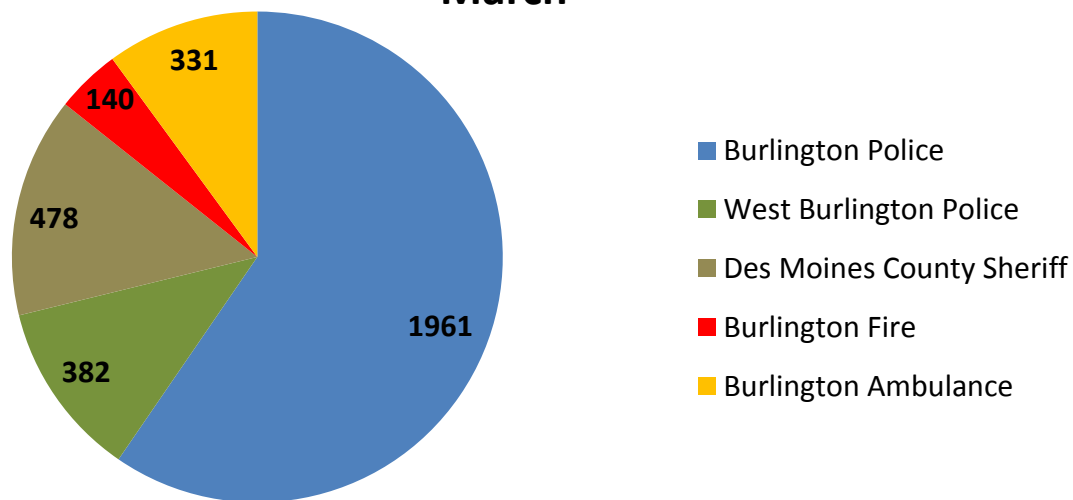

Re: Police Department Activities – March, 2015



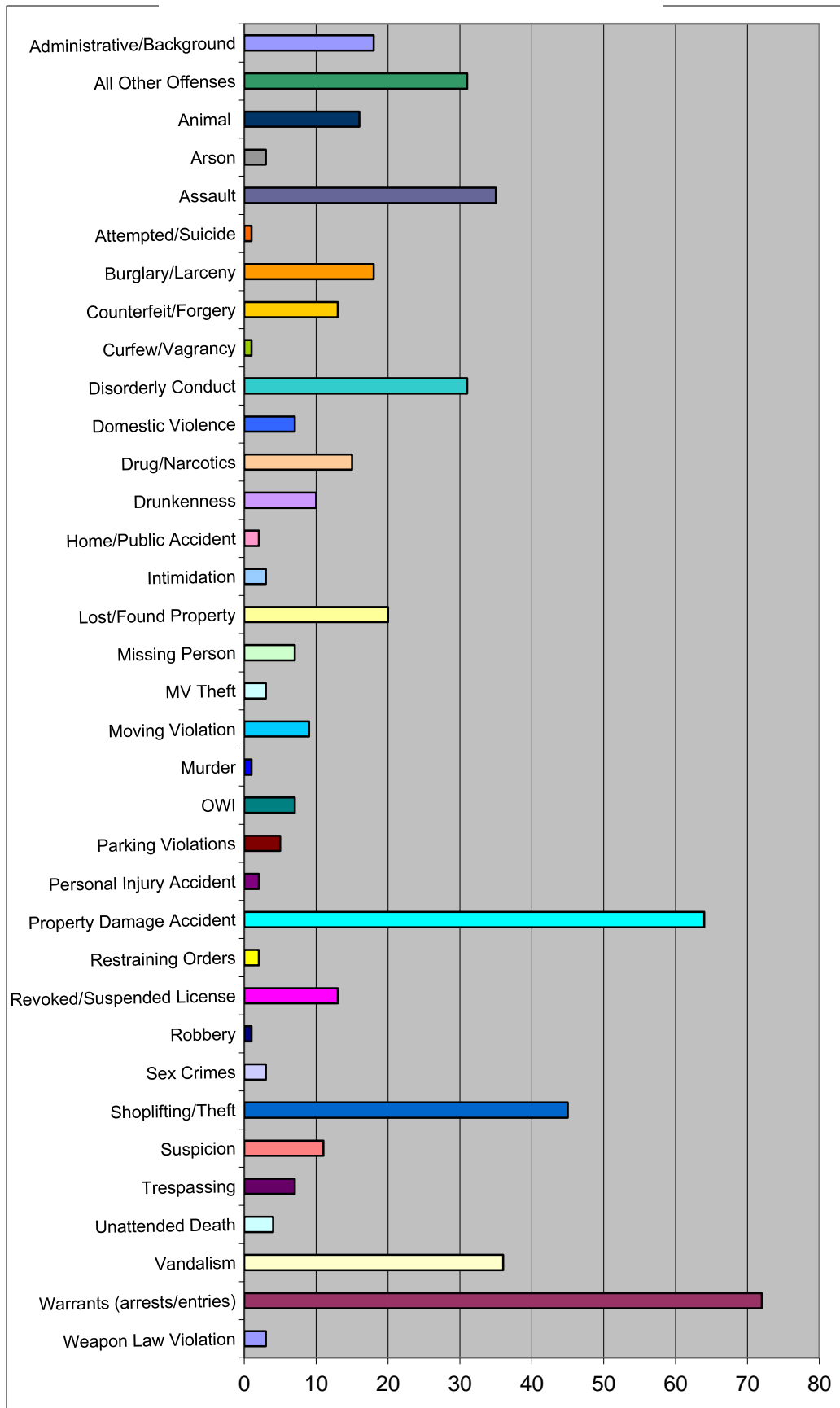
- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

