

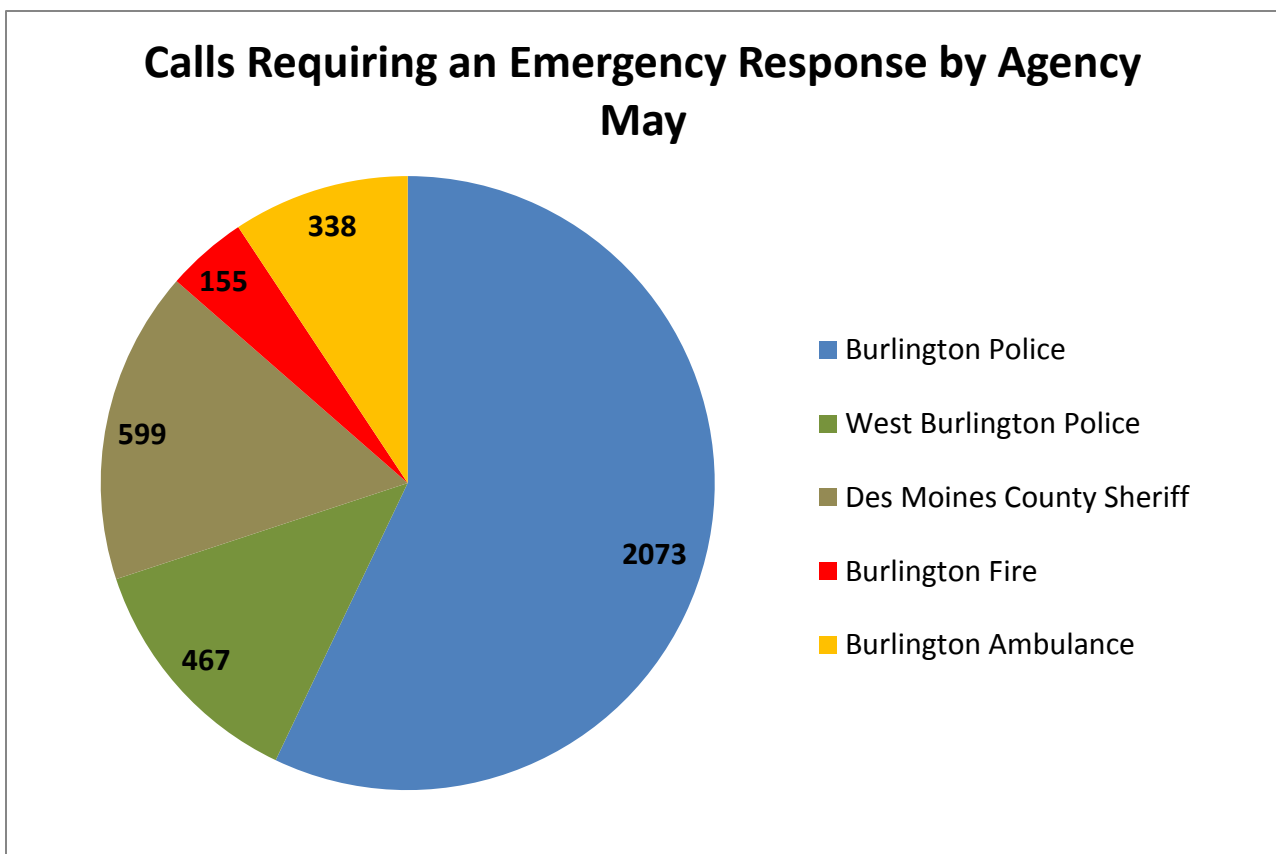

Re: Police Department Activities – May, 2015

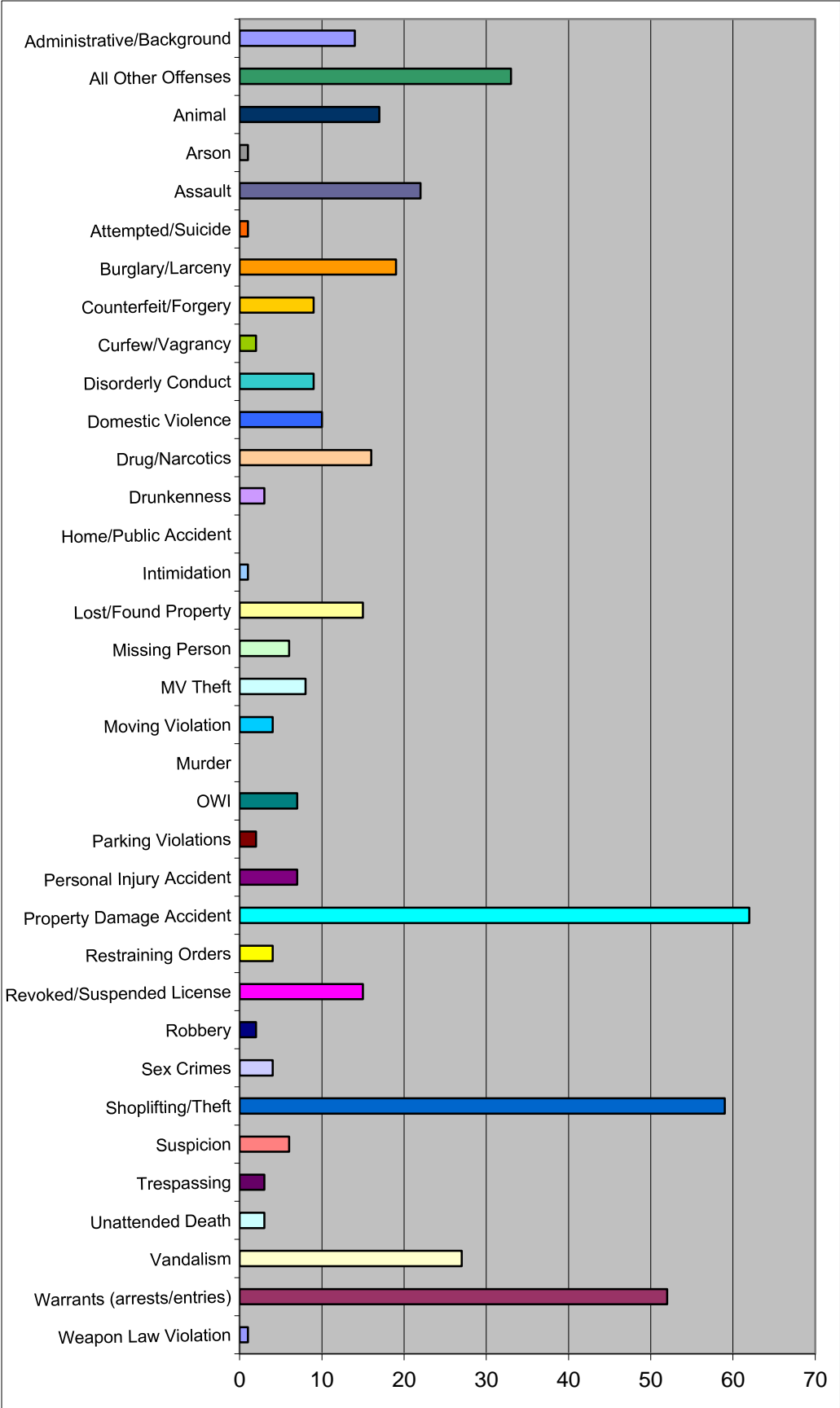


- The Chief attended all City Council Work Session and Meetings.

- The Command Staff met for the monthly staff meeting.

