He stated that Steve Klein asked if ATVs and UTVs would be required to carry liability insurance; Mary Eipert stated that this is an unnecessary ordinance and Rose Kendall stated that these vehicles will and do cause too much noise and that operators are careless. Council Member Rinker stated that it is a necessary ordinance due to the new state law and the UTVs have a limit to the amount of noise that they make.