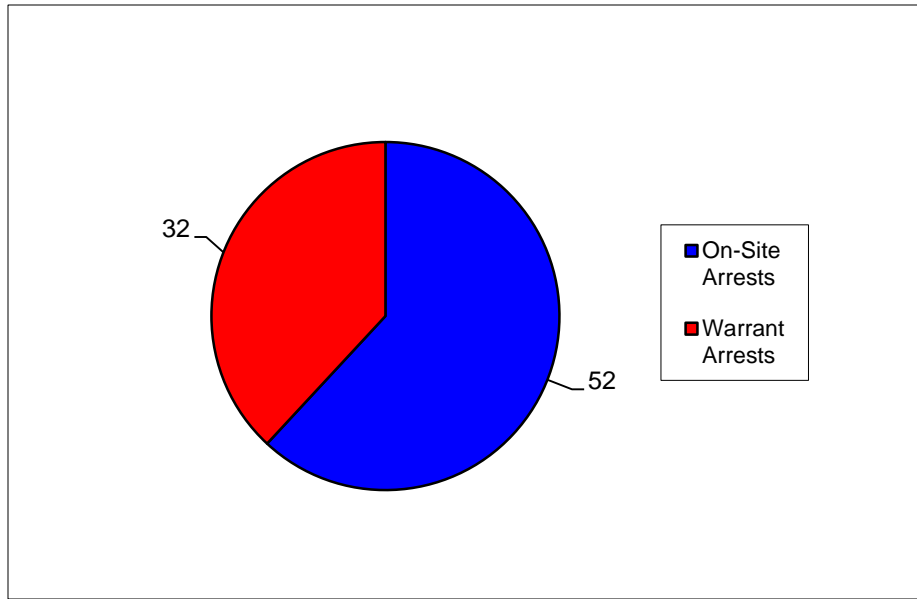
Calls Requiring an Emergency Response by Agency March



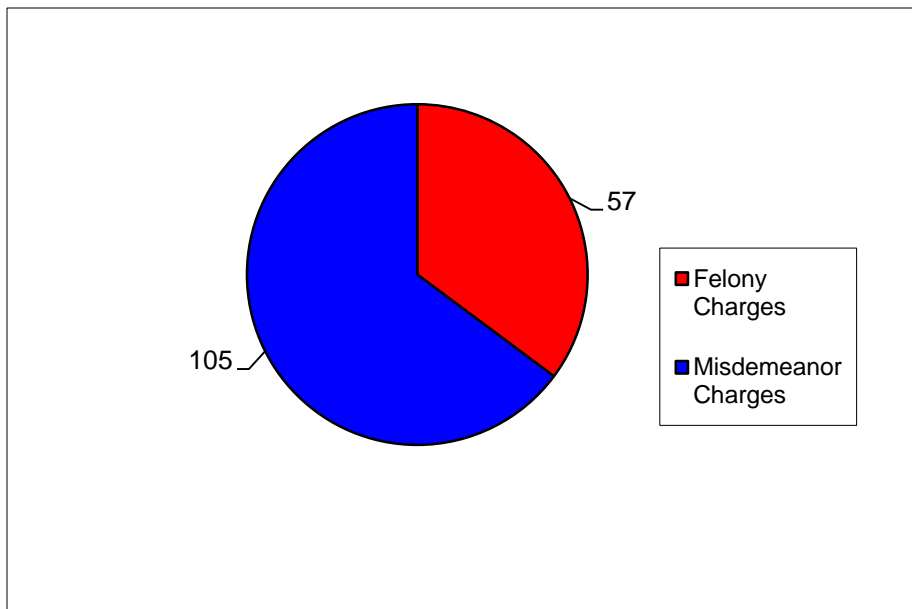
Incidents March 2015