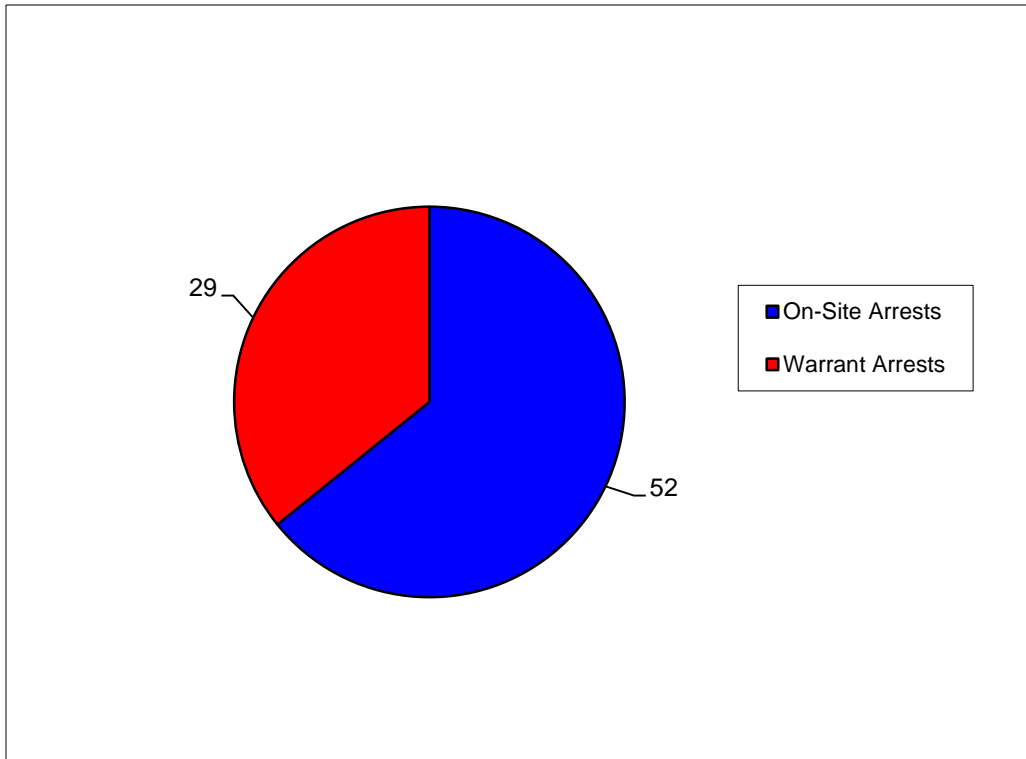
- During the month of May, 146 animals were received at the Animal Shelter.

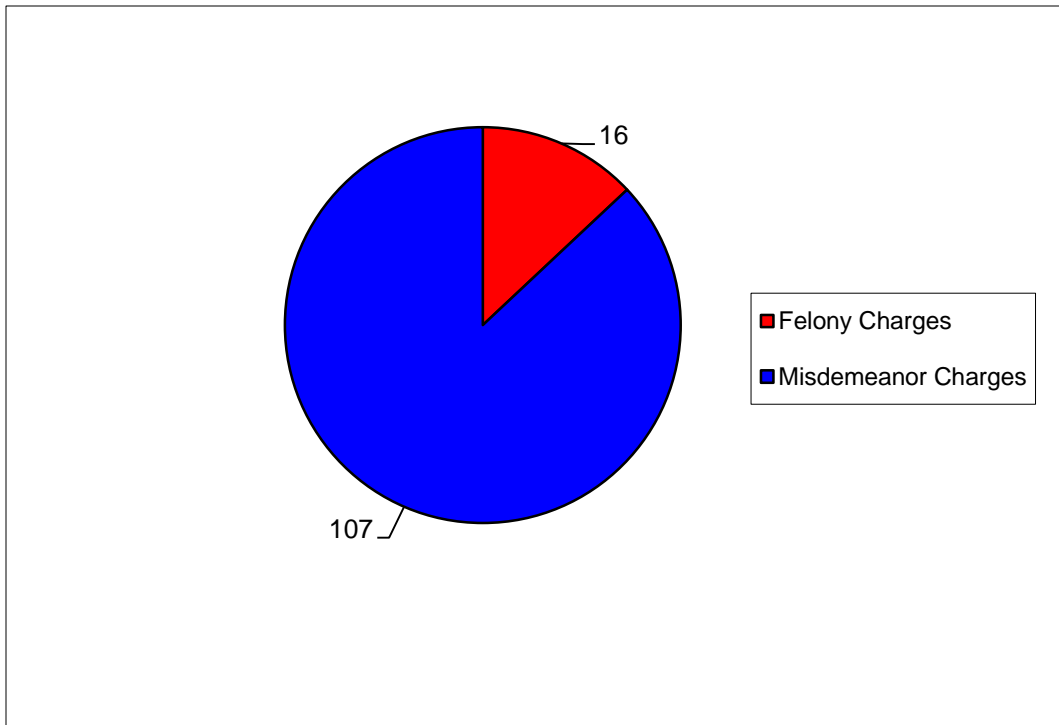
Incidents May 2015
