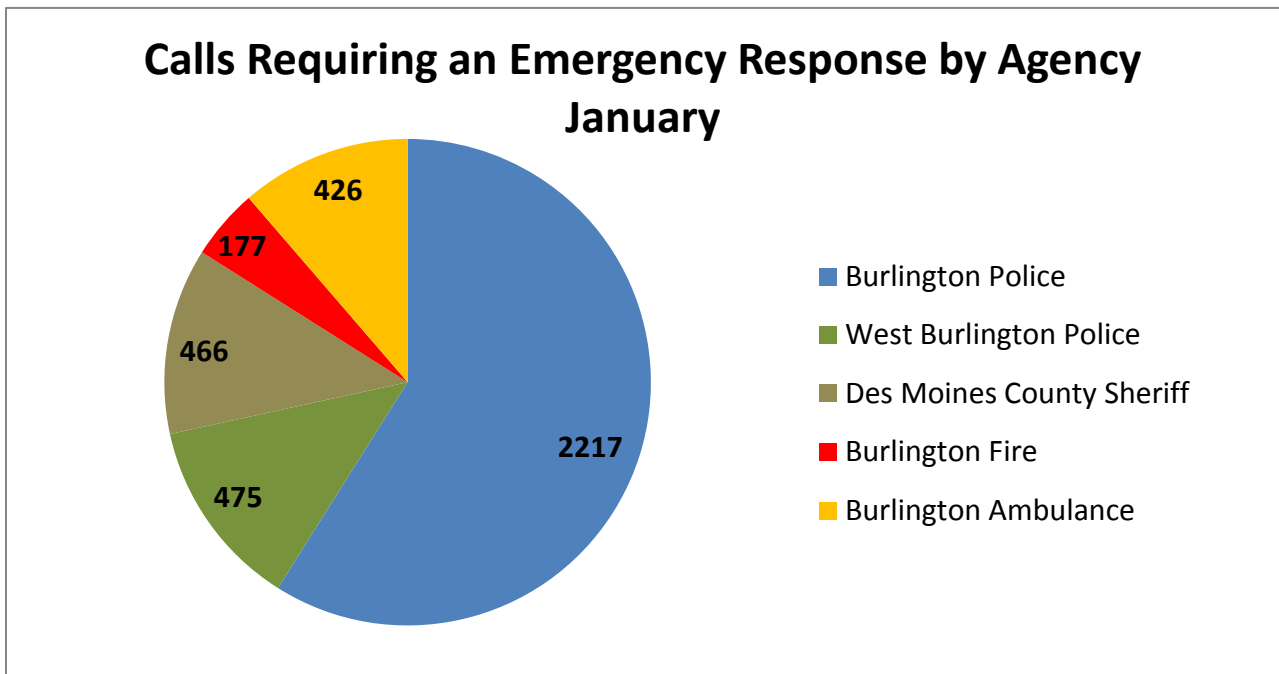

Re: Police Department Activities – January, 2015

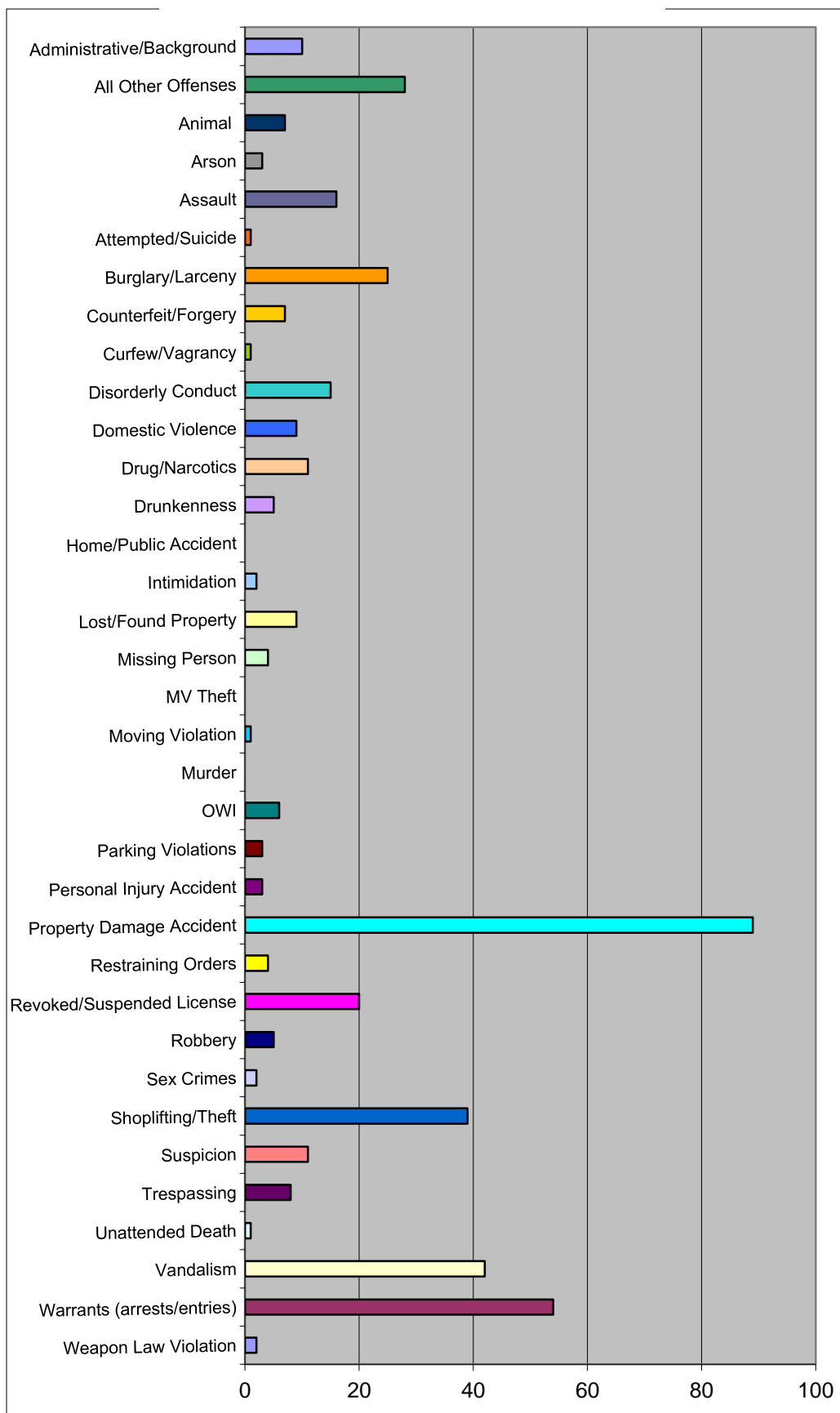


- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

