

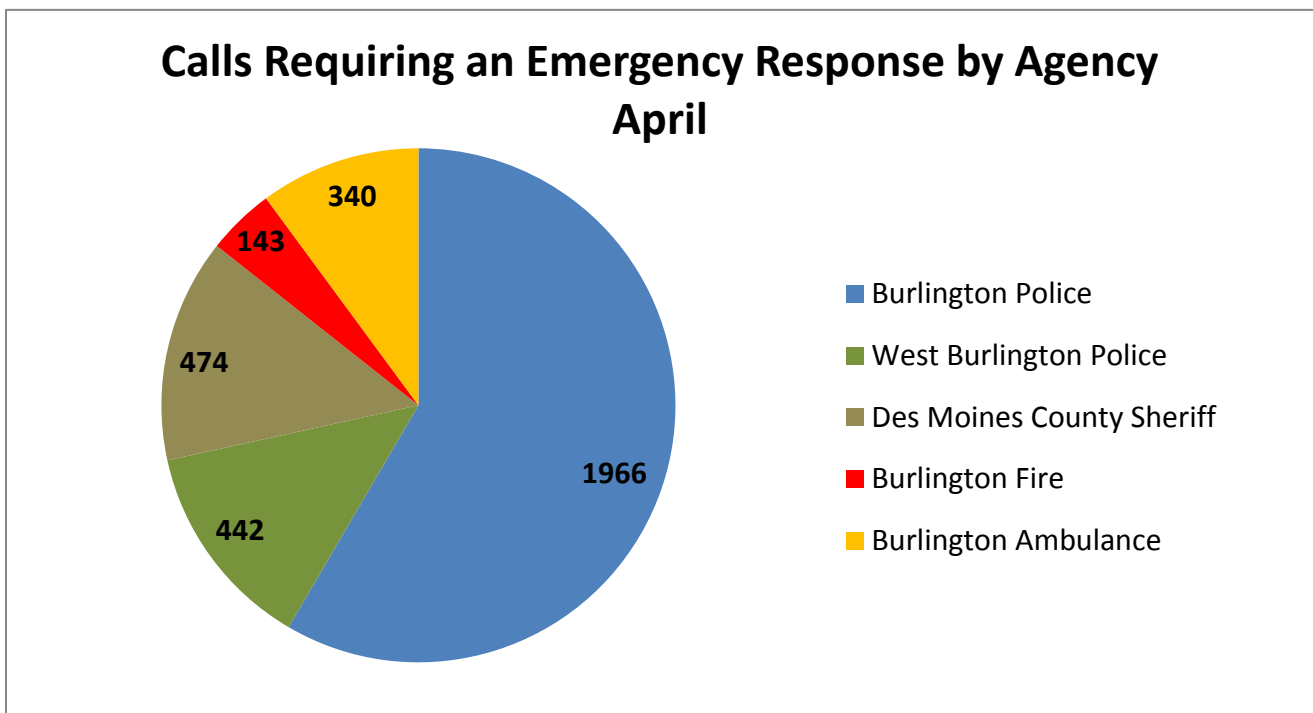

Re: Police Department Activities – April, 2015

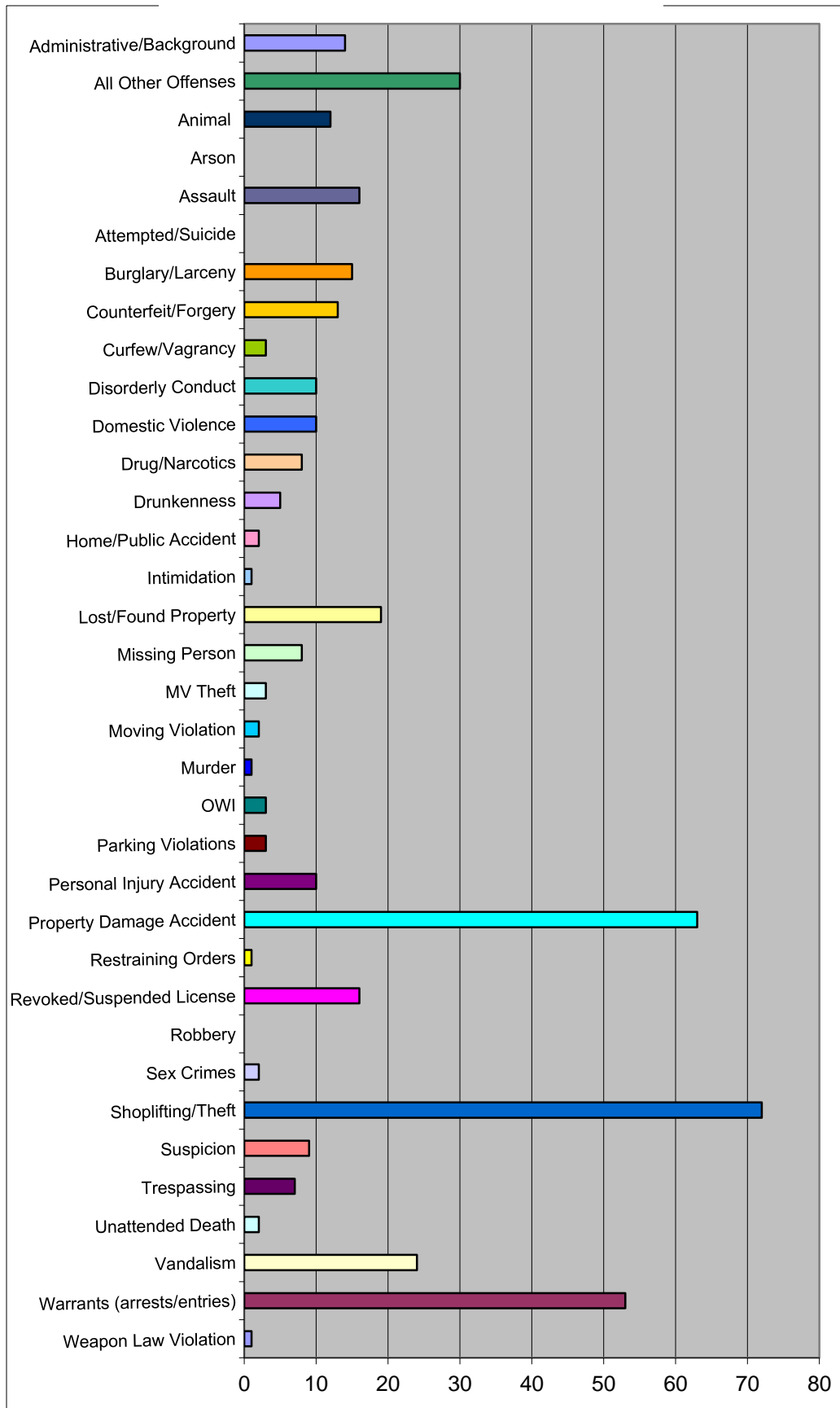


- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

- Major Grimshaw met with a committee of Burlington Police Officers and Chaplains to plan the upcoming Police Week Memorial Service.

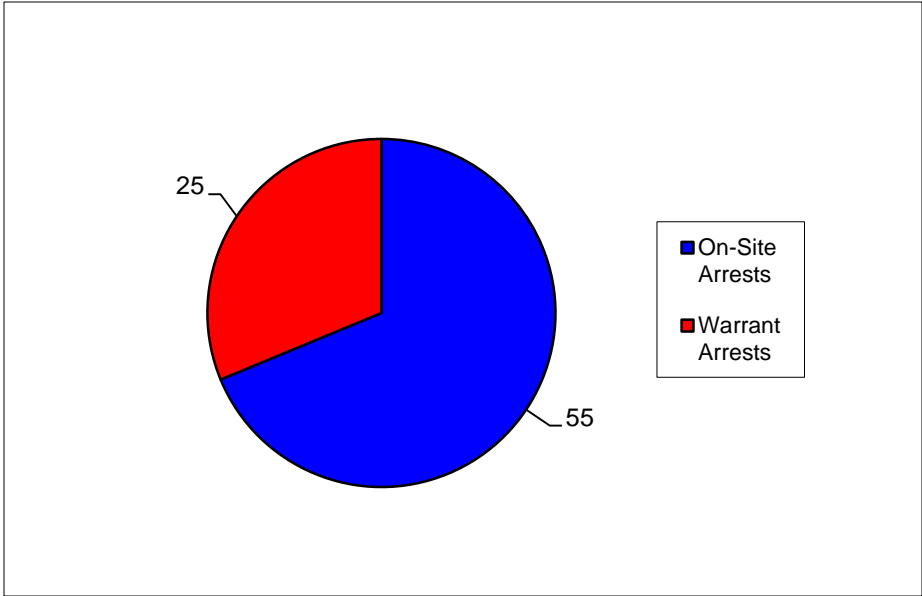

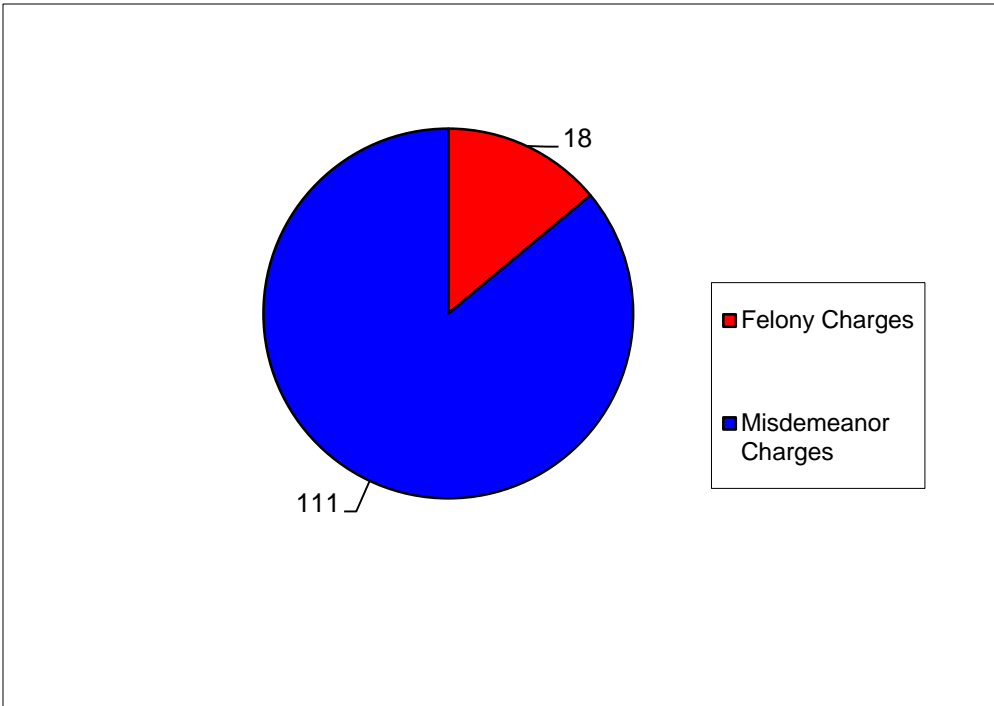
Incidents April 2015