- The Command Staff met for the monthly staff meeting.

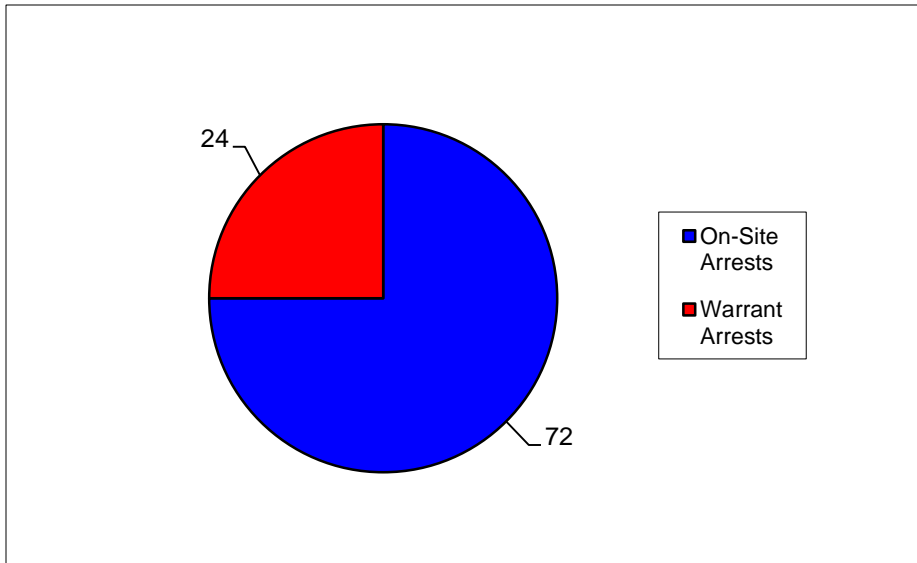
- During the month of January, 80 animals were received at the Animal Shelter.

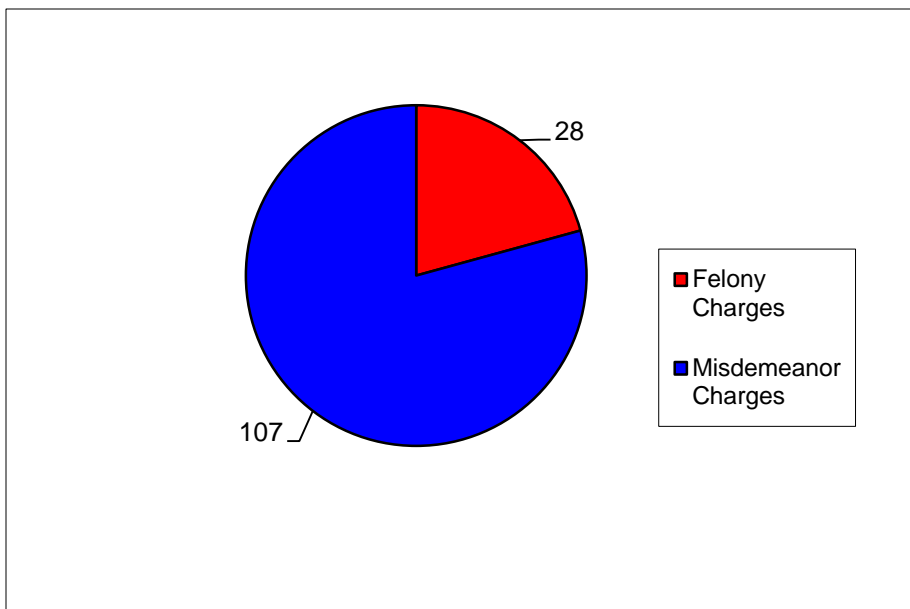
Incidents January 2015
